After "these things", Rev 4:1a

Q1: WHAT are "these things" that John is speaking of, in verse 4:1a ?

A: John is speaking of all that he had heard and saw up to this point in time, Rev 1:1-Rev 3:22

First > He saw the Vision of the Son of Man who spoke to him, in Rev 1:9-11

Second > He heard what the Son of Man had to say to the 7 Churches, in Rev 2:1-Rev 3:22

This means,

"these things" are "the things which you (John) have seen" > the Vision of the Son of Man, in Rev 1:9-11 "these things" are "the things which are" > the 7 Churches in the first century, in Rev 2:1-Rev 3:22

"these things" are "After these things" OR after the Vision of the Son of Man and after the 7 Churches.

Q2: WHO was "the first voice (Son of Man) which I (John) had heard" "like a trumpet", in verse 4:1b ? Read Rev 1:10-13

A: John said, "... I heard behind me a loud voice like the sound of a trumpet", Rev 1:10
 John said, "Then I turned to see the voice that was speaking with me....", Rev 1:12
 The first voice John heard, Rev 4:1, was the Son of Man, Rev 1:13, and He began speaking in Rev 1:17

Then John was told by the Son of Man, "Come up here", meaning come up to "heaven", 4:2 So John came from Earth to Heaven. This was the first of about 14 Visions in Heaven

John was told to come up to "heaven", so that the Son of Man could show John:

what must take place after these things OR after the Vision of the Son of Man and after the 7 Churches.

Q3: WHAT are the **things** that "**must take place**", in verse 4:1d ? Read Rev 1:1, 1:19, 22:6

"The Revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him (Jesus) to show to His bond-servants, the things which must soon take place" ..., Rev 1:1

"Therefore write **the things** which **you** (John) have **seen**, and **the things** which **are**, and **the things which** will take place after these things. Rev 1:19

... "and the Lord, the God of the spirits of the prophets, sent His angel (Jesus) to show to His bond-servants the things which must soon take place", Rev 22:6

Q4: WHAT are the things that "must take place" "after these things", in verse 4:1d ? The things after (future) these things (after this, ESV) refers to:

The Throne, the Scroll, and the Tribulation Period or Judgments of God, and the 2nd Coming, in Rev 4:1–19:21 and the 1000 year Millennium, the New Heavens and Earth, and the New Jerusalem, Rev 20:1-22:17

The Throne in Heaven, 4:2-3

Working Outline > Read Revelation 4:2-3 (Portion of Paragraph ¶ from NAS Bible) Revelation 4:2-3

- I. 2 Immediately I (John) was in the Spirit; 1:10, 17:3, 21:10
- II. and behold, a throne was standing in heaven, Rev 1:4, 20:11, 5:1, 6:16, 19:4, Ps 11:4, Isa 66:1, Ezek 1:26-28
 A. and One (the Father) sitting on the throne. 1 Kings 22:19, Isa 6:1, Dan 7:9
 - 1. 3 And He (the Father) who was sitting
 - a. was like a jasper stone 21:11, 21:18-20, Ex 28:20, Ezek 28:13
 - b. and (like) a sardius (carnelian) in appearance; 21:11,
 - 2. and there was a **rainbow** around the **throne**, Ezek 1:28,
 - a. like an emerald (21:19) in appearance.

"in the Spirit", Rev 4:2

John, "in the Spirit" refers to the exalted spiritual state brought on by the Holy Spirit, that he "was in", so he could hear ("heard", 1:10) and "see" (1:11-12) "things" (1:19) that were about to be revealed to him. John, being "in the Spirit" is mention 3 other times, in Rev 1:10, 17:3, 21:10

"**a throne** was standing in **heaven**, and **One** (the Father) **sitting** on the **throne**", Rev 4:2 Rev 1:4, 20:11, 5:1, 6:16, 19:4, Ps 11:4, Isa 6:1, Isa 66:1, Ezek 1:26-28

First, John saw a Throne in Heaven, Rev 4:2. Heaven: where God and His Angels live.

Second, The One sitting on the throne was God the Father, Read 5:1, 5:5, 5:7

We know this because **the Lion of Judah** (Jesus), 5:5, takes the **Book/Scroll** from the right hand of **Him** who **sat** on the **Throne**, 5:7. **Him** (God the Father) who is **Worshiped**, 5:10-11.



