Why Study the Covenants in the Bible?

Covenants as a Framework for a Biblical Theology

Or a way of looking for God's Overall Plan for Man through Covenant Promises

COVENANT Definition - Conclusion:

COVENANT of GOD with MAN. A Promise of God, always initiated by God,

between God and a Person or a People Group, according to His Plan, Purpose and Will.

IF the Covenant specified certain binding conditions for God to fulfill both parties' obligations then it was considered a Unilateral or Un-Conditional Covenant.

IF the Covenant specified certain binding conditions for God to fulfill, God's Part, and separate conditions for Man to fulfill, Man's Part,

then it was considered a Bi-lateral or Conditional Covenant.

Covenants seen as under Various Dispensations

"In theology, one meaning of the term **dispensation** is as a distinctive **arrangement** or **period in history** that forms the **framework** through which **God** relates to **mankind**." wikipedia

- Covenants under Dispensations > from Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology)
- 2. Covenants under Dispensations > from Dispensational Theology

Dispensational Theology,

is most known for using **Dispensations** to explain their **Theology**

Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology),

is most known for using Covenants to explain their Theology

BUT, Both Reformed Theology and Dispensational Theology,

use **Dispensations** with their **Theology**

AND, Both Reformed Theology and Dispensational Theology,

use Covenants with their Theology

Dispensational Theology,

follows their Covenants chronologically as progressively revealed in OT, Genesis to Malachi Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology),

Does Not follow their Covenants chronologically as progressively revealed in OT.

It uses Covenant of Redemption, revealed in NT first, ("New is in the Old Concealed") then Covenant of Works, revealed in in OT,

then Covenant of Grace, as seen in OT and NT

Theological Covenants and Non-Theological Covenants

Theological Covenants > Covenants according to a particular Biblical Theology, they use

the Bible (Not Alone) along with <u>adopted</u> Confessions, Creeds, Catechisms, Church Father's writings, Reformation + Post-Reformation writings, Commentaries and Theologies.


As in, Augustine, Medieval Church, Catholic Church, Protestant Reformation and Post-Reformation

Non-Theological Covenants > Covenants Not according to a particular Biblical Theology, they use the Bible (Alone), without adopted Confessions, Creeds, Catechisms, Church Father's writings,

Reformation + Post-Reformation writings, Commentaries and Theologies.


Scripture alone Used, usually in a Chronological Progressive Order given in Bible.

1647 - Westminster Confession of Faith [Reformed and Covenant Theology] 2 Covenants: 1st Covenant of Works and 2nd Covenant of Grace





Reformed Theology is Covenant Theology

3 Covenants: 1st Covenant of Redemption, 2nd Covenant of Works, 3rd Covenant of Grace



Reformed Theology is Covenant Theology





Covenants given to All Mankind

Some Covenants apply to **All Mankind** like the Covenant with **Adam**. It applied to all **those** born after **him**, **his** future **descendants**. **Everyone** ever born is a **descendant** of **Adam**, except **Christ** who is the **seed** of the woman and not the **physical descendant** of **Adam** but of the **Holy Spirit** as the **son of God**, Lk 1:35.

Another Covenant applied to All Mankind is the Covenant with Noah. All people on the earth were corrupt, except Noah, so the Lord said He would destroy them and the earth, Gen 6:13. It applied to all those born after him, his future descendants or seed, Shem, Ham, and Japheth, Gen 6:10, Gen 10 & 11.

Covenants given to the Nation of Israel

Covenant with Abraham

PART 1 applied first to Abraham's physical descendants, the Nation of Israel (Abraham to Christ, in OT)
"I will make you (Abraham) a Great Nation", Gen 12:2.

PART 2 applied next to **all families** or **nations**, everyone Not of the **Nation of Israel** (the **Gentiles**) "in **you** (Abraham) <u>all families</u> (nations) blessed", Gen 12:3, Acts 3:25.

Covenant with Moses

Applies to Abraham's physical descendants, the Nation of Israel, Read Exodus 19:1-6
No Gentiles involved

Covenant with David

Applies to Abraham's physical descendants, the Nation of Israel

David to be ruler over the Lord's People (Israel) forever, Read 2 Sam 7:8, 7:16

No Gentiles involved

The New Covenant

Given to Abraham's physical descendants, the Nation of Israel Read Jer 31:31-34

PART 1 applied first in NT to Abraham's physical descendants, the Nation of Israel a "chosen" "remnant" of the Nation of Israel, the rest were hardened. Read Rom 11:1-10 The "chosen" "remnant", "devote Jews from every nation" Read Acts 2:5, 2:41, 4:4, 21:20 Read Rom 11:25-32


