Our Approach to the Study of Covenants

We are studying the **Covenants** for ourselves. [Not adopting an existing Theology on Covenants]

We are starting in Genesis and working forward through the Old Testament to understand how **they** are **Chronologically** and **Progressively Revealed** and how each **Covenant** builds on or does not build on each previous **Covenant**.



COVENANT Definition – A **Covenant** of **God** is a **Promise** of **God** that will come to pass

COVENANT Definition: Final

COVENANT of **GOD**. A **Promise** of **God**, always **initiated** and **established** by **God**, **Gen 6:18, 9:9, 11, 17** between **God** and a **Person**, a **People** Group, or all **Living** things, **Gen 9:10, Gen 9:17**, according to **His Plan, Purpose, and Will**.

COVENANT of **GOD**, as “**Promises**”, often with “**I will**” or “**I shall**” statements, that “will come to pass”.

IF the **Covenant** specified certain binding **conditions** for **God** to fulfill both parties’ obligations then **it** was considered a **Unilateral** or **Un-Conditional Covenant**.

IF the **Covenant** specified certain binding conditions for **God** to fulfill, **God’s** Part, and separate **conditions** for **Man** to fulfill, **Man’s** Part, then **it** was considered a **Bi-lateral** or **Conditional Covenant**.

COVENANT of **GOD**, often has **offered burnt** (killed) **offerings**, **Gen 8:20, Gen 22:2, Ex 24:5, Rom 8:3**

COVENANT of **GOD**, often has “**a sign**” to “**remember**” or to **identify** with, that **Covenant**, **Gen 9:12**

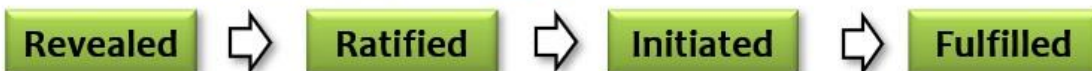
COVENANT of **GOD**, is often identified as an “**everlasting** (perpetual) **Covenant**”, **Gen 9:16, Gen 17:7, Jer 32:40**

COVENANT of **GOD**, may be **Ratified** with **Blood**, **Ex 24:5-8, Gal 3:15-17, Heb 9:15-22, 13:20**

COVENANT of **GOD**, may be **Ratified** by passing between cut animals, **Gen 15:10, 17, Jer 34:18**

COVENANT of **GOD**, may be **Ratified** by **Swearing** and/or by **Oath**, **Gen 26:3, 50:24, Num 14:15-16, Deut 7:6-9, Deut 9:5, 29:9-15, 1 Chron 16:13-18, Ps 105:6-11, Jer 11:1-5, Ezek 16:59-60, Lk 1:67-74, Acts 2:29-31, Heb 6:16-18**

How Many Covenants are there in the Bible ?

The list of Covenants given by most Commentators writing on the Covenants are only referring to what they see as the Major Covenants or Primary Covenants in the Bible. Most Commentators don't give you all the Covenants in the Bible but just the most significant Covenants necessary to understand God's promises according to their particular Biblical Theology. Other Commentators explain that there are Major Covenants and Minor Covenants, like when talking about Major and Minor Prophets in scripture. Other Commentators say that there are Major Covenants with Sub-Covenants or Subordinate Covenants or Supplementary Covenants underneath them.

Dispensational Theology and Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology)

