# Chapter One of Zechariah gives a Summary of the Entire Book

I. The word of the Lord came to Zechariah the Prophet, 1:1–6 (Oct-Nov) (520BC),

- A. 1 In the eighth month (Oct-Nov) of the second year of (Persian King) Darius (I) (520BC), 1:1
  - 1. the word of the Lord came to Zechariah the prophet, 1:1
- B. The Call for Israel to Repent and Return to the Lord, do not be like your fathers, 1:2-5
  - 1. 2 "The Lord was very angry (wrathful) with your fathers (Israel's).
     1:2
     [The Problem]
  - 2. 3 "Therefore (because of that) say to them, 'Thus says the Lord of hosts, 1:3

     a. "Return (turn back) to Me," declares the Lord of hosts,
     [The Solution to The Problem]
     i. "that I may return (turn back) to you," says the Lord of hosts.
  - 3. 4 "Do not be like your (Israel's) fathers, to whom the former prophets proclaimed, saying, 1:4
  - 4. 'Thus says the Lord of hosts, "Return now from your evil ways and from your evil deeds."'
- a. But they (your fathers) did not listen or give heed to Me," declares the Lord. [The Problem] C. Did not My words and Statutes overtake your fathers? 1:6
  - 1. 6 "But did not My words and My statutes, 1:6

a. which I commanded My servants the prophets, overtake your fathers? 1:6

2. Then they (your fathers) repented (turned) and said, 1:6 [The Problem Confessed] a. 'As the Lord of hosts purposed to do to us, 1:6

i. in accordance with our ways and our deeds, so He has dealt with us. 1:6

III. the angel of the LORD to the LORD of hosts how long will You, 1:12–17¶

A. 12 Then the angel of the LORD (Jesus) said, "O LORD of hosts (the Father),

[<mark>Q:</mark> How Long will You have <u>No Compassion</u> and be <u>Indignant</u> for Jerusalem and Judah ?]

- 1. how long will You (the Father) have no compassion for Jerusalem and the cities of Judah,
- 2. with which You (the Father) have been indignant these seventy years, 7:5?"
- B. 13 The LORD (the Father) answered the angel (of the Lord, Jesus) who was speaking with me
  1. with gracious words, comforting words.

C. 14 So the angel (of the Lord, Jesus) who was speaking with me said to me,

[A: Lord's Answer to: <u>No Compassion</u> and being <u>indignant</u> for Jerusalem and Judah ?] 1. "Proclaim, saying, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts (the Father),

[I am exceeding <u>Jealous</u> for Jerusalem and Zion]

2. "I am (the Father) exceedingly jealous for Jerusalem and Zion.

D. 15 "But I am (the Father) very angry with the nations who are at ease;

[I am very angry with The Nations]

- 1. for (Reason) while I was only a little angry, they (the nations) furthered the disaster."
- E. 16 'Therefore (because of that) thus says the LORD (the Father),

[I will return to Jerusalem with compassion]

- "I will (the Father) return to Jerusalem with compassion;
  - [My house (Temple) will be built in it (Jerusalem)]
- 2. My house (Temple) will be built in it (Jerusalem)," declares the LORD of hosts,
- 3. "and a **measuring line** will be stretched over Jerusalem." '
- F. 17 "Again, proclaim, saying, 'Thus says the LORD of hosts (the Father),

[My cities will again overflow with prosperity]

1. "My cities will again overflow with prosperity,

[the LORD will again <u>comfort</u> Zion and again <u>choose</u> Jerusalem] 2. and the LORD will <u>again comfort</u> Zion and <u>again choose</u> Jerusalem." ' "

#### So The Problem with Israel was:

**"The Lord** was <u>very angry</u> with your (Israel's) fathers

<mark>they</mark> (your fathers) <u>did **not listen** or give heed</u> to Me," declares the Lord

[<mark>Q:</mark> How Long will You have <u>No Compassion</u> and be <u>Indignant</u> for Jerusalem and Judah ?]

how long will You (the Father) have <u>no compassion</u> for Jerusalem and the cities of Judah, with which You (the Father) have been <u>indignant</u> these seventy years?"

[A: Lord's Answer to: <u>No Compassion</u> and being <u>indignant</u> for Jerusalem and Judah? Zech 1:12]

[I am exceeding <u>Jealous</u> for Jerusalem and Zion]

[<mark>I am very angry</mark> with The Nations]

[I will return to Jerusalem with compassion]

[My house (Temple) will be <u>built</u> in it (Jerusalem)]

[My cities will again overflow with prosperity]

[the LORD will again comfort Zion and again choose Jerusalem]

# So The Solution to The Problem with Israel:

Was that **the Lord** would Return to **Israel** with <u>Compassion</u> and Build **His Temple there**. Then **His** Cities will <u>Overflow with Prosperity</u> and **He** would again <u>Comfort</u> **Israel**.