He who was sitting on the throne was in appearance Like, Rev 4:3

3 And He (God the Father) who was sitting

was **like** (Simile Metaphor) a **jasper stone** (in appearance), 21:11, 21:18-20, Ex 28:20, Ezek 28:13 He (God the Father) appeared as a **jasper stone** does, But He was Not a **jasper stone**.

Jasper A "Precious stone" or gem, 21:18, "a very costly stone, as a stone of crystal-clear jasper", 21:11 "that reflects various colors", 21:11. Also what the "Wall" of the New Jerusalem is made of, 21:18, and what the "first foundation stone" of the New Jerusalem is made of, 21:19.

Jasper is also one of the precious stones, in row 4, of the breastplate of the high priest, Ex 28:20.

He (God the Father) appeared as a sardius stone does, But He was Not a sardius stone. Sardius A "Precious stone" or gem, 21:19

and what the "sixth foundation stone" of the **New Jerusalem** is made of, 21:20. **Sardius** is also one of the **precious stones**, in row 4, of the **breastplate** of the **high priest**, Ex 28:20. And on the shoulder **plate** of **ephod**, the **priest's** garment, with the names of **the tribes of Israel**, Ex 28:9-12. **Ezekiel 1:27**

27 Then I (Ezekiel) noticed from the **appearance** of His loins (waist) and upward

something like glowing metal (amber) that looked like fire all around within it (waist), and from the **appearance** of **His loins** (waist) and downward I saw something like fire; ...

Apparently, He (God the Father) appeared as "a very costly stone, as a stone of crystal-clear jasper", 21:11

And above and below His waist appeared "something like glowing metal (amber color)

that looked like fire all around", "there was a radiance (brightness) around Him"

"there was a **rainbow** around the **throne**", Rev 4:3 there was a **rainbow** around (the Father's) the **throne**, Ezek 1:28, **like** an **emerald** (21:19) in **appearance**, 4:3

Ezekiel 1:27d-28

and there was a **radiance** around **Him. 28** As the **appearance** of the **rainbow** in the clouds on a rainy day,

so was the **appearance** of the surrounding **radiance**. Such was the appearance of the likeness of **the glory of the Lord**. And when I (Ezekiel) saw it, I fell on **my face** and heard a **voice speaking**.

Apparently, there **appeared** a "**radiance**" of **green light**, the color of "**emerald**", "around the **throne**", and **it** "was the **appearance** of the likeness of **the glory of the Lord**".



The 7 Visions John saw in Heaven and on Earth

The Scenes "in Heaven" are preliminary to and explain the Events that follow "on Earth",

- There are 7 Pairs of Connecting Events, each with a Heavenly and an Earthly component,
 - All "in Heaven" Scenes have some Heavenly Voices, 17 Heavenly Voices in 7 Scenes,
- I. Introduction, (1:1-20),
 - A. The People on the Earth, (The 7 Churches) (2:1-3:22),
 - The First Vision, "in Heaven", (4:1-5:14), (The Throne, the Book, and the Lamb), a. The First Vision, "on Earth", (6:1-7:8), (The 6 Seals and the 144,000),
 - The Second Vision, "in Heaven", (7:9-8:6) (The Great Multitude and the 7th Seal),
 a. The Second Vision, "on Earth", (8:7-11:14) (The 6 Trumpet Judgment),
 - The Third Vision, "in Heaven", (11:15-19) (The 7th Trumpet Judgment),
 a. The Third Vision, "on Earth", (11:19) (The Earthquake, etc.),
 - 4. The Forth Vision, "in Heaven", (12:1-12) (The Woman, the Child, and the Dragon), a. The Fourth Vision, "on Earth", (12:13-13:8) (The Dragon and 2 Beasts),
 - The Fifth Vision, "in Heaven", (14:1-5) (The Lamb and the 144,000),
 a. The Fifth Vision, "on Earth", (14:6-20) (The Lamb and the 6 Angels),
 - 6. The Sixth Vision, "in Heaven", (15:1-8) (The 7 Bowl Judgment Angels),
 a. The Sixth Vision, "on Earth", (16:1-18:24) (The 7 Bowl Judgments),
 - 7. The Seventh Vision, "in Heaven", (19:1-16) (The Marriage of the Lamb, etc),
 - a. The Seventh Vision, "on Earth", (19:17-20:15) (The Final Five Judgments),
 - B. The People of the New Earth, (21:1-22:5), (The Millennium, Judgment, and New Jerusalem),