Dispensational Theology,

is most known for using Dispensations to explain their Theology

Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology),

is most known for using Theological Covenants to explain their Theology

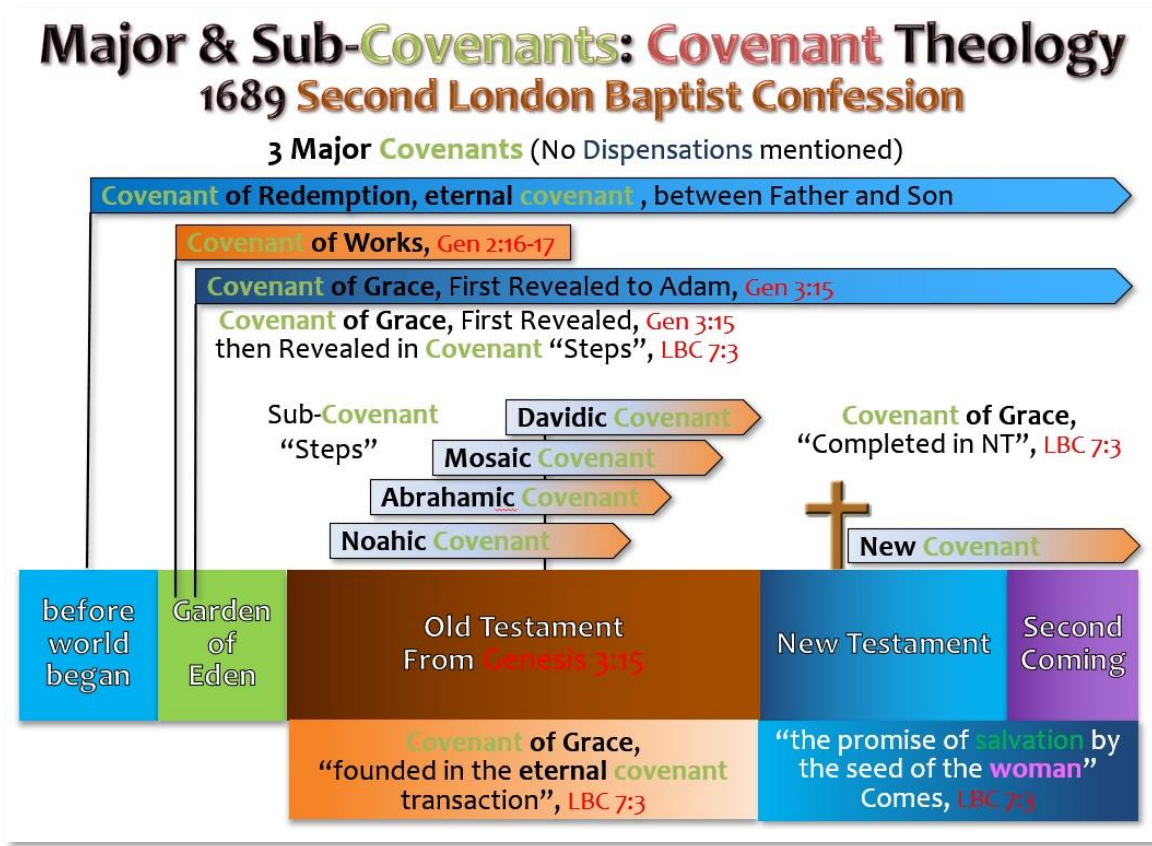
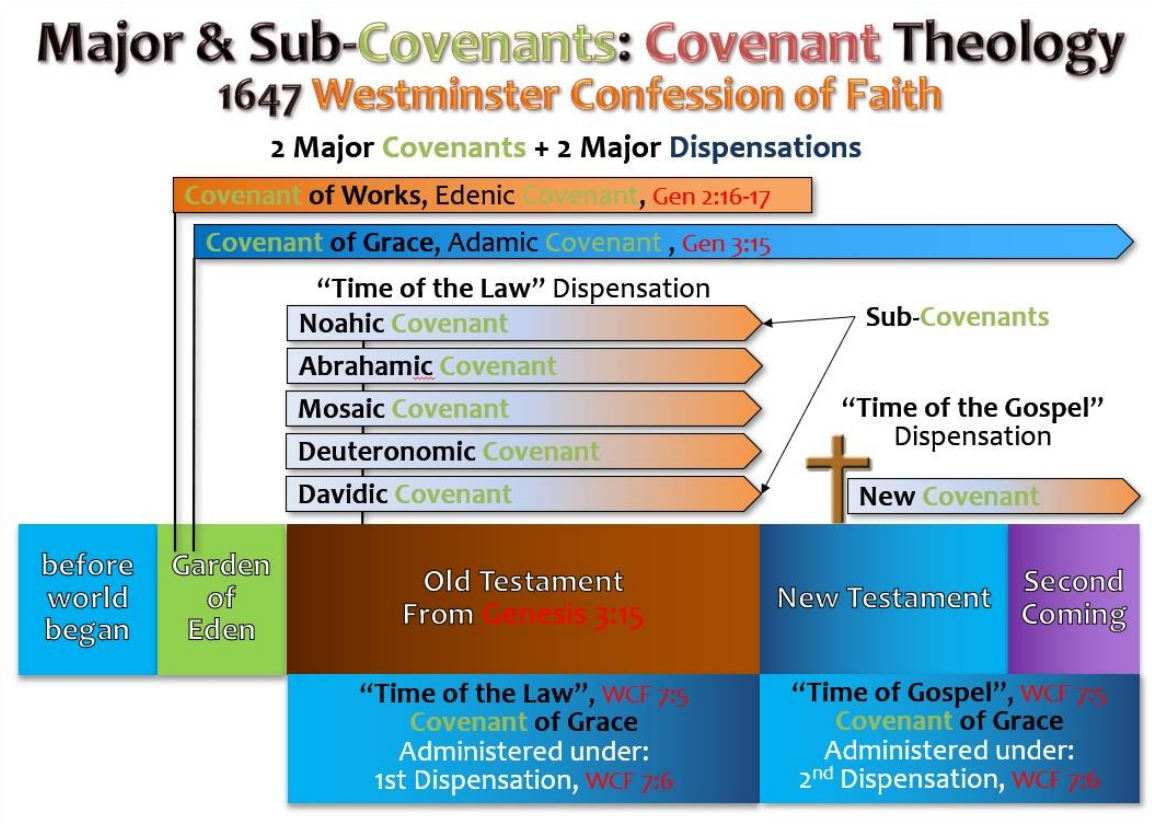
BUT, Both Reformed Theology and Dispensational Theology,

use Dispensations with their Theology

AND, Both Reformed Theology and Dispensational Theology,

use Covenants with their Theology

Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology): Theological Covenants with either 2 or 3 Major Theological Covenants + Sub-Covenants

