THE LORD'S - COVENANTS OF PROMISE

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Our Approach to the Study of Covenants

We are studying the **Covenants** for ourselves. [Not adopting an existing Theology on Covenants]
We are starting in Genesis and working forward through the Old Testament to understand
how they are **Chronologically** and **Progressively Revealed** and how each **Covenant** builds on
or does not build on each previous **Covenant**.

The **COVENANT Definition – Update One**

COVENANT Definition: Update One

COVENANT of GOD. A Promise of God, always <u>initiated</u> and <u>established</u> by God, Gen 6:18, 9:9, 11, 17 <u>between</u> God and a Person, a People Group, or all Living things, Gen 9:10, Gen 9:17, according to His Plan, Purpose and Will.

COVENANT of GOD. as "Promises", often with "I will" or "I shall" statements, that "will come to pass". IF the Covenant specified certain binding conditions for God to fulfill both parties' obligations then it was considered a Unilateral or Un-Conditional Covenant.

IF the Covenant specified certain binding conditions for God to fulfill, God's Part, and separate conditions for Man to fulfill, Man's Part,

then it was considered a Bi-lateral or Conditional Covenant.

COVENANT of GOD, often has offered burnt (killed) offerings, Gen 8:20, Gen 22:2, Rom 8:3

COVENANT of GOD, often has "a sign" to "remember" or to identify with, that Covenant, Gen 9:12

COVENANT of GOD, is often identified as an "everlasting covenant", Gen 9:16, Gen 17:7, Jer 32:40

Interpretation: Context or Meaning

No Verse of Scripture should be interpreted by itself!

"No Verse is an Island; it is always connected to the Mainland!"

Rule of Context: "A Text, Out of Context, Becomes a Pretext, for a Proof Text!"

Context (Immediate > Near > Far)

"the text or speech that comes

immediately before and after a particular phrase or piece of text and that influence how it is used and what it means" Cambridge Dictionary

Pretext (Out of Context)

"a pretended reason (not the real reason) for doing something that is used to hide the real reason" Cambridge Dictionary

The Meaning of The Text

Don't ask, "What does The Text mean to me?"

The meaning of The Text, is always the author's intended meaning.

The meaning of The Text, is what it meant to the original recipients (audience).

The Text always means, what it has always meant.

GOD'S COVENANT WITH ABRAHAM AND HIS DESCENDANTS - PART 4A

Working Outline > Genesis 17:1-8 (a Paragraph ¶ from NAS Bible)

Read Genesis 17:1-8 Abram was 99 years old, Gen 17:1, Sarai 90 years, 17:17, Ishmael 13 years (99-86=13yrs) Genesis 17:1–8

- I. 1 Now when Abram was ninety-nine years old,
 - A. the Lord (Yahweh) appeared to Abram and said to him, (Gen 12:7, 18:1)
 - 1. "I am God Almighty (El Shaddai); (Gen 28:3, 35:11)
 - 2. Walk before Me, and be blameless.
 - 3. 2 "I will establish My covenant (Gen 15:18) between Me and you,
 - 4. And I will multiply you exceedingly." (Gen 13:6, 15:5)
 - B. 3 Abram fell on his face, and God (Elohim) talked with him, saying,
 - 1. 4 "As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you,
 - 2. And you will be the father (Non-Physical father) of a multitude of nations. (12:2, Rom 4:11)
 - 3. 5 "No longer shall your name be called Abram (exalted Father),
 - a. But your name shall be Abraham (Father of multitude);
 - b. For (Reason) I will make you the father of a multitude of nations. (12:2, Rom 4:11)
 - 4. 6 "I have made (will make) you exceedingly fruitful, (Fulfilled, Ex 1:7)
 - 5. and I will make nations of you, (12:2, Rom 4:11)
 - 6. and kings will come forth from you. (Gen 17:16, Jacob, 35:11)
 - 7. 7 "I will establish My covenant between Me and you
 - a. and your descendants (seed) after you
 - b. throughout their generations for an everlasting covenant,
 - i. to be God (Elohim) to you and to your descendants (seed) after you.
 - C. 8 "I will give to you and to your descendants (seed) after you,
 - 1. the land of your sojournings (temporary Living place),
 - a. all the land of Canaan, (12:7, 15:8)
 - i. for an everlasting possession; (Acts 7:5)
 - 2. and I will be their (your descendant's) God (Elohim)."