Around, Out From, and Before, the Throne in Heaven, 4:4-6a

- I. 4 Around the throne (of the Father) were twenty-four thrones; 11:6
 - A. and upon the (24) thrones I (John) saw twenty-four elders sitting, 1 Chron 24:4, 25:9-31
 - clothed in white garments, 3:4-5, 3:18, 6:11, 7:9, 7:13–16, 19:14
 and golden crowns on their heads. 4:10, 2:10, 3:11,
- II. 5 Out from the throne come flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder. 11:19, 14:2, 19:6
- III. And there were **seven lamps** of **fire** burning before the **throne**, 1:4, 3:1, 5:6, Zech 4:10, 2 Chron 16:9 A. which are the **seven Spirits of God**; 1:4, 5:6
- IV. 6a and before the throne there was something like a sea of glass, like crystal; 15:2, 21:18, 21:21

THE TWENTY-FOUR ELDERS, Rev 4:4

 Q1: In Rev 4:4, WHO are the twenty-four elders ?
 A: Elders in the Bible are always Men and Not Angels the only other choice.
 Therefore, if Men, they are Men who are, at this point in time, in Heaven.



Chart

Elders (Hebrew, zequen),

were wise, experienced, discerning Men entrusted with authority to help govern the people, Num 1:13-15
Men were selected to run the day-to-day affairs of the People of Israel, the Sanhedrin, and Synagogues.
When David was Old, he made Solomon King, and he gathered all the leaders, Priests, and Levites,
30 years old and older, 1 Chron 23:1-2, and he assigned Duties to the Levite Priests, 1 Chron 23:3-26:32.
David assigned the Levite Priests, into 24 groups, with each group serving 2 weeks a year. 1 Chron 24:1-31
David also assigned 24 groups of Prophetic Musicians, serving 2 weeks a year, 1 Chron 25:1-31, Rev 5:8

In the **New Testament Church**, "elder" also refers to governing group of Men over the affairs of the People.

These 24 Elders are "sitting" on "thrones" around the throne of God, implies ruling, Rev 4:4 These Elders are "clothed in white garments", Rev 4:4, that identify them as Born of God or Overcomers who will be Given by God Clean White Fine Linen Robes, Rev 3:4-5, 1 John 5:4–5, Washed, Sanctified, and Justified with the Blood of Lamb, Rev 3:18, 7:15, 1 Cor 6:11. See Lesson 8 for more.

These 24 Elders "worship Him who lives forever", 4:10, 11:16, 19:4

and they have "golden crowns on their heads", 4:4, and "will cast their crowns before the throne", 4:10. Believers "will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him", 2:10, Jas 1:12.

"each one holding a harp and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints", Rev 5:8–9 The 24 Elders explain to John who the Great Multitude in white robes in Heaven are, in Rev 7:13-17 Also are the ones after the 7th Trumpet sounded, who give thanks to God,

Because God by **His** great **power**, **wrath**, and **destruction** has begun to **reign**, **Rev 11:16-18 Because** the **time came** "to **destroy those** (unbelievers) **who** destroy the **earth**", **11:18**

24 Elders Conclusion Men ? or Angels? Chart

These elders must represent Humans redeemed by the Blood of Lamb, both Jew and Gentile. These elders stand for Human representatives of the New Covenant Church, of Jew and Gentile. Because they are "in Heaven", 4:2, and "upon thrones", a place of ruling, Elders Rule, Rev 4:4, Because Overcomers/Believers are to have <u>authority over</u> and <u>rule over</u> the Nations, Rev 2:26-27 Because Humans are always referred to as Elders and Angels as Elders is implied only once in Isa 24:23 Because Angels are Not said to <u>Rule</u> on thrones or have golden crowns, in the Bible, 2 Tim 4:8, Jas 1:12 Because Angels with white garments, are <u>Not</u> said to have "washed their robes and made them white

in the **blood** of **the Lamb**", Rev 7:14, as **Overcomers** or **Believers** or **Redeemed Humans** have, Rev 3:4-5 Because they are "clothed in white garments", Rev 4:4

Clean White Fine Linen Robes identifies them as Overcomers or Believers, Rev 3:4-5, 1 John 5:4–5 Because they have "golden crowns on their heads", 4:4, and "will cast their crowns before the throne", 4:10. Because Believers "receive the crown of life, the Lord has promised to those who love Him", 2:10, Jas 1:12 Because they Worship, Praise, Pray, and Give Thanks to God as Believers do, in OT and NT. Because their number seems to correspond to the 24 divisions of the Ruling Levite Priests, 1 Chron 24:7–18, and the 24 divisions of the Prophetic Musicians, 1 Chron 25:9–31.