"this mystery..... that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in; Rom 11:25

"then all Israel will be saved", Rom 11:26

When Saved? When "the Deliver comes and removes all ungodliness from Jacob", Rom 11:27

PART 2 applied next to **all families** or **nations**, everyone Not of the **Nation of Israel** (the **Gentiles**) Then "**chosen**" of the **Gentiles**, that will be **saved**, before the **Deliverer** comes, Rom 11:26
First **Saul** (Paul) was "**chosen**" by **the Lord** to go to the **Gentiles**, **Read** Acts 9:15
Then, "the **Holy Spirit** is poured out on the **Gentiles**", **Read** Acts 10:43-11:1
The **Holy Spirit** is poured out, until "the fullness of the **Gentiles**"

or until all "chosen" Gentiles have been saved, that will be saved, before the Deliverer comes, Rom 11:26



All saved of the Nation of Israel and saved of the Gentiles, are Sons of Abraham

(1) **All saved** of the **Nation of Israel** that are <u>physical</u> **Sons of Abraham**OR All those **descendants** from **Abraham's body**, will be <u>heirs</u>, <u>Read</u> Gen 15:4

Galatians 3:7

7 "Therefore, be sure that it is <u>those</u> who are of <u>faith</u> who are <u>sons</u> of <u>Abraham</u>." Those of <u>faith</u> > of <u>physical</u> Sons of <u>Abraham</u>, of the <u>Nation of Israel</u>

(2) **All saved** of the **Gentiles** that are <u>Not physical</u> **Sons of Abraham**OR All **saved** of the **Gentiles** that are *spiritual* **Sons of Abraham**

Galatians 3:7

7 "Therefore, be sure that it is <u>those</u> who are <u>of faith</u> who are <u>sons</u> <u>of Abraham</u>." Those <u>of faith</u> > of <u>spiritual</u> Sons of Abraham, of the <u>Gentiles</u>

Galatians 3:8–9

8 The Scripture, foreseeing that **God** would justify the **Gentiles** <u>by faith</u>, preached the **gospel** beforehand to **Abraham**, saying,

"ALL THE NATIONS (All families) WILL BE BLESSED IN YOU." (from Gen 12:3, we read)

9 So then those (either Jew or Gentile) who are of faith are blessed with Abraham, the believer.

This is the mystery, that Gentiles are fellow heirs with Israel, Read Eph 3:1-7


"to bring to light what is the **administration** of the **mystery**which for **ages** has been **hidden** in **God** who created all things, Eph 3:9, Col 1:26-27

The mystery concerning the Gentiles, Eph 3:6

That the Gentiles: are fellow heirs (with Israel)

That the **Gentiles:** <u>fellow members</u> of the **body** (of Christ) (with Israel)

That the Gentiles: fellow partakers of the promise (New Cov), Eph 3:1-6, (with Israel)



The Mystery of Israel's Hardening

that Israel partially Hardened

Romans 11:25

25 For I do not want you, brethren, to be uninformed of this mystery

..... that a partial hardening has happened to Israel until the fullness of the Gentiles has come in; Romans 11:7–10

7 What then? What Israel is seeking, it has not obtained,

but **those** (of Israel) who were **chosen** obtained it, and the rest (of Israel) were **hardened**; 8 just as it is written, (from Isa 6:9-10)

"God gave them a spirit of stupor, Eyes to see not and ears to hear not, Down to this very day." (Israel Hardened)

(Isa 6:9-10, Matt 13:14-15, Mark 4:12, Luke 8:10, John 12:40, Acts 28:26-27, Rom 11:8, 2 Cor 3:14) 9 And David says,

"Let their table become a snare and a trap, And a stumbling block and a retribution to them. 10 "Let their eyes be darkened to see not, And bend their backs forever." (Israel Hardened, until given a heart to know God, Jer 31:33, Ezek 36:25-28)

The Mystery of Gentiles

that the **Gentiles** are fellow **heirs**, **members**, and **partakers** of **promise** (with **Israel**), Eph 3:6 Ephesians 3:1–6

- 1 For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of you Gentiles—
- 2 if indeed you have heard of the stewardship of God's grace which was given to me for you;
- 3 that by revelation there was made known to me the mystery, as I wrote before in brief.
- 4 By referring to this, when you read you can understand my insight into the mystery of Christ,
- 5 which in other generations was **not** made **known** to the **sons** of men,

as it has now been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit;

6 to be specific, (about Mystery)

that the Gentiles are fellow heirs (with Israel)

and <u>fellow</u> members (with Israel) of the body, (of Christ)

and <u>fellow partakers</u> (with Israel) of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel,
