#### Our Approach to the Study of Covenants

We are studying the Covenants for ourselves. [Not adopting an existing Theology on Covenants]
We are starting in Genesis and working forward through the Old Testament to understand
how they are Chronologically and Progressively Revealed and how each Covenant builds on
or does not build on each previous Covenant.



#### COVENANT Definition - A Covenant of God is a Promise of God that will come to pass

#### **COVENANT Definition: Final**

COVENANT of GOD. A Promise of God, always initiated and established by God, Gen 6:18, 9:9, 11, 17

between God and a Person, a People Group, or all Living things, Gen 9:10, Gen 9:17,

according to His Plan, Purpose, and Will.

COVENANT of GOD, as "Promises", often with "I will" or "I shall" statements, that "will come to pass".

IF the Covenant specified certain binding conditions for God to fulfill both parties' obligations then it was considered a Unilateral or Un-Conditional Covenant.

IF the Covenant specified certain binding conditions for God to fulfill, God's Part, and separate conditions for Man to fulfill, Man's Part,

then it was considered a Bi-lateral or Conditional Covenant.

COVENANT of GOD, often has offered burnt (killed) offerings, Gen 8:20, Gen 22:2, Ex 24:5, Rom 8:3

COVENANT of GOD, often has "a sign" to "remember" or to identify with, that Covenant, Gen 9:12

COVENANT of GOD, is often identified as an "everlasting (perpetual) Covenant", Gen 9:16, Gen 17:7, Jer 32:40

COVENANT of GOD, may be Ratified with Blood, Ex 24:5-8, Gal 3:15-17, Heb 9:15-22, 13:20

COVENANT of GOD, may be Ratified by passing between cut animals, Gen 15:10, 17, Jer 34:18

COVENANT of GOD, may be Ratified by Swearing and/or by Oath, Gen 26:3, 50:24, Num 14:15–16, Deut 7:6–9,

Deut 9:5, 29:9-15, 1 Chron 16:13-18, Ps 105:6-11, Jer 11:1-5, Ezek 16:59-60, Lk 1:67-74, Acts 2:29-31, Heb 6:16-18

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#### How Many Covenants are there in the Bible?

The list of Covenants given by most Commentators writing on the Covenants are only referring to what they see as the Major Covenants or Primary Covenants in the Bible.

Most Commentators don't give you all the Covenants in the **Bible** but just the most significant Covenants necessary to understand **God's promises** according to their particular **Biblical Theology**.

Other Commentators explain that there are Major Covenants and Minor Covenants, like when talking about Major and Minor Prophets in scripture.

Other Commentators say that there are Major Covenants

with **Sub-Covenants** or **Subordinate Covenants** or **Supplementary Covenants** underneath them.

### Dispensational Theology and Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology)

Dispensational Theology,

is most known for using Dispensations to explain their Theology

Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology),

is most known for using Theological Covenants to explain their Theology


BUT, Both Reformed Theology and Dispensational Theology,


use **Dispensations** with their **Theology**

use Covenants with their Theology


# Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology): Theological Covenants with either 2 or 3 Major Theological Covenants + Sub-Covenants






**Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology):** is based on **their** particular traditional **Theological Covenants**Combining a **Literal Interpretation** with **their Confessions**, **Creeds**, **Writings**, and **Church Fathers**.

# **Dispensational Theology:** often with **7 Major Covenants** without **Theological Covenants** or **Sub-Covenants**





**Dispensational Theology,** is Not primarily based on **Dispensations**,

but is based on a consistent Literal, Historical, and Grammatical method of Interpretation.



Many Commentators do not address the Covenant of Marriage



## Noahic Covenant - Gen 8:20 - 9:17

The Command: Noah and sons are to be fruitful and populate the earth, 9:1, 9:7, Gen 1:28, 8:7

The Pronouncement: Now every living thing will now fear you,

because they are food for you, like the green plant, 9:2-3

The Command: But you are not to eat every living thing's flesh with its life, its blood, Lev 17:10

If you do, I will require your lifeblood or any beast's lifeblood, 9:4-5

The Pronouncement: Whoever sheds mans blood, by man his blood shed,

Do not shed man's blood, because man is made in the image of God, 9:6

The Command: Noah and sons are to be fruitful and populate the earth, 9:7, 9:1, Gen 1:28, 8:7