Q2: In Rev 4:4, Are these 24 Elders actual members the Nation of Israel or of the NT Church ? Israel or Old Testament believers or saints of Israel could not be represented here in Rev 4:4, until after Daniel's 70th week.

Because "all Israel will be saved" when "the Deliver (Jesus) comes (2nd Coming)" and Jesus removes ungodliness (sin) from Jacob (from Israel), Rom 11:25-32, Dan 12:1-2 Also Jer 31:34, Isa 59:20-21, Hosea 2:1-23, Hosea 3:1-5, Zech 10:6, Isa 35:4.

If the 24 Elders are Not Israel, then that leaves the Church

made up primarily of Gentiles (non-Jews), Eph 3:11-13, and a remnant of Israel (Jews), Rom 11:5. The Churches in Rev 2 and Rev 3, are rewarded with:

a crown, 2:10, 3:11, a throne, 3:21, a white robe, 3:4-5, like the 24 Elders, in 4:4, 4:10

Out from the Throne of God, Rev 4:5

Out from the **throne** come flashes of **lightning** and sounds and peals of **thunder**. 4:5 When **God** on **His Throne** is present, it is often accompanied by, **lightning** and **thunder**, Rev 11:19 Also When **God** appeared on **Mt. Sinai**, there was **lightning** and **thunder**, Ex 19:16, 20:18

SEVEN LAMPS OF FIRE, Rev 4:5

And there were **seven lamps** of **fire burning** before the **throne**, 1:4, 3:1, 5:6, Zech 4:10, 2 Chron 16:9 which are the **seven Spirits of God**; 1:4, 5:6

Notice John gives the Literal Interpretation of the "seven lamps of fire burning"

as "the seven Spirits of God"

The Seven Spirits: Represent Seven Angels these are the Seven Eyes of the Lord Zechariah 4:10

10 ... But these seven (eyes) will be glad when they (eyes) see the plumb line in the hand of Zerubbabel
 —these (eyes) are the eyes of the Lord which range to and fro throughout the earth." (2 Chron 16:9)

Revelation 5:6 The seven spirits OR the seven eyes of the Lamb (Jesus) >

are those 7 spirits (Angels) "sent out into all the earth", by Jesus,

2 Chronicles 16:9

9 "For the eyes of the Lord move to and fro throughout the earth

that He may strongly support those whose heart is completely His....

Apparently, the seven spirits of the Lamb (Jesus), 5:6, seven spirits or seven Angels,

These 7 Angels represent the Lamb's "all seeing eyes",

"which range to and fro throughout the earth.", Zech 4:10, 2 Chron 16:9

The Lamb has "seven eyes", and the "eyes" are the spirits (Angels) which are dispatched into all the earth. These are "the seven eyes" of the Lamb (Jesus) or His <u>omniscience</u> (all knowing/seeing) as in (Rev 5:6). It says that there is <u>no place on earth</u> which is not under the all seeing eye of the Lord.

The eyes of the LORD are in every place, Watching the evil and the good, Prov 15:3

BEFORE THE THRONE SOMETHING LIKE A SEA OF GLASS, Rev 4:6a

Rev 4:6a "and **before** the **throne** there was something like a **sea of glass**, like **crystal**;" 15:2, 21:18, 21:21 Revelation 15:2

2 And I saw (in Heaven) something like a sea of glass mixed with fire, and those who had been victorious over the beast and his image and the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, holding harps of God. Revelation 21:18

18 The material of the **wall** was **jasper**; and **the city** (New Jerusalem) was **pure gold, like clear glass**. Revelation 21:21

21 And the twelve gates were twelve pearls; each one of the gates was a single pearl.

And the street of the city (New Jerusalem) was pure gold, like transparent glass.