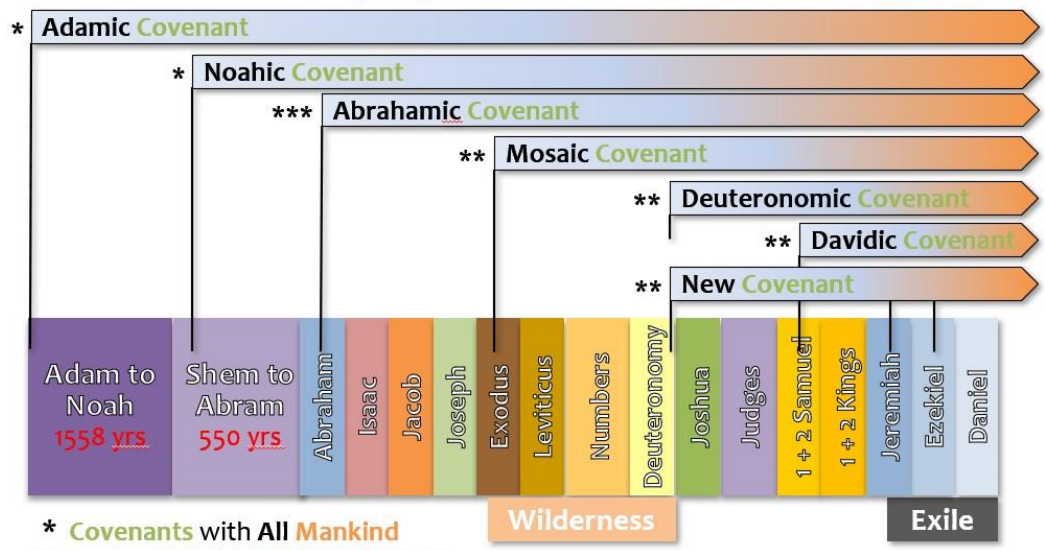


Reformed Theology (Covenant Theology): is based on their particular traditional Theological Covenants Combining a Literal Interpretation with their Confessions, Creeds, Writings, and Church Fathers.

Dispensational Theology: often with 7 Major Covenants without Theological Covenants or Sub-Covenants

