      A. 1 Then he (Jesus) showed me (Zechariah) Joshua the high priest
          1. (Joshua) standing before the angel of the Lord (Jesus),
          2. and Satan standing at his (Joshua's) right hand
              a. to accuse him (Joshua). (Job 1, 2, Rev 12:10, Ps 109:6)
          3. 2 The Lord said to Satan, "The Lord rebuke you, Satan! (Jude 9)
          4. Indeed, the Lord who has chosen Jerusalem rebuke you!
          5. Is this (Jerusalem) not a brand plucked from the fire? (Yes) " (Amos 4:11)
      B. 3 Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments and standing before the angel (Jesus). (Isa 64:6)
          1. 4 He (Jesus) spoke and said to those (Angel's) who were standing before him, saying,
          2. "Remove the filthy garments from him (Joshua)." (Isa 64:6, Matt 22:11)
              a. Again he (Jesus) said to him (Joshua),
              b. "See, I have taken your iniquity away from you
              c. and will clothe you with festal robes." (Matt 22:11, Lk 15:22, Rev 19:8)
      C. 5 Then I (Zechariah) said,
          1. "Let them (Angels before Jesus, 3:4) put a clean turban on his (Joshua's) head." (Job 29:14)
              a. So they (Angels) put a clean turban on his (Joshua's) head
              b. and clothed him with garments (festal robes), (Matt 22:11, Lk 15:22, Rev 19:8, Isa 61:10)
              c. while the angel of the Lord (Jesus) was standing by.

Q1: WHAT persons were standing before the angel of the Lord (Jesus), in Verse 1, 4, & 5?
   A1: Joshua the high priest + Satan + those (Angel's) who were standing before him, Verse 4 & 5
Q2: WHO answered Satan's accusing of Joshua for the angel of the Lord, in Verse 2?
   A2: "The Lord (Jesus) said to Satan" This makes the angel of the Lord, same as the Lord
Q3: WHAT was Satan doing and WHERE was He positioned, in Verse 1?
   A3: Satan standing at his (Joshua's) right hand to accuse him
Q4: Does Satan (an Angel) accuse Men before God? Read (Job 1:6-7 + Job 2:1-2 & Rev 12:10 & Ps 109:6)
A4: Yes, accused Job + accuses Believers. (Satan) who accuses them (brethren) before our God day/night.
Q5: In what sense is Jerusalem "a brand plucked from the Fire"? Read (Amos 4:11 & Jude 23)
  A5: Jerusalem is plucked (or snatched) from the eternal the Lake of Fire, Rev 20:13-15, Like Believers are.
Q6: WHY were "those (Angel's)" told to "Remove the filthy garments from (Joshua)" Read (Isa 64:6)
  A6: (Joshua) was unclean or had iniquity, like a filthy garments. The Lord had his iniquities removed.
Q7: WHAT does "will clothe you with festal robes" symbolize?
                                                                Read (Matt 22:11, Lk 15:22, Rev 19:8)
A7: The filthy garments symbolize iniquity or Sin and festal robes symbolize righteousness or Cleanness
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Q8: WHAT does the "clean turban on his (Joshua's) head" symbolize? Read (Job 29:14)
  A8: The "clean turban", like festal robes, symbolizes Justice and righteousness
Q9: WHAT does Joshua the high priest represent, in the bigger CONTEXT?
  A9: He represents the forgiveness and restoration of the nation Israel, as a priestly nation before God.

IV. the angel of the Lord (Jesus) admonishes Joshua the high priest, 3:6-10 ¶
     A. 6 And the angel of the Lord (Jesus) admonished (assured) Joshua, saying,
          1. 7 "Thus says the Lord of hosts (the Father),

               a. bring in My (the Father's) servant (Jesus) the Branch (Jesus).
          3. 9 'For (Reason) behold, the stone (Jesus) that I (the Father) have set before Joshua;
              a. on one stone (Jesus, Ps 118:22, Isa 8:13-15, Isa 28:16, Dan 2:44-45)
                    are seven eyes (Zech 4:10, Rev 5:6).
          4. Behold, I (the Father) will engrave an inscription on it (the stone, Jesus),
               a. declares the Lord of hosts (the Father),
          5. 'and I (the Father) will remove the iniquity of that land (of Judah) in one day. (Zech 12:10, 13:1,
             Rom 11:25-27)
          6. 10 'In that day,' declares the Lord of hosts (the Father),
              a. 'every one of you (of Judah) will invite his neighbor
              b. to sit under his vine and under his fig tree." (1 Kings 4:25, Isa 36:16, Mic 4:4)