Conclusion

before the throne (of God in Heaven) there was something like a sea of glass, like crystal, Rev 4:6

I (John) saw (in Heaven) something like a sea of glass mixed with fire, Rev 15:2

I (John) saw Believers standing on the sea of glass, holding harps of God, Rev 15:2

the city (New Jerusalem out of Heaven) was pure gold, like clear glass, Rev 21:18, 21:2

the street of the city (New Jerusalem out of Heaven) was pure gold, like transparent glass, Rev 21:18, 21:2

Heaven's standing surface and New Jerusalem city and its streets are like Clear Pure Gold Glass

Around, Out From, and Before, the Throne in Heaven, 4:6-8

- V. 6 and before the throne there was something like a sea of glass, like crystal; 15:2, 21:18, 21:21
- VI. and in the center and around the throne,
 - A. four living creatures full of eyes in front and behind. 4:8, 6:1, Ezek 1:5, (11 times in Rev)
 - 1. **7** The first creature was like a lion, Ezek 1:5, Ezek 1:10, Ezek 10:14
 - 2. and the **second creature** like a **calf** (ox),
 - 3. and the **third creature** had a **face** like that of a **man**,
 - 4. and the **fourth creature** was like a flying **eagle**.
 - B. 8 And the four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, Isa 6:2,
 - 1. are full of eyes around and within; 4:6, Ezek 1:18, Ezek 10:12
 - 2. and day and night they do not cease to say,
 - 3. "Holy, holy is the Lord God, the Almighty, Isa 6:3
 - 4. who was and who is and who is to come." 1:4, 1:8,



THE FOUR LIVING CREATURES, Rev 4:6-8

The four living creatures are mentioned in, Rev 4:6, 4:8, 5:6, 5:8, 5:14, 6:1, 6:3, 6:5, 6:6, 6:7, 7:11, 14:3, 15:7, 19:4

- The **four living creatures** > were "in the **center** and **around** the **throne** (of the Father)", **4**:6
 - John saw, the creatures immediately in the center and around the throne of the Father, 4:2-3
 - John saw, the 24 Elders around the throne, but not "in the center" of "the throne", 4:4

The four living creatures, each one of them having six wings, 4:8, Isa 6:2,

Only Angels are said to have wings in the Bible, so the four living creatures must be Angelic Spiritual Beings. Cherubim Angels are said to have 2 Wings, Ex 25:20, 1 Kings 6:24-27 Cherubim Angels are said to have 4 Wings, Ezek 1:6, Ezek 10:, 8, 12, 16, 19, 21, 11:22,

Seraphim Angels are said to have 6 Wings, in Isa 6:2

Read Isaiah 6:1–7

1 In the year of King Uzziah's death I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, lofty and exalted, with the train of His robe filling the temple.

- 2 Seraphim (plural) stood above (around, Sep.) Him, each having six wings:
 - with **two** (wings) **he** (they, Sep.) covered **his** (their, Sep.) **face**,
 - and with two (wings) he (they, Sep.) covered his (their, Sep.) feet,
 - and with **two** (wings) **he** (they, Sep.) **flew**.
- 3 And one (Seraphim) called out to another (Seraphim) and said,
 - "Holy, Holy, Holy, is **the Lord of hosts**, Rev 4:8 The **whole earth** is full of **His** glory."
- 4 And the foundations of the (Temple) thresholds trembled at the voice of him (they, Sep.) (Seraphim) who called out, while the temple was filling with smoke.
- 5 Then I (Isaiah) said, "Woe is me, for I am ruined ! Because I am a man of unclean lips, And I live among a people (Israel) of unclean lips; For my eyes have seen the King, the Lord of hosts."

- 6 Then one of the Seraphim flew to me with a burning coal in his hand, which he had taken from the altar with tongs.
- 7 He (Seraphim) touched my mouth with it (coal) and said,
 "Behold, this (coal) has touched your lips; and your iniquity is taken away and your sin is forgiven."

How are the four living creatures in Rev 4:6-9, Like the Seraphim in Isa 6:2-7?

They both are ("before" or "above (around)" One/the Lord, sitting on a throne, Rev 4:1-2 and Isa 6:2) They both have wings (six wings, Rev 4:8 and six wings, Isa 6:2)

Therefore, they must be Angels in Rev 4 and Isa 6, because Only Angels are said to have wings in Bible. They are Angels (called living creatures, Rev 4 and called Seraphim, Isa 6)

They both "say" or "called out", "Holy, Holy, is the Lord of hosts", in Rev 4:8 and in Isa 6:3-4 Therefore, they both **Praise the Lord** in the same words, so their function is the same in Heaven.

Conclusion

They both are <mark>6 winged Angels, Seraphim</mark>, around the throne in Heaven that praise the Lord.

How are the four living creatures in Rev 4:6-9, Not Like the Seraphim in Isa 6:2-7?