<u>Compassion</u>: sympathetic pity and concern for the sufferings or misfortunes of others.

This Time will be in the Future Millennial Kingdom on Earth

#### Zechariah 2:10-12

10 "Sing for joy and be glad, O daughter of Zion;

for behold I am coming and I will dwell in your midst," declares the LORD.

11 "Many nations will join themselves to the LORD in that day and will become My people. Then I will <u>dwell</u> in your midst, and you will <u>know</u> that the LORD of hosts has <u>sent</u> Me to you.

12 "The LORD will possess Judah as His portion in the holy land, and will again choose Jerusalem.

## What about the 7 year Tribulation Period and the Antichrist ?

**Q:** But what about all those things that will occur that are <u>Not Mentioned</u> in the **Book of Zechariah** ? What about **the 7 year Tribulation Period** and **the Antichrist** ?

A: Zechariah is Prophesizing this between 520 BC and 480 BC, But just 20-60 years before, in 539 BC,

Daniel Prophesied of the 7 year Tribulation Period and the Antichrist.

# The Seventy Weeks have been Decreed for Your (Daniel's) People (Israel) and the Holy City

#### Read Daniel 9:1-2 + 9:20-23

The Angel Gabriel comes to give Daniel understanding (Dan 9:25) of the Vision, Daniel 9:20-23

#### Read Daniel 9:24-27

I. The Seventy Week Decree by Gabriel for Israel and Jerusalem, Daniel 9:24–27

- A. 24 "Seventy weeks (7 x 70 = 490 yrs) have been decreed (determined by authority)
   a. for your (Daniel's) people (Israel) and your (Daniel's) holy city (Jerusalem),
  - 1. (Decree) to finish the transgression (of Israel) (Dan 9:11),
  - 2. (Decree) to make an end of sin (of Israel) (Heb 9:26, Ezek 37:23, Ezek 36:24-28),
  - 3. (Decree) to make atonement (covering) for iniquity (sin act) (1 Pet 2:24, 1 Pet 3:18),
  - 4. (Decree) to bring in <u>everlasting</u> righteousness (of Israel) (Isa 60:21, Jer 23:5-6),
  - 5. (Decree) to seal up vision and prophecy (close or end, for lack of need)
  - 6. (Decree) and to <u>anoint</u> (make holy) the most holy place (the Temple).
- B. 25 "So you (Daniel) are to know and discern that
  - 1. from the issuing of a decree to <u>restore</u> and <u>rebuild</u> Jerusalem (Neh 2:1-9), 444 BC a. until Messiah the Prince (Jesus)
  - 2. there will be seven weeks (49 yrs) and sixty-two weeks (434 yrs); (49 + 434 = 483 yrs)
  - 3. it (Jerusalem) will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.
- C. 26 "Then after the sixty-two weeks (after, 483 yrs)
  - 1. the Messiah (Jesus) will be cut off (Killed) and have nothing,
  - and the people (Romans) of the prince (Antichrist) who is to <u>come</u> (little horn, Dan 7:8)
     a. will <u>destroy</u> the city and the sanctuary (Temple).
  - 3. And its (Jerusalem's), end will <u>come</u> with a flood (Nah 1:8);
    - a. even to **the end** there will be **war**;
    - b. desolations (destructions) are determined.
- D. 27 "And he (Antichrist) will make a firm covenant with the many (Israel) for one week (7 yrs),
  - 1. but in **the middle of the week** (after, 3 1/2 yrs)
    - a. **he** (Antichrist) will <u>put a stop</u> to **sacrifice** and **grain offering**; (implied, Temple)
  - 2. and on the wing of **abominations**
  - 3. will come **one** (Antichrist) who <u>makes desolate</u> (Matt 23:38),
  - 4. even until <u>a complete destruction</u>,
  - 5. one (Jesus) that is decreed, is poured out on the one (Antichrist) who makes desolate."

# In Dan 9:24, Seventy weeks (7 x 70 = 490 yrs) have been decreed (by God)

for (purpose) Daniel's people Israel and Daniel's holy city Jerusalem, [intended audience]

the Seventy weeks Decree has 6 Aspects that <u>must be fulfilled</u> during this 490 year period.