Abram's Problem - Being both Childless and having innumerable Descendants

First Abram was "childless", 15:2, has "no offspring", 15:3, at 85 years old (86-1), 16:16, Sarai <u>barren</u>, 16:1 Second Abram assumes "one born in my house is my <u>heir</u>", 15:3, Eliezer of Damascus, 15:2 but the Lord says, "one who will come forth from your own body, he shall be your <u>heir</u>." 15:4 This established, by promise, that Abram's <u>heir</u> will be a <u>physical descendant</u> from his "own body"

Third Abram, 86 years old, has son Ishmael through Hagar, 16:4, 16:16. Sarai still <u>barren</u>, 16:1

Ishmael seems to fulfill promise, of Abram's <u>heir</u> will be a <u>physical descendant</u> from <u>his "own body"?</u>

Ishmael will become a great Nation with many <u>descendants</u>, 16:11, 17:20

Fourth Abram, 13 years later at 99 years old, God appears to him concerning His covenant with Abram.

Abrahamic Covenant was established "between" Abraham and His Physical descendants

- (1) Covenant established "between" God and Abraham Personally
 - "I will establish My covenant (Gen 15:18) between Me and you (Abram)", 17:2, 17:4, 17:7
 - "As for Me, behold, My covenant is with you (Abram)", 17:4
- (2) Covenant established "between" God and Abraham and Abraham's Physical descendants
 "I will establish My covenant between Me and you (Abram), and your descendants after you", 17:7
 - "I will multiply you exceedingly", 17:7. Same as: Making Abram, into a great nation, 12:2
 - The Covenant is "between", 17:2, 7, 10, 11, or "with", 17:4, Abram and his Physical Descendants.
- (3) Covenant established Abraham as the (Non-Physical father) of a multitude of nations, 17:4,Rom 4:11

 Same as: Blessing in Abram, of all families (nations) (Non-Physical Descendants), Gen 12:2

 Read Rom 4:11, "so that he might be the father (spiritual Father), of all who believe...."

Abrahamic Covenant's - 8 Promises, in Genesis 17:1-8

- I. I will establish My covenant (Gen 15:18) between Me and you and your descendants, 17:2, 17:4, 17:7
 - 1. I will multiply you exceedingly." 17:2, 17:6 (Gen 13:6, 15:5) (Fulfilled, Ex 1:7)
 - 2. Abram will be the father (Non-Physical father) of a multitude of nations. (12:2, Rom 4:11)
 - 3. No longer called Abram (exalted Father), But Abraham (Father of multitude);
 - a. For (Reason) I will make you the father of a multitude of nations. (12:2, Rom 4:11)
 - 4. I will make nations of you, (12:2, Rom 4:11)
 - 5. Kings will come forth from you. (Gen 17:16, Jacob, 35:11)
 - 6. My covenant will be an everlasting covenant, 17:7
 - 7. I will be God (Elohim) to you and to your descendants (seed) after you. 17:7, 17:8
 - 8. I will give to you and to your descendants (seed) after you,
 - a. the land of your sojournings, all the land of Canaan, (17:8, 12:7, 15:8)
 - b. for an everlasting possession; (17:8, Acts 7:5)

GOD'S COVENANT WITH ABRAHAM AND HIS DESCENDANTS — PART 4B

Working Outline > Genesis 17:9–14 (a Paragraph ¶ from NAS Bible)

Read Genesis 17:9–14 Abram was 99 years old, Gen 17:1, Sarai 90 years, 17:17, Ishmael 13 years (99-86=13yrs)

- I. 9 God said further to Abraham,
 - A. "Now as for you (Abraham), you shall keep My covenant,
 - 1. you and your descendants (Physical seed) after you
 - 2. throughout their generations.
 - B. 10 "This is My covenant, which you shall keep,
 - a. between Me and you and your descendants (seed) after you:
 - 2. every male among you shall be circumcised.
 - 3. 11 "And you shall be circumcised in the flesh of your foreskin,
 - a. and it (circumcision) shall be the sign of the covenant between Me and you.
 - 4. 12 "And every male among you who is eight days old shall be circumcised
 - a. throughout your generations,
 - 5. a **servant** who is born in the house or who is bought with money from any foreigner,
 - a. who is <u>not</u> of **your descendants** (seed).
 - b. 13 "A servant who is born in your house or who is bought with your money
 - c. shall surely be **circumcised**;
 - d. thus shall My covenant be in your flesh for an everlasting covenant.
 - 6. 14 "But an uncircumcised male who is not circumcised in the flesh of his foreskin,
 - a. that person shall be cut off (separated) from his people;
 - i. he has broken (failed) My covenant."