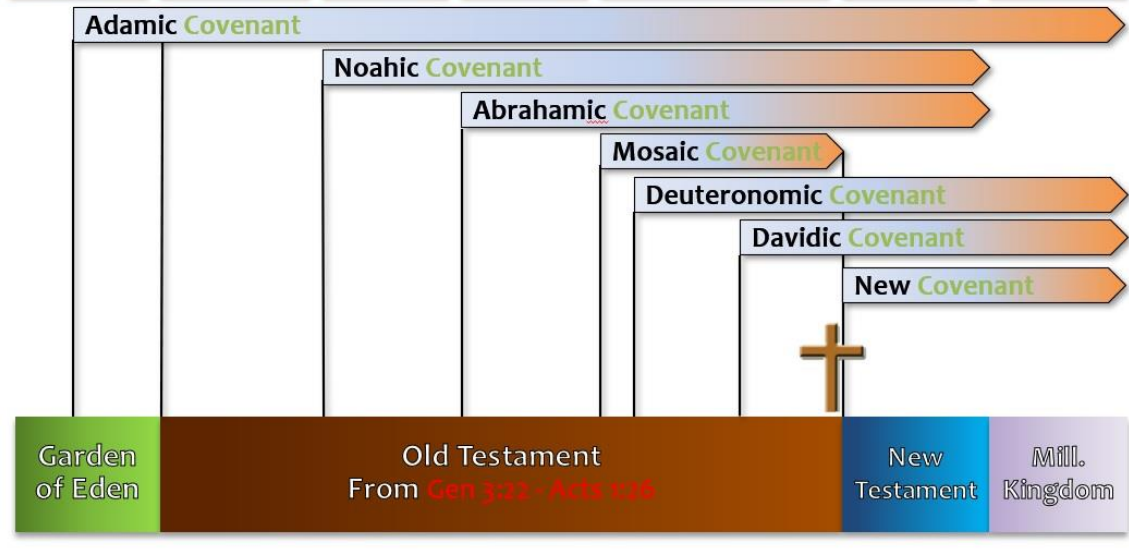

God's Covenant with Adam is Broken, Gen 3:1-7

Covenant Breaker's (Adam's and Eve's) Trial, Gen 3:8-13

Covenant Breaker's (Adam's and Eve's) Sentencing and Curses, Gen 3:16-19

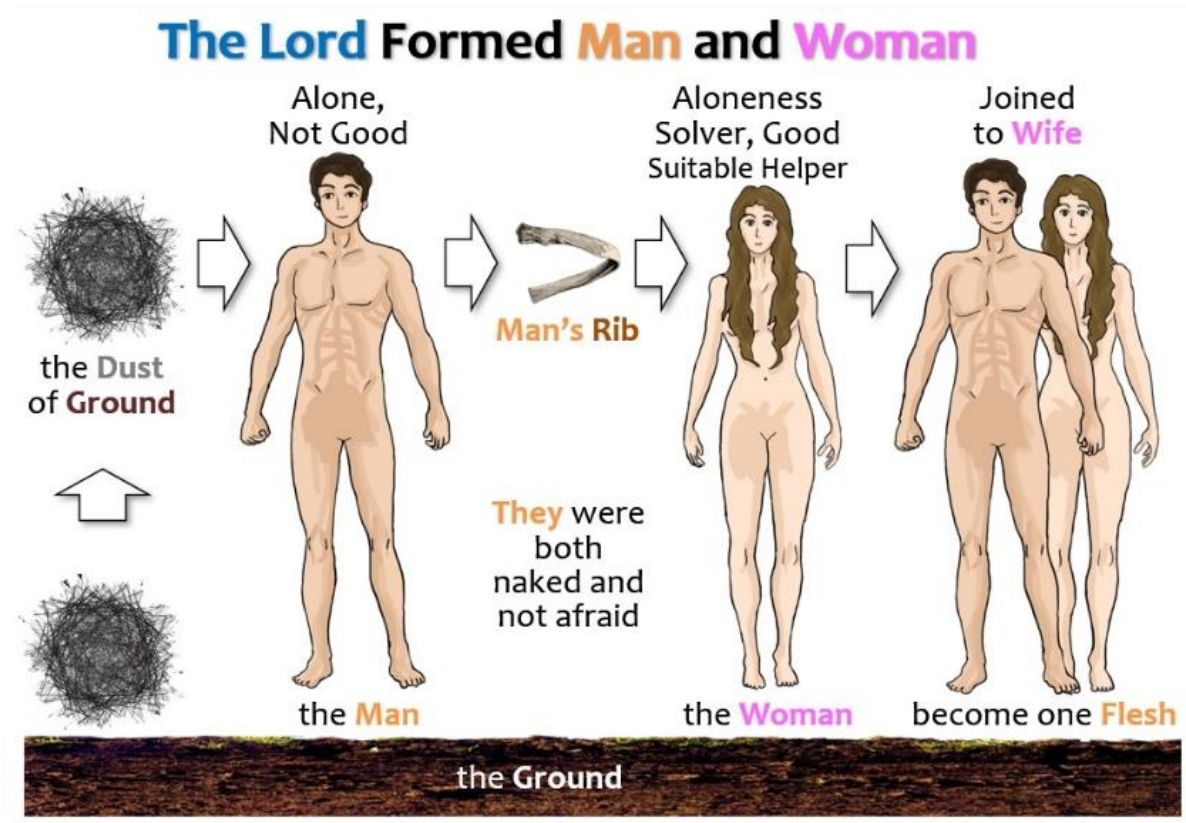
Covenant Breaker's Accomplice's (Satan's) Sentencing and Curses, Gen 3:14-15

GOD'S - COVENANT OF MARRIAGE OF MAN AND WOMAN

God established a Covenant between the Man and the Woman.

The Key Texts are Genesis 2:18-25, Proverbs 2:17, and Malichi 2:14

Many Commentators do not address the Covenant of Marriage



COVENANT OF GOD – WITH NOAH AND HIS DESCENDANTS

Noahic Covenant – Gen 8:20 - 9:17

- The **Command**: Noah and sons are to be fruitful and populate the earth, 9:1, 9:7, Gen 1:28, 8:7
- The **Pronouncement**: Now every living thing will now fear you, because they are food for you, like the green plant, 9:2-3
- The **Command**: But you are not to eat every living thing's flesh with its life, its blood, Lev 17:10
If you do, I will require your lifeblood or any beast's lifeblood, 9:4-5
- The **Pronouncement**: Whoever sheds mans blood, by man his blood shed, Do not shed man's blood, because man is made in the image of God, 9:6
- The **Command**: Noah and sons are to be fruitful and populate the earth, 9:7, 9:1, Gen 1:28, 8:7
- The **Pronouncement**: This everlasting Covenant is established with you and your descendants, and with all flesh, both man & beast, 9:8-11
- The **Pronouncement**: I will never Flood Earth again, to cut off (kill) all flesh, 9:11
- The **Pronouncement**: of the Sign of Covenant, between God & Earth, for God to remember, with all flesh, both man & beast, 9:12-17

Typical Covenant - Aspects

Most aspects of a Typical Covenant, are revealed in this Covenant of Noah

God establishes His Covenants, Gen 6:18, 9:9, 11, 17

God establishes His Covenants, as "Promises", often with "I will" 9:15, or "I shall" 9:11, 13, 14, statements.