- 1. (Decree) to finish the transgression (of Israel) (Dan 9:11),
- 2. (Decree) to make an end of sin (of Israel) (Heb 9:26, Ezek 37:23, Ezek 36:24-28),
- 3. (Decree) to make atonement (covering) for iniquity (sin act) (1 Pet 2:24, 1 Pet 3:18),
- 4. (Decree) to bring in <u>everlasting</u> righteousness (of Israel) (Isa 60:21, Jer 23:5-6),
- 5. (Decree) to <u>seal up</u> vision and prophecy (close or end, for lack of need)
- 6. (Decree) and to <u>anoint</u> (make holy) the most holy place (the Temple).

Dan 9:25 "So you (Daniel) are to know and discern that

from the issuing of **a decree** to <u>restore</u> and <u>rebuild</u> Jerusalem (Neh 2:1-9), 444 BC until Messiah the Prince (Jesus)

there will be seven weeks (49 yrs) and sixty-two weeks (434 yrs); (49 + 434 = 483 yrs)

it (Jerusalem) will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.

from the issuing of a decree > to restore and rebuild Jerusalem.

There were **4 decrees** made by **Persian rulers** in reference to **the Jews**. **First** - **decree** of **Cyrus'** in **538 BC** (2 Chron 36:22–23, Ezra 1:1–4, 5:13), for rebuilding of **the temple Second** - **decree** of **Darius I** (522–486) in **520 B.C.** (Ezra 6:1, 6–12), for rebuilding of **the temple Third** - **decree** of **Artaxerxes Longimanus** (464–424) in **457 BC** (Ezra 7:11–26), for sacrifices in **the temple Fourth** - **decree** of **Artaxerxes Longimanus**, March 5, **444 BC** (Neh 2:1–8), **"to** <u>restore / rebuild</u> **Jerusalem"** 

Nehemiah was sad that Jerusalem "the city" was "desolate" (Neh 2:3)

"... If it please **the king**, and if **your** servant has found favor before **you**, send me to **Judah**, to **the city** of **my fathers'** tombs, that I may <u>rebuild</u> it (Jerusalem)." (Neh 2:5)

<mark>the Letters</mark> or <mark>Decree</mark> to <mark>"to <u>restore / rebuild</u> Jerusalem"</mark> > the Temple was already Built Nehemiah 2:7–8

7 ...."If it please the king, let letters be given me for the governors of the provinces beyond the River,... 8 and a letter to Asaph the keeper of the king's forest, that he may give me timber to make beams for the gates of the fortress which is by the temple, for the wall of the city and for the house to which I go."

And the king granted them (decree letters) to me because the good hand of my God was on me. from the issuing of a decree March 5, 444 BC > to restore and rebuild Jerusalem. until Messiah the Prince (Jesus) there will be 7 weeks (49 yrs) and 62 weeks (434 yrs);

49 years + 434 years = 483 Years

#### Dan 9:26

"... after the 62 weeks (483 yrs) the Messiah (Jesus) will be cut off (Killed) and have nothing,