Q1: In verse 10, Who is to be circumcised? A1: "every male among you shall be circumcised"> All ages

Q2: In verse 12, Who is to be **circumcised**? **A2:** "every male eight days old shall be **circumcised** > Babies

Q3: In verses 12-13, Who is to be **circumcised**?

A3: a servant born in the house or bought with money, not of your descendants, shall be circumcised.

Q4: In verse 14, what will become of un-circumcised males?

A4: that person shall be cut off (separated) from his people; he has broken (failed) My covenant.

Q5: In verse 11, who is the sign of the covenant between?

A5: between God and Abram

The Purpose of Circumcision

Circumcision identified <u>outwardly</u> those <u>circumcised males</u> with <u>God's Covenant Promise</u> with <u>Abram</u>

Circumcision identified males and their descendants, in procreation, with the Covenant Promise.

Circumcision identified Covenant Promise to "be in your flesh", 17:13, and outward sign. Read Acts 7:8

Circumcision identified circumcised descendants of Abram, with the Nation of Israel, Read Eph 2:11-12

Circumcision of the Heart

Moses said that God would circumcise the hearts of His people to love Him (Deut 30:6).

Paul wrote that "circumcision of the heart" was being inwardly set apart "by the Spirit" (Rom 2:25-29,4:11). Unbelief is described as having an un-circumcised heart (Jer 9:26, Ezek 44:7–9).

GOD'S COVENANT WITH ABRAHAM AND HIS DESCENDANTS - PART 4C

Working Outline > Genesis 17:15-21 (a Paragraph ¶ from NAS Bible)

Read Genesis 17:15-21 Abram was 99 years old, Gen 17:1, Sarai 90 years, 17:17, Ishmael 13 years (99-86=13yrs)

- I. 15 Then God said to Abraham, "As for Sarai your wife,
 - A. you shall not call her name Sarai, but Sarah (princess) shall be her name.
 - B. 16 "I will bless her, and indeed I will give you a son by her.
 - C. Then I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations;
 - 1. kings of peoples will come from her."
- II. 17 Then Abraham fell on his face and laughed, and said in his heart,
 - A. "Will a child be born to a man one hundred years old?
 - B. And will Sarah, who is ninety years old, bear a child?"
- III. 18 And Abraham said to God, "Oh that Ishmael might live before You!"
 - A. 19 But God said, "No, but Sarai your wife will bear you a son,
 - 1. and you shall call his name Isaac;
 - 2. and I will establish My covenant with him, 17:21
 - a. for an everlasting covenant
 - b. for his descendants after him.
- IV. 20 "As for Ishmael, I have heard you;
 - A. behold, I will bless him,
 - B. and will make him fruitful and will multiply him exceedingly.
 - C. He shall become the father of twelve princes,
 - D. and I will make him a great nation.
- V. 21 "But My covenant I will establish with Isaac, 17:19
 - A. whom Sarah will bear to you at this season next year."

Abraham's New Name means (Father of multitude), the father of a multitude of nations, back in Gen 17:5 Sarah's New Name means (princess) and shall be (a mother of nations), here in Gen 17:16

They together will be the Father and Mother of a multitude of nations

Q1: In verse 16, What are 3 things God will do for Sarah?