God establishes His Covenants, "Between" a person, a people Group, or every living creature, 9:10, 17

God establishes His Covenants, with "specifying certain binding conditions, for God to fulfill", that is "God's Part"

This leads to this Covenant, being considered a Unilateral or Un-Conditional Covenant.

This leads to other Covenants, being considered Bi-lateral or Conditional Covenants.

God establishes His Covenants, often with offered burnt (killed) offerings, Gen 8:20, 22:2, Rom 8:3

God establishes His Covenants, often with "a sign" to "remember", that Covenant, 9:12

Promise of: **Blessing Abram** and **his** name, (personally), 12:2

Promise of: **Blessing** in **Abram**, of **all families** (nations) (Non-Physical Descendants), 12:2

Promise of: **The Lord** giving the **Land** to **Abram**, and **his** Physical Descendants, 12:7

Calling of **Abram**, from **your** country (Ur of the Chaldeans), 12:1, 15:7, 20:13, Acts 7:3, Heb 11:8

Sending of **Abram**, to Go the **Land of Canaan**, 12:1

Promises Concerning: Giving the Land of Canaan

Sending of **Abram**, to the **Land of Canaan**, 12:1

Promise to: **Give Land of Canaan**, to **Abram** and **his** (Physical) Descendants, 12:7, 13:15, 13:17, 15:18, 17:8

Promise to: **Give Land of Canaan**, to **them**, **forever**, as and **everlasting** possession, 13:15, 17:8

Covenant of: **Giving this land** (Canaan) from **river** of **Egypt** to **river** Euphrates, 15:18

Promises Concerning: Making Abram, into a great nation and exceedingly fruitful

Promise of: **Making Abram**, into a **great nation** (Physical Descendants), 12:2, 17:6, 18:18

Promise of: **Abram descendants** being **innumerable**, as dust, stars, and sand, 13:16, 22:17

Promises Concerning: God Personally Blessing Abram

Promise of: **Blessing Abram** and **his** name, (personally), 12:2, 22:17

Promise of: “**you** shall go to **your fathers** in peace; buried at a good old age”, 15:15

Promises Concerning: Abram Blessing and Father, of all families (all nations) and Kings

Promise of: **Blessing** in **Abram**, of **all families** (nations) (Non-Physical Descendants), 12:2, 17:4-6, 18:18, 22:18

Promises Concerning: Abram descendants being strangers in a land ...not theirs

Promise of: **descendants** will be strangers in a **land ... enslaved** and **oppressed**, 15:13

Promise of: **the Lord will** judge **the nation** (Egypt) whom **descendants** will serve, 15:14

Promise of: **descendants** will come out with many possessions, in 4th **generation**, to **Land**, 15:14, 15:16

Promises Concerning: establishing God's Covenant with Abraham and his Descendants

Promise of: establishing **My covenant** between **Me** and **you**, 17:2, 17:7, 15:18

Promise of: establishing **My covenant** throughout **Descendants generations** as **everlasting covenant**, 17:7

Promise of: establishing **My covenant** with **Isaac**, 17:19

Promises Concerning: being God to Abraham and to his descendants after him

Promise of establishing being **God** to **you** and to **your descendants** after **you**. 17:7, 17:8

Promises Concerning: Abraham's descendants possessing the gates of their enemies

Promise of **Abraham's seed** (descendants) shall **possess** the gate of **their** enemies, 22:17

GOD'S COVENANT WITH THE SONS OF ISRAEL AT MOUNT SINAI

Mosaic Covenant – Ex 19:1 - 34:28

Conditions of the Covenant:

if **you Israel** will indeed **obey My voice**, Ex 19:5, Ex 15:26,
if **you Israel** **keep My covenant**, Ex 19:5

Provisions of the Covenant:

then **you Israel** shall be **My own** possession, among **all the peoples**, Ex 19:5
then **you Israel** shall be to **Me** a kingdom of priests, Ex 19:6
then **you Israel** shall be and a **holy nation**, Ex 19:6

Agreement to the Covenant:

Moses gives **the elders** and **the people**, all the words of **the Covenant** commanded, Ex 19:7
All the people answered, "All that **the Lord** has **spoken we** will do !", Ex 19:8