But the Jewish Calendar has 360 days not 365 days? [Like Rev 11:2-3 has (42 mo = 1260 days)]
So 483 years x 360 days = 173,880 days, per Jewish Calendar & Prophetic Years
Then 173,880 days / 365 days = 476.38 years, per Gregorian Calendar
Then 476 years x 365 days = 173,740 days
Leap Year Adjustment: 476 years / 4 = 119 Days - 3 Days = 116 Days
3 days during a 400 cycle of years, are not leap years
Years: 300 BC, 200 BC, 100 BC, are not leap years. So minus 3 Days
Year: 400 BC, is leap year. So not subtracted
```

The Fourth Decree > by King Artaxerxes Longimanus, was Mar 5, 444 BC Then from March 5, 444 BC, plus 476 years = March 5, 33 AD (no year zero) 173,740 days + 116 days = 173,856 days to March 5, 33 AD Then 173,880 days - 173,856 days = 24 days to add Then March 5, 33 AD + 24 days = March 29, 33 AD > Jesus' Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem

the Messiah (Jesus) will be cut off (Killed) on Friday April 3, 33 AD

# The Decree: the 483 years



25 "So you (Daniel) are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree (444 BC) to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince (33 AD)

there will be **seven weeks** and **sixty-two weeks**; (69 wks or 483 years)

- It (Jerusalem) will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress,
- 26 "Then after the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary.....

# The First 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> years of 7 Year Tribulation Period

First > the Antichrist makes a firm Covenant with Israel for one week (7 years), Dan 9:27 For 3 ½ Years > the Antichrist is on good terms with Israel, according to Covenant with them, Dan 9:27 During 3 ½ Years > Israel Builds New Temple in Jerusalem, (implied, Dan 9:27) During 3 ½ Years > Israel will sacrifice and give offerings in the New Temple, (implied, Dan 9:27)

1st Stage, of the First 3 ½ Years, of 7 Year Tribulation "the Beginning of Sinth Pangs" > Before the Son Comes False Christs, Wars, Famines, and Earthquakes, Matt 24:4-8

But "is not yet the end", Matt 24:4-8

2nd Stage, of the First 3 ½ Years, of 7 Year Tribulation <u>the Middle of Birth Pangs</u> or "tribulation" > Before the Son Comes

"they will deliver you (Israel) to tribulation" Matt 24:9

Continuing "Birth Pangs" (more severe labor pains)

#### Matthew 24:9-14

9 "Then (after that) they will deliver you (Israel) to tribulation, and will kill you (Israel),

and you (Israel) will be <u>hated</u> by all nations because of My name.

- 10 "At that time many (people) will <u>fall away</u> and will <u>betray</u> one another and <u>hate</u> one another.
- 11 "Many false prophets will <u>arise</u> and will <u>mislead</u> many.
- 12 "Because <u>lawlessness</u> is <u>increased</u>, most <u>people's</u> love will grow cold.
- 13 "But **the one** (of Israel) who <u>endures</u> to <u>the end</u>, he (of Israel) will be <u>saved</u>.
- 14 "This **gospel of the kingdom** shall be <u>preached</u> in the whole world as a testimony to **all the nations**, and <u>then</u> (after that) <u>the end will **come**</u>. (24:6)

# The Second 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> years of 7 Year Tribulation Period

1st Stage, of the Second 3 1/2 Years, of 7 Year Tribulation

the Final most severe (Great) Birth Pangs > Just Before the Son Comes WHEN you (of Israel) see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION (the Antichrist) standing in the holy place (New Temple), Matt 24:15, 2 Thes 2:1-4

## 2nd Stage, of the Second <u>3 <sup>1</sup>/2</u> Years, of **7 Year Tribulation**

THEN **you** (of Israel) **flee** and <u>take **flight**</u> and **don't turn back** for any reason, Matt 24:16 Matthew 24:15–20

15 "Therefore (for that reason) WHEN you (of Israel) see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION (2 Thes 2:1-4) which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, (Dan 9:27)

standing in the holy place (Israel's New Temple) (let the reader understand),

16 THEN **those** (of Israel) who are in Judea must <u>flee</u> to the mountains.

- 17 "Whoever (of Israel) is on the housetop <u>must **not** go down to **get the things** out that are in **his** house.</u>
- 18 "Whoever (of Israel) is in the field <u>must **not turn back**</u> to get **his** cloak.
- 19 "But **woe** to **those** (of Israel) who are pregnant and to **those** who are nursing babies in those days!

20 "But pray that **your** (of Israel) <u>flight</u> will not be in the winter, or on a **Sabbath** (of Israel).

# 3rd Stage, of the Second 3 ½ Years, of **7 Year Tribulation** - a Great Tribulation

THEN (at that time of **the apostasy**) there will be **a great tribulation**, Matt 24:21

the Final most severe (Great) Birth Pangs or <u>a great tribulation</u> > Before the Son Comes Matthew 24:21-22

21 "For (reason) then (at that time of the apostasy) there will be <u>a great tribulation</u>, such as <u>has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now, nor ever will</u>. (Dan 12:1)

- 22 "Unless <u>those days</u> (of Great Tribulation) had been <u>cut short</u>, no life would have been saved; but for the sake of the elect (chosen of Israel) those days will be <u>cut short</u>.
  - "the Beginning of Birth Pangs" > First Part of First 3 ½ Years
  - the Middle of Birth Pangs or "tribulation" > Second Part of First 3 ½ Years