The Pronouncement: This everlasting Covenant is <u>established</u> with you and your descendants, and with all flesh, both man & beast, 9:8-11

The Pronouncement: I will never Flood Earth again, to cut off (kill) all flesh, 9:11

The **Pronouncement:** of the **Sign** of **Covenant**, between **God** & **Earth**, for **God** to remember, with **all flesh**, both **man** & **beast**, 9:12-17

## **Typical Covenant - Aspects**

Most aspects of a Typical Covenant, are revealed in this Covenant of Noah

God establishes His Covenants, Gen 6:18, 9:9, 11, 17

God establishes His Covenants, as "Promises", often with "I will" 9:15,

or "I shall" 9:11, 13, 14, statements.

God establishes His Covenants, "Between" a person, a people Group,

or every living creature, 9:10, 17

God <u>establishes</u> His Covenants, with "specifying certain binding <u>conditions</u>, for God to fulfill", that is "God's Part"

This leads to this Covenant, being considered a Unilateral or Un-Conditional Covenant.

This leads to other Covenants, being considered Bi-lateral or Conditional Covenants.

(Provisions of the Covenant) All the people answered, "All that the Lord has spoken we will do!", commanded in Ex 19:3-6.
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(Conditions of the Covenant) are:
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to **obey** and **keep** it, Ex 19:5

But at this point the people don't know exactly What to obey and keep?

Because the Commands and Ordinances of the Covenant are Not given until Ex 20 - 23

#### (Provisions of the Covenant) are:

Israel will be the Lord's own possession, out of All Peoples.

Israel will be to the Lord a kingdom of priests

Israel will be to the Lord a holy (set apart) Nation.

#### GOD'S COVENANT OF SHOWBREAD OR BREAD OF PRESENCE

### Covenant of Showbread - Lev 24:5-9

#### The Covenant of Showbread or Bread of Presence

The 12 Loaves of Bread, for the Tabernacle, were baked by the Kohathites 1 Chron 9:32

The Loaves were to be set in 2 stacks of 6 Loaves each stack, Lev 24:5

The Loaves were to be set on the Table of acacia wood overlaid with pure gold, Ex 25:30

The Loaves were to have frankincense put on the bread,

as a memorial (remembrance) to the Lord, Lev 24:7

The 12 Loaves of Bread were to be set every Sabbath Day, before the Lord continually, Lev 24:8

The 12 Loaves of Bread are an everlasting (forever) covenant for the sons of Israel, Lev 24:8

The 12 Loaves of Bread are for Aaron and his sons (the Priests), to eat in a holy place, Lev 24:9

The twelve Loaves of Bread represented the 12 Tribes of Israel, Lev 24:8

The twelve Loaves represented an everlasting (forever) covenant

for the sons of Israel to the Lord Lev 24:8

The twelve Loaves represented a continual reminder

of God's everlasting (forever) covenant with His people, the sons of Israel, Lev 24:8

of God's everlasting (forever) covenant provision for the Nation of Israel

The twelve Loaves of Bread were called "the Bread of the Presence (Bread of the Face)", Ex 25:30

Because the Bread was always in God's presence or face, in the Tabernacle



#### GOD'S COVENANT OF PERPETUAL PRIESTHOOD

## Covenant - Perpetual Priesthood - Num 25:10-13

Covenant of a Perpetual Priesthood,

at Shittim, through Phinehas, Num 25:10-13

The zeal of Phinehas in being jealous for his God

was rewarded with a divinely ordained relationship.

His descendants would serve continuously as high priests,

as part of a covenant of perpetual priesthood, over the nation of Israel through his family line would come all future, legitimate High-Priests (Ps 106:30-31).

This Covenant Promise will extend even into the Millennial Kingdom (Ezek 44:15; 48:11).