- A1: (1) I will bless her, and give you a son by her.
 - (2) I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations;
 - (3) Kings of peoples will come from her."
- Q2: In verse 19, What are the 3 provisions of Isaac's Covenant?
- A2: (1) I will establish My covenant with him
 - (2) I will establish My covenant "for an everlasting covenant"
 - (3) I will establish My covenant "for his descendants after him"
- Q3: In verse 20, What are the 3 provisions of Ishmael's Covenant?
- A3: (1) I will bless him
 - (2) I will make him fruitful and will multiply him exceedingly
 - (3) He shall become the father of twelve princes
 - (4) I will make him a great nation

The Promise of giving you all the land of Canaan for an everlasting possession, 17:8, 12:7, 15:8, Acts 7:5

What we learned about the Abrahamic Covenant Promises, in Gen 17:9-14

God said to Abraham, you and your descendants after you shall keep My covenant, 17:9

This is My covenant, which you shall keep, every male among you shall be circumcised, 17:10

circumcision shall be the sign of the covenant between Me and you, 17:11

every male among you who is eight days old shall be circumcised, 17:12

every **servant** who is born or bought who is <u>not</u> of **your descendants** shall be **circumcised**, 17:12

thus shall My covenant be in your flesh (outward sign) for an everlasting covenant, 17:13, Acts 7:8

All uncircumcised males shall be cut off (separated) from his people, 17:14

All uncircumcised males have broken (failed) My covenant. 17:14

What we learned about the Abrahamic Covenant Promises, in Gen 17:15-21

The Promise of God said you shall not call her name Sarai, but Sarah (princess), 17:15

The Promise of I will bless her, and indeed I will give you a son by her, 17:15

The Promise of I will bless her, and she shall be a mother of nations, 17:16

The Promise of kings of peoples will come from her, 17:16

The Promise of Sarai your wife will bear you a son, and you shall call his name Isaac; 17:19

The Promise of I will establish My covenant with him (Isaac), 17:19, 17:21

The Promise of establishing My covenant for an everlasting covenant for (Isaac's) descendants, 17:19,

The Promise of My covenant I will establish with Isaac, 17:19

The Lord appeared as a Man and 2 Angels appeared as Men, to Abraham, and Ate.

Read Genesis 18:1-8



Read Genesis 18:9-15 Abram was 99 years old, Gen 17:1, Sarai 90 years, 17:17, Ishmael 13 years (99-86=13yrs)

- I. 9 Then they (the Lord and 2 Angels) said to him, "Where is Sarah your wife?"
 - A. And he said, "There, in the tent."
- II. 10 He (the Lord) said, "I will surely return to you at this time next year; 21:1
 - A. and behold, Sarah your wife will have a son." 17:9
 - B. And Sarah was listening at the tent door, which was behind him.
 - C. 11 Now Abraham and Sarah were old, advanced in age;
 - D. Sarah was past childbearing.
 - E. 12 Sarah laughed to herself, saying,
 - F. "After I have become old, shall I have pleasure, my lord (Abraham) being old also?"
- III. 13 And the Lord said to Abraham,
 - A. "Why did Sarah laugh, saying, 'Shall I indeed bear a child, when I am so old?"
 - B. 14 "Is anything too difficult for the Lord?
 - C. At the appointed time I will return to you, at this time next year,
 - D. and Sarah will have a son." 21:1
- IV. 15 Sarah denied it (laughing) however, saying, "I did not laugh";
 - A. for she was afraid. And He said, "No, but you did laugh."
- Q1: In verses 10 and 14, What 2 part promise, does the Lord promise will happen concerning Sarah?
- A1: (1) "I will surely return to you at this time next year" (2) "Sarah your wife will have a son"
- Q2: In verse 14, "Is anything too difficult for the Lord? Read Jer 32:17, Matt 19:26, Rom 4:21
- A2: No, Nothing is too difficult for the Lord
- Q2: In verse 14, What does "the appointed time" of the Lord tell us about His Plans?
- **A2: the Lord** has certain **appointed times** for everything that is to occur, all according to **His Plan** and **Purpose**. There is No chance that it will fail. **Read** Gen 21:1

- I. 18 since Abraham will surely become a great and mighty nation, Gen 12:2
 - A. and in him all the nations of the earth will be blessed? Gen 12:2
 - B. 19 "For (Reason) I have chosen (know) him,
 - C. so that (Reason) he may command his children and his household after him
 - 1. to keep the way of the Lord
 - a. by doing righteousness and justice,
 - 2. so that (Reason) the Lord may bring upon Abraham what He has spoken about him."