Commands and Ordinances of the Covenant:

The Lord gives the **Ten Commandments**, of **the Covenant**, Ex 20:1-17
The Lord came to **Test the people**, in order that, **they** Fear **Him** and Not **Sin**, Ex 20:20
The Lord gives all the **Ordinances**, Ex 24:3, of **the Covenant**, Ex 21:1 – 23:33

The Recounting, Agreeing, Writing, and Ratifying in Blood of the Covenant:

The People **Promise** to do the **Commands and Ordinances of the Covenant**, Ex 24:3, Deut 5:27, 26:17
Moses writes down **all the words of the Covenant**, Ex 24:4
Moses builds an **altar**, with **12 pillars**, for the **12 tribes of Israel**, Ex 24:4
Young Men, offer **burnt offerings** and **sacrifice young bulls** as **peace offerings**, Ex 24:5, Lev 1:3, 13, 17
Moses puts half **the blood** (of **bulls**) in **basins**, and the other half **he** sprinkled on **the altar**, Ex 24:6, Lev 1:5, 11
Moses took **the book of the covenant** and **read it** in the hearing of **the people**, Ex 24:7
The People say, "All that **the Lord** has spoken **we will do**, and **we will be obedient** !", Ex 24:7, 19:8, 24:3
Moses took **the blood** (of basins) and sprinkled **it** on **the people**, Ex 24:8, Heb 9:18-22
says, "Behold **the blood of the covenant**, **the Lord** has **made with you** in accordance with **all these words** ."

Disobeying the Covenant, Ex 32:1-6

All the people **Corrupt themselves**, by worshipping idols, and **the Lord** is angry, Ex 32:7-10
Moses intercedes for **the people**, by entreating **the Lord**, Ex 32:1-6

Renewing the Covenant with the people, Ex 34:1-28

Moses set before **Israel** **all these words** which **the Lord** had **commanded him** in Ex 19:3-6.

if **you** will indeed **obey My voice**, Ex 15:26, and **keep My covenant** (Conditions of the Covenant)

then **you** shall be **My own** possession, among **all the peoples** (Provisions of the Covenant)

and **you** shall be to **Me** a kingdom of priests and a **holy nation**. (Provisions of the Covenant)

All the people answered, "All that **the Lord** has **spoken we** will do !", **commanded** in Ex 19:3-6.

(Conditions of the Covenant) are:

to **obey** and **keep it**, Ex 19:5

But at this point **the people** don't know exactly What to **obey** and **keep** ?

Because the **Commands and Ordinances** of **the Covenant** are Not given until Ex 20 - 23

(Provisions of the Covenant) are:

Israel will be **the Lord's own** possession, out of **All Peoples**.

Israel will be to **the Lord** a kingdom of priests

Israel will be to **the Lord** a **holy** (set apart) Nation.

GOD'S COVENANT OF SHOWBREAD OR BREAD OF PRESENCE

Covenant of Showbread – Lev 24:5–9

The Covenant of Showbread or Bread of Presence

- The **12 Loaves of Bread**, for the **Tabernacle**, were baked by the **Kohathites** 1 Chron 9:32
- The **Loaves** were to be set in **2 stacks of 6 Loaves** each stack, Lev 24:5
- The **Loaves** were to be set on the **Table** of acacia wood overlaid with pure **gold**, Ex 25:30
- The **Loaves** were to have **frankincense** put on **the bread**,
as a memorial (remembrance) to **the Lord**, Lev 24:7
- The **12 Loaves of Bread** were to be set every **Sabbath Day**, before **the Lord** continually, Lev 24:8
- The **12 Loaves of Bread** are an **everlasting** (forever) **covenant** for **the sons of Israel**, Lev 24:8
- The **12 Loaves of Bread** are for **Aaron** and **his sons** (the Priests), to eat in a **holy place**, Lev 24:9
- The **twelve Loaves of Bread** represented the **12 Tribes of Israel**, Lev 24:8
- The **twelve Loaves** represented an **everlasting** (forever) **covenant**
for **the sons of Israel** to **the Lord** Lev 24:8
- The **twelve Loaves** represented a continual reminder
of **God's everlasting** (forever) **covenant** with **His people**, **the sons of Israel**, Lev 24:8
of **God's everlasting** (forever) **covenant** provision for the **Nation of Israel**
- The **twelve Loaves of Bread** were called “**the Bread of the Presence** (**Bread of the Face**)”, Ex 25:30
Because **the Bread** was always in **God's presence** or **face**, in the **Tabernacle**



GOD'S COVENANT OF PERPETUAL PRIESTHOOD

Covenant - Perpetual Priesthood - Num 25:10-13

Covenant of a Perpetual Priesthood,
at Shittim, through **Phinehas**, Num 25:10–13

The zeal of **Phinehas** in being jealous for **his God**
was rewarded with a **divinely** ordained relationship.