Phinehas was the direct Descendant of Levi: of Levitical Priesthood, through Aaron Levi, Kohath, Amram, Aaron, Eleazar, Phinehas, 1 Chron 6:1-11

#### GOD'S COVENANT WITH ISRAEL AT MOAB - DEUTERONOMIC COVENANT

Many **Commentators** see this **Covenant** at **Moab** as just a <u>renewal</u> of the **Covenant** at **Horeb** (Mt. Sinai). However, 29:1 clearly states that this **covenant** at **Moab** was "<u>besides</u>," or "<u>in addition to</u>", the **one** at **Sinai**. Hebrew-English Interlinear (LHI), "in land Moab <u>alone to</u> (bad) <u>from</u> (min) covenant", "at Horeb", 29:1, 12-13 This <u>separate</u> or <u>additional</u> Covenant has been called the **Palestinian** or Land Covenant, because of Deut 30:5. However, the emphasis of Deut 29:1-30:20, is Not on the Land, But on the change of Israel's heart.

First it says, "the Lord has <u>not given</u> you (all Israel) a heart <u>to know</u>", 29:4

Second, "the Lord your God will <u>circumcise your heart</u>... <u>to love</u> the Lord your God with <u>all</u> your heart", 30:6

## Deuteronomic Covenant - Deut 29:1 - 30:20

Moses Proclaims a New Covenant in Moab to the Nation of Israel and its Future Generations

The Covenant with All Israel, in Moab, is Not like the Covenant at Mt. Sinai, Deut 29:1–9

All Israel is to enter into a Covenant with the Lord and be His People and He their God, Deut 29:10–13

The Lord's Covenant and Oath with Israel and its Future Generations and His Warning, Deut 29:14-21

The Future Generation of Israel and the Nations will see Canaan afflicted by the Lord, Deut 29:22-28

The Revealed Things or Words of the Lord are Given, so Israel may Observe Them, Deut 29:29

After Cursed, Israel will Return and Obey the Lord and be Restored, with a New Heart, Deut 30:1-10
After Cursed, You will Return and Obey the Lord, Deut 30:1-2 > (Millennium)

You will be Restored and Gathered, back to the Land, Deut 30:3-5 > (Millennium)

The Lord will circumcise your heart to Love the Lord, Deut 30:6 > (Millennium)

The Lord will inflict all these curses on your enemies, Deut 30:7 > (Millennium)

You will again Obey the Lord and Prosper Abundantly, Deut 30:8-9a > (Millennium)

The Lord will again rejoice over you, when you Obey, Deut 30:9b-10 > (Millennium)

Moses Prophetically Reveals Israel's Future, as seen in Joshua through Revelation, Amos 3:7
Israel Continues to Disobey God throughout the OT, in the Gospels, in Acts, and Today!
Israel Continues Today to Not See, Not Hear, Not Understand, and Not Believe the Lord

No Conditions to this Covenant: it is an Un-Conditional Covenant

Nothing for Israel to Do, the Lord will do it all.

This Covenant of the Lord will all occur because:

the Lord Swore by Oath it would, and God cannot Lie, Num 23:19, Ps 89:35, Heb 6:18, Titus 1:2 the Lord has spoken and truly He will bring it to Pass and Surely He will do it, Isa 46:11

#### GOD'S COVENANT WITH DAVID - DAVIDIC COVENANT

This is an Everlasting Covenant, sworn by the Lord with David, 2 Sam 23:5, Ps 89:3, 28 David was Living in Jerusalem, he lived 7 ½ years in Hebron and now was in Jerusalem for about a year. 5:6 During that time he had a House of Cedar built, 2 Sam 5:11, and David was newly living in that House. "the Lord had given him rest on every side from all his enemies", 7:1 David tells Nathan that he is living in a House but the Lord is living in a tent, 7:2 Then that very Night, Nathan has a Vision from the Lord and Lord comments on Not having a House. The Lord says, He has lived in a tent or tabernacle from the time Israel left Egypt. (1445 to 1002 BC = 444 yrs.) The Lord says, He never question anyone about Not having a House, 7:7 David later told grown up Solomon that before Solomon was born, that the Lord told him in a Vision,

that David would Not build Him a House, because David had Wage War and shed much Blood, 2 Chron 22:8. Instead, Solomon a man of Rest and Peace and Quiet would build the Lord a House, 2 Chron 22:9-10.

David wanted a House (Building) for the Lord, But the Lord wanted a House (Dynasty) for David, 2 Sam 7:18