  - the Final most severe (Great) Birth Pangs or a great tribulation.
  - the Birth Pangs End > the Son Comes or is delivered after much Birth Pain > After 7 Years

# Great Tribulation is a Unique Time for Israel

#### Daniel 12:1

1 "Now at that time Michael, the great prince who stands guard over

the sons of your (Daniel's) people (Israel), will arise.

[Michael Guarding Daniel's People, the Nation of Israel]

And there will be **a time of distress** such as never occurred since there was a nation until **that time**; (Mt 24:21) and **at that time your** (Daniel's) **people** (Israel), **everyone** who is found written in the book (of Life), will be **rescued**.

# <mark>a time of distress</mark> for Daniel's People Israel

everyone who is found written in the book (of Life) (chosen of Israel), will be rescued. "the book (of Life)" (Mal 3:16–4:3, Luke 10:20, Rev 13:8, 17:8, 20:12, 20:15, 21:27) "will be rescued" (Rev 12:12-17)

# The Decree: the 7 years



27a "And he (the prince who is to come, <u>AntiChrist</u>) will make a firm covenant with the many (11:33, 39, 12:3) for one week, (<u>7 year</u> Covenant, with Israel) (for 7 years, the 70 th Week)

but in the middle of **the week** (at the 3 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> year) **he** (AntiChrist) will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; (Dan 11:31, 12:11)

# the Coming of the Son of Man, "immediately after the tribulation of those days"

# the Coming of the Son of Man, Just as the lightning flashes

Just as the lightning flashes, so will the (Second) coming of the Son of Man be the SAME WAY Lightning Comes, the Son will Come

#### the Birth Pangs End > the Son Comes or is delivered after much Birth Pain Matthew 24:27-28

27 "For (reason) just as the lightning <u>comes</u> from the east and <u>flashes</u> even to the west, (Lk 17:24) so will **the** (Second) **coming** of **the Son of Man** be.

28 "Wherever the corpse is, there the vultures will gather. (Lk 17:37, Rev 19:17-18, Great Supper of God)

## **the Coming** of **the Son of Man, Sun** and **Moon Darkened, Stars** Fall, and Heavens Shaken Matthew 24:29

29 "But <u>immediately after</u> the tribulation of those days [after the 7 years of Tribulation]

THE SUN WILL BE DARKENED, AND THE MOON WILL NOT GIVE ITS LIGHT,

AND THE **STARS** WILL <u>FALL</u> from the sky, and the powers of the heavens will be <u>shaken</u>.

Many Verses speak of this DARKENING (Rev 6:12-17, Acts 2:20, Isa 13:10, Joel 2:10, Joel 2:31....) All Light from Sun, Moon, and Stars will be Turned Off, DARKNESS

- First the DARKNESS
- > THEN out of the DARKNESS the Son of Man Comes, like a Flash of Lightning
- THEN the Son of Man, will <u>APPEAR</u> in the Sky with power and great glory

#### the Coming of the Son of Man, will APPEAR in the Sky

#### Matthew 24:30-31

30 "And **then the sign** of **the Son of Man** will <u>APPEAR</u> in the sky, (Matt 16:27, Matt 25:31) and then all the tribes (of Israel) of the earth will mourn,

and they will <u>SEE</u> the SON OF MAN COMING ON THE CLOUDS OF THE SKY with power and great glory. 31 "And He will <u>send forth</u> His angels with A GREAT TRUMPET

and THEY WILL GATHER TOGETHER His elect (chosen of Israel)

from the four winds, from one end of the sky to the other.

#### the Coming of the Son of Man,

- all the tribes of the earth will mourn
- they will <u>SEE</u> The Son of Man Coming on the Clouds of the Sky with Power and Great Glory.
- He will send forth His angels with A Great Trumpet
- they (angels) will gather together His elect (chosen of Israel)

#### Matthew 24:32-34

32 "Now learn the parable from **the fig tree:** when **its** branch has already become tender and puts forth **its** leaves, **you** (of Israel) <u>know</u> that summer is <u>near</u>;

33 so, you (of Israel) too, <u>when</u> you (of Israel) <u>SEE</u> all these things,

recognize that **He** is **near**, right at the door.

34 "Truly I say to you (of Israel), this generation will not pass away until all these things take place.

# When Israel is able to "SEE all these things" "take place", mentioned in Matt 24:4-31

**Q:** "this generation" <u>cannot</u> refer to the generation living at that time of **Christ** can it ? for "all those things"

for "all these things"

the abomination of desolation (the Antichrist) (v. 15),

the persecutions and judgments (vv. 17–22),

the sun and moon darkened (v. 29),

Jesus coming on the Clouds (v. 30),

the gathering of the **elect** (v. 31)

did not "take place" in **that generation's** lifetime or anytime during the last 2000 years did they ?

# Q: that generation didn't "SEE" " "all these things" occur did they ?

Q: Jesus <u>didn't</u> come in the first century "with power and great glory" and "gather His Elect" did He?

Some Commentators want to move "all these things" of Jesus' Coming to 70 AD?

"Its plain and obvious reference is to **the contemporaries** of the speaker, or **those** who shall live some thirty or forty years longer; this period would bring **them** to the siege of Jerusalem (70 AD)" Pulpit Commentary

Q: Jesus <u>didn't</u> come in 70 AD "with power and great glory" and "gather His Elect" did He ? that generation, in 70 AD, <u>didn't</u> "SEE" "all these things" occur did they ?