His descendants would serve continuously as **high priests**,
as part of a **covenant of perpetual priesthood**, over the **nation of Israel**
through **his family line** would come all future, legitimate **High-Priests** (Ps 106:30-31).

This **Covenant Promise** will extend even into the **Millennial Kingdom** (Ezek 44:15; 48:11).

Phinehas was the direct **Descendant of Levi**: of **Levitical Priesthood**, through **Aaron**
Levi, Kohath, Amram, Aaron, Eleazar, Phinehas, 1 Chron 6:1-11

GOD'S COVENANT WITH ISRAEL AT MOAB – DEUTERONOMIC COVENANT

Many Commentators see this Covenant at Moab as just a renewal of the Covenant at Horeb (Mt. Sinai). However, 29:1 clearly states that this covenant at Moab was “besides,” or “in addition to”, the one at Sinai. Hebrew-English Interlinear (LHI), “in land Moab alone to (bad) from (min) covenant”, “at Horeb”, 29:1, 12-13. This separate or additional Covenant has been called the Palestinian or Land Covenant, because of Deut 30:5. However, the emphasis of Deut 29:1-30:20, is Not on the Land, But on the change of Israel's heart.

First it says, “the Lord has not given you (all Israel) a heart to know”, 29:4

Second, “the Lord your God will circumcise your heart... to love the Lord your God with all your heart”, 30:6

Deuteronomic Covenant – Deut 29:1 – 30:20

Moses Proclaims a New Covenant in Moab to the Nation of Israel and its Future Generations

The Covenant with All Israel, in Moab, is Not like the Covenant at Mt. Sinai, Deut 29:1-9

All Israel is to enter into a Covenant with the Lord and be His People and He their God, Deut 29:10-13

The Lord's Covenant and Oath with Israel and its Future Generations and His Warning, Deut 29:14-21

The Future Generation of Israel and the Nations will see Canaan afflicted by the Lord, Deut 29:22-28

The Revealed Things or Words of the Lord are Given, so Israel may Observe Them, Deut 29:29

After Cursed, Israel will Return and Obey the Lord and be Restored, with a New Heart, Deut 30:1-10

After Cursed, You will Return and Obey the Lord, Deut 30:1-2 > (Millennium)

You will be Restored and Gathered, back to the Land, Deut 30:3-5 > (Millennium)

The Lord will circumcise your heart to Love the Lord, Deut 30:6 > (Millennium)

The Lord will inflict all these curses on your enemies, Deut 30:7 > (Millennium)

You will again Obey the Lord and Prosper Abundantly, Deut 30:8-9a > (Millennium)

The Lord will again rejoice over you, when you Obey, Deut 30:9b-10 > (Millennium)

Moses Prophetically Reveals Israel's Future, as seen in Joshua through Revelation, Amos 3:7

Israel Continues to Disobey God throughout the OT, in the Gospels, in Acts, and Today!

Israel Continues Today to Not See, Not Hear, Not Understand, and Not Believe the Lord

Isa 6:9-10, Matt 13:14-17, Mark 4:11-12, Luke 8:10, Jn 12:39-40, Acts 28:25-27, Rom 11:7-8, 1 Cor 2:9

No Conditions to this Covenant: it is an Un-Conditional Covenant

Nothing for Israel to Do, the Lord will do it all.

This Covenant of the Lord will all occur because:

the Lord Swore by Oath it would, and God cannot Lie, Num 23:19, Ps 89:35, Heb 6:18, Titus 1:2

the Lord has spoken and truly He will bring it to Pass and Surely He will do it, Isa 46:11

GOD'S COVENANT WITH DAVID — DAVIDIC COVENANT

This is an **Everlasting Covenant**, sworn by the Lord with David, 2 Sam 23:5, Ps 89:3, 28

David was Living in **Jerusalem**, he lived 7 ½ years in **Hebron** and now was in **Jerusalem** for about a year. 5:6

During that time he had a **House of Cedar** built, 2 Sam 5:11, and **David** was newly living in that **House**.

“the Lord had given him rest on every side from all his enemies”, 7:1

David tells **Nathan** that he is living in a **House** but the Lord is living in a **tent**, 7:2

Then that very Night, **Nathan** has a **Vision** from the Lord and **Lord** comments on Not having a **House**.

The Lord says, He has lived in a **tent** or **tabernacle** from the time **Israel** left **Egypt**. (1445 to 1002 BC = 444 yrs.)

The Lord says, He never question anyone about Not having a **House**, 7:7

David later told grown up **Solomon** that before **Solomon** was born, that the Lord told him in a **Vision**, that **David** would Not build **Him** a **House**, because **David** had **Wage War** and shed much **Blood**, 2 Chron 22:8. Instead, **Solomon** a man of **Rest** and **Peace** and **Quiet** would build the Lord a **House**, 2 Chron 22:9-10.