In Rev 4:7, They looked Like a Lion, a Calf, a Man, and an Eagle, mostly Like Creatures in appearance. In Isa 6:2, 6, They are said to have a face, feet, hands, and flew, mostly Like Humans in appearance.

How are the four living creatures in Rev 4:6-9, Like the four living beings of Ezek 1:5–14?

They both are ("above" or "before" a throne with One/the Glory of Lord, Rev 4:1-2 and Ezek 1:26-28) They both have wings (But six wings, Rev 4:8 and four wings, Ezek 1:6, 10:21)

Therefore, they must be Angels, because Only Angels are said to have wings in Bible. They are Angels (called living creatures, Rev 4 and living beings and Cherubim, Ezek 1:5, 10:1, 20) They both have some feature resembling a Lion, Calf (ox), eagle, Man, Rev 4:7 and Ezek 1:4-11 But, in Rev 4, only one had a Face of a Lion, Calf (ox), eagle, Man, and in Ezek 1, all 4 had those faces.

Conclusion

They both are winged Angels, "above" or "before" a throne in Heaven that praise or move the Lord. Therefore, the four living creatures in Rev 4:6-9 are Angels

The Four Living Creatures, are Like

The four living creatures > are full of eyes in front and behind. 4:6, 4:8, 6:1, Ezek 1:5, > are **full of eyes** around and within; 4:8, Ezek 1:18, Ezek 10:12 full of eyes represents at least 2 major attributes of God. His omniscience (He knows all things, Past, Present, and Future) and **His** omnipresence (He is everywhere Present at the same time) The four living creatures (Angels) > and day and night they do not cease to say, 4:8 "Holy, holy is the Lord God, the Almighty, 4:8, Like in Isa 6:3, who was and who is and who is to come." 4:8, 1:4, 1:8, The first creature (Angel) was like a lion, full of eyes, having six wings, Ezek 1:5, Ezek 1:10, Ezek 10:14 This seems to be representative of the Chief Land Creature of the Earth, the Lion. The second creature (Angel) like a calf (ox), full of eyes, having six wings, This seems to be representative of the Chief **Domestic Creature** of the **Earth**, the **Calf** (ox). The third creature (Angel) had a face like that of a man, full of eyes, having six wings. This seems to be representative of the Chief Land Person of the Earth, Man. The fourth creature (Angel) was like a flying eagle, full of eyes, having six wings, This seems to be representative of the Chief Sky Creature of the Earth, the Eagle. Conclusion

Perhaps it is safest to say that the **four** different **living creatures** portrayed certain **creatures** of the **Earth** and are important because **each one** represents a part of all **living creation** on the **Earth**. **"full of eyes"** representing **God** overseeing **His Creation** in **His** omniscience and **His** omnipresence.

This **Compares with** "every **living creature**", Gen 1:24, 2:19, 9:10, named by Adam and on Noah's Ark.

The Whole Creation or every created thing

Romans 8:19-22

19 For the anxious longing of the creation waits eagerly for the revealing of the sons of God.
20 For the creation was subjected to futility, not willingly, but because of Him who subjected it, in hope 21 that the creation itself also will be set free from its slavery to corruption

into the freedom of the glory of the children of God.

22 For we know that the whole creation groans and suffers the pains of childbirth together until now.

Revelation 4:11

11 "Worthy are You, our Lord and our God, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and because of Your will they (all things) existed, and were created."

Revelation 5:13

13 And every created thing which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and on the sea, and all things (created) in them, I heard saying, "To Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, be blessing and honor and glory and dominion forever and ever."

Conclusion

The Creation was subjected to futility, after the Fall of Man in Gen 3:17, and after the Flood, Gen 9:2-3 The Whole Creation groans and suffers the pains of childbirth together until now, Rom 8:22 Q: But how can Creation groan and suffer pains of childbirth ?

A: Personification, a figure of speech that adds human qualities to non-human things, as to Creation here.

The Purpose of the Four Living Creatures, in Revelation

Revelation 4:8

8 And the four living creatures (Angels), each one of them having six wings,

are full of eyes around and within; and day and night they do not cease to say,

"Holy, holy, holy is the Lord God, the Almighty, who was and who is and who is to come."

The **4** Angels Praise the Lord God, without ceasing, in Heaven.

Revelation 4:9

9 And when the **living creatures**

give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, to Him who lives forever and ever, The 4 Angels give glory and honor and thanks the Lord God, in Heaven.