Joshua the high priest of Israel is still standing before the angel of the Lord (Jesus), 3:1.
     the angel of the Lord (Jesus), is speaking in the name of the Lord of hosts (the Father)
Q1: WHAT are the 2 conditions of blessing did Jesus give Joshua, in Verse 7?
A1: (1) 'If you (Joshua) will walk in My ways (2) if you will perform My service, Read (1 Kings 2:3)
Q2: WHAT are the 3 results of divine blessing for obeying the 2 conditions of blessing, in Verse 7?
A2: then you (Joshua), (1) will govern My house (Temple)
                                                            (2) have charge of My courts,
   (3) I (the Father) will grant you free access (to the Lord) among these (Angel's, 3:4a, 5) standing here.
   the angel of the Lord (Jesus), continues speaking in the name of the Lord of hosts (the Father).
Q3: In Verse 8, (Jesus) says, the Lord (the Father) says, (Joshua's friends or priests) are a symbol (sign) of
(the Father's) coming servant the Branch. WHO is the Branch? Read (Isa 11:1, Jer 23:5, Zech 6:12)
A3: "a shoot ... from the stem of Jesse, And a branch from his (Jesse's) roots will bear fruit, Isa 11:1
   "I will raise up for David a righteous Branch, Jer 23:5. He will build Temple, Zech 6:12
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## Questions of the Text: Zechariah 3:6-10 (Continued)

- Q4: In Verse 9, WHAT is the "one stone with seven eyes"?

  Read (Zech 4:10, Rev 5:6)

  A4: these (seven) are the eyes of the Lord which range to and fro throughout the earth, [All Seeing Lord]
- **Q5:** In Verse 9, WHAT is the **"one stone"**? **Read** (Ps 118:22, Isa 8:13-15, Isa 28:16, Dan 2:44-45)
- A5: "I (the Father) will engrave an inscription on it (the stone, Jesus)" the Cornerstone of the Temple Inscription concerns the "removal the iniquity of that land (of Judah) in one day"
- **Q6:** WHAT is the "**removal** the **iniquity** of **that land** in one day", in Verse 9 **Read** (Zech 12:10, 13:1, Rom 11:25-27)
- A6: Zech 12:10, "I will pour out, the Spirit of grace and of supplication (New Covenant)" Zech 12:10

  Rom 11:25-27, that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in;
  26 and so all Israel will be saved; just as it is written,
- "The Deliverer (Jesus) will come from Zion, He (Jesus) will remove ungodliness from Jacob."
- 27 "This is My covenant with them, When I take away their sins." Rom 11:25-27
- Q7: WHAT is this Covenant when The Lord takes away Israel's Sin? Read (Isa 59:21, Jer 31:33-34)
- A7: This Covenant is > the New Covenant promised to Israel Isaiah 59:21
- 21 "As for Me, this is My covenant with them," says the Lord:
- "My Spirit which is upon you, and My words which I have put in your mouth shall not depart from your mouth, nor from the mouth of your offspring, nor from the mouth of your offspring," says the Lord, [For How Long will this Go On!] "from now and forever."
- Jeremiah 31:33–34 (Same as Heb 8:10)
- 33 "But this is the covenant which I will make with the house of Israel after those days," declares the Lord, "I will put My law within them and on their heart I will write it; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people.
- 34 "They will not teach again, each man his neighbor and each man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' for they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them," declares the Lord, "for I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more."
- Q8: In Verse 10, WHAT is 'In that day, every one of you (Judah) will invite his neighbor to sit under his vine and under his fig tree." Mean? Read (1 Kings 4:25, Isa 36:16, Mic 4:4)
- A8: Symbol of Safety and Peace >
- 1 Kings 4:25, Symbol of Safety > Judah and Israel lived in safety, every man under his vine and his fig tree Isa 36:16, Symbol of Peace > Make your peace with me, and eat each of his vine and each of his fig tree