David wanted a **House** (Building) for the Lord, But the Lord wanted a **House** (Dynasty) for David, 2 Sam 7:18

Davidic Covenant - 2 Sam 7:8-17, 1 Chron 17:1-16

The Lord Reminds David of All He has done for him and will do for him

First the Lord reminds David of All He > has (past) done for him, 7:8-9, 1 Chr 17:7 (David Before)

by choosing David and making him in as a Ruler of Israel, 7:8

by having been with David wherever he has went, 7:9a, 1 Chr 17:8

by having cut off all David's enemies from before him, 7:9b

Second the Lord reminds David of All He > Will Do (future) for him, 7:9c (David Future)

The Lord will make you (David) a great name, 7:9c (like Abraham, Gen 12:2)

Third the Lord reminds David of All He > Will Do (future) for His people Israel, 7:10-11 (David's Kingdom)

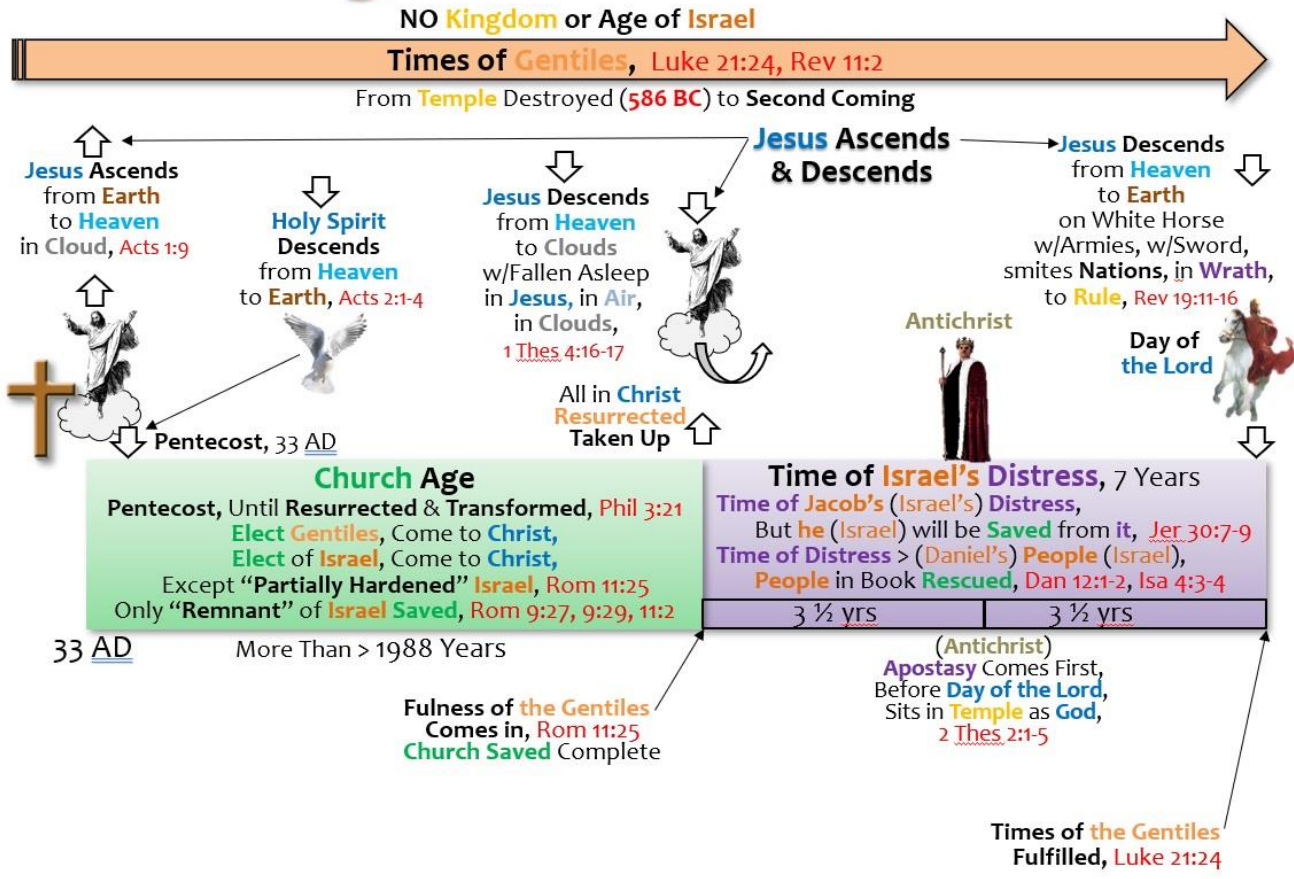