Revelation 5:8

8 When He had taken the book, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before	e
the Lamb, each one holding a harp and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the sair	nts.

The **4** Angels at times, present the Lamb (Jesus) with the prayers of the saints.

Revelation 5:9–10

9 And they (four living creatures) sang a new song, saying,

"Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals; for You were slain,

and **purchased** for **God** with **Your blood** men from every **tribe** and **tongue** and **people** and **nation**.

10 "You have made them (believers) to be a kingdom and priests to our God;

and they (believers) will reign upon the earth."

The **4** Angels at times, sing songs of praise and acclaim the worthiness in the work of the Lamb Jesus in His purchasing (bought for a price) Believers for God.

Revelation 5:12–13

12 saying with a loud voice, "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain

to receive **power** and **riches** and **wisdom** and **might** and **honor** and **glory** and **blessing."**

The **4** Angels at times, proclaim the Worthiness of the Lamb, to receive all these things listed.

Revelation 5:14

14 And the **four living creatures** kept saying, **"Amen."** And the elders fell down and worshiped. The **4** Angels at times, say **"Amen"** as a declaration of affirmation

Revelation 6:1 Also Rev 6:3, 6:5, 6:6, 6:7

1 Then I saw when the Lamb broke one of the seven seals,

and I heard one of the **four living creatures** saying as with a voice of thunder, "**Come**." (4 Times)

The **four living creatures** say **"Come**." to each of the **four horse riders** of the **first 4 Seal Judgments**, The **4 Angels** as **God's** agents, at times, call other **Angels** to execute the **wrath** of **God**,

with Judgments and Plagues on Man and on the Earth. Rev 6:16-17, 15:7

Revelation 7:11 and 19:4

11 And all the angels were standing around the throne and around the (24) elders and

the **four living creatures;** and **they** (the 4) **fell** on their faces before the throne and **worshiped God, 4** And the twenty-four **elders** and the **four living creatures**

fell down and worshiped God who sits on the throne saying, "Amen. Hallelujah!"

The 4 Angels at times, fall down and worship God on His throne, saying, "Amen. Hallelujah!"

Revelation 15:7

7 Then one of the four living creatures gave to the seven angels seven golden bowls full of the wrath of God, who lives forever and ever.

The **4** Angels as God's agents, at times, call other Angels to execute the wrath of God, with Judgments and Plagues on Man and on the Earth. Rev 6:1, 6:16-17

Four Living Creatures (Angels) - Praising the Father

Here we have the **Four Living Creatures** or **4 Angels** In Rev 4:9, Angels giving glory and honor and thanks to God the Father on the throne who lives forever

Twenty-Four Elders (Men)

Then in Rev 4:10, we have the Twenty-Four Elders or 24 Redeemed Men

- 24 Elders who worship God the Father on the throne who lives forever
- 24 Elders who cast their crowns before the throne
- 24 Elders who Proclaim God the Father Worthy, to receive glory and honor and power

Because they have "golden crowns on their heads", 4:4, and "will cast their crowns before the throne", 4:10. **Because Believers** "receive the crown of life, the Lord has promised to those who love Him", 2:10, Jas 1:12

Twenty-Four Elders - Worship the Father

In Rev 4:11, the Father is Worthy "Worthy......to receive glory and honor and power

the Father is Worthy, "for You created all things", 4:11

In Rev 5:9, the Lamb is Worthy "Worthy are You to take the book and to break its seals;

for You were slain, and purchased for God with Your blood

men from every tribe and tongue and people and nation.

In Rev 5:12, the Lamb is Worthy "Worthy is the Lamb that was slain

to receive **power** and **riches** and **wisdom** and **might** and **honor** and **glory** and **blessing**."

I. The Vision of the Throne Room in Heaven, 4:1–11

A. The throne in Heaven, with the Lord like Jasper stone, 4:1–3

- 1. Around the throne, 24 thrones with 24 Elders, 4:4
- 2. Before the throne, were 7 Lamps of Fire, the 7 Spirits of God, 4:5
- 3. Before the throne, there was something like a sea of glass, like crystal;
- 4. Around the throne, were 4 Living Creatures, full of eyes, 4:6
 - a. 4 Living Creatures like a lion, calf, man, eagle, with 6 Wings, full of eyes, Praising God, 4:7
 - b. 4 Living Creatures and 24 Elders, give Honor, Glory, and Worship to God, 4:8-11
