What is a Prophet?

A **Prophet** > was a **Spokesman** or an **Agent** for **God**.

Prophets are: Individuals chosen, called, and empowered by God to declare His Will and to fulfill His Purpose, to His chosen people.

The "Prophet" proclaimed the message, given to him by the Lord.

How is Prophecy Revealed to Men?

Numbers 12:6-8

6 He said, "Hear now My words: If there is a prophet among you,

I, the LORD, shall make Myself known to him in a vision.

I shall speak with him in a dream.

7 "Not so, with My servant Moses, He is faithful in all My household;

8 With him I speak mouth to mouth, Even openly,

and not in dark sayings, And he beholds the form of the LORD.

What is Prophecy?

Prophecy: is **the Lord** speaking and making **His Word** known, either in a **Vision**, a **Dream**, mouth to mouth, or openly, <u>foretelling</u> what is to come, to be heard by certain **men**, at certain times. Num 12:6–8

Prophecy: is God declaring His Will, Plan, and Purpose, as established from ancient times, Read Isa 46:8-11

- 1. **Prophecy** Declares, "the end, from the beginning", Isa 46:10, (42:9, 44:7, 45:21, 41:22-23, 41:26)
- 2. Prophecy Declares, "from ancient times, things which have not been done", Isa 46:10
- 3. Prophecy is given to certain men God calls for His Purpose, Isa 46:11
- 4. The Lord Says, "My purpose, will be established", Isa 46:10
- 5. The Lord Says, "I will accomplish, all My good pleasure (His Will)", Isa 46:10
- 6. The Lord Says, "Truly I have spoken" (His Will, Plan, Purpose), Isa 46:10-11
- 7. The Lord Says, "Truly I will bring it to pass", Isa 46:11
- 8. The Lord Says, "(Truly) I have planned it (His Will, Plan, Purpose)", Isa 46:11
- 9. The Lord Says, "Surely I will do it (His Will, Plan, Purpose)", Isa 46:11

Interpretation of Prophecy Key: All Prophecy Must be Fulfilled,

Because The Lord: established it, will accomplish it, spoke it, will bring it to pass (fulfill it)

Because The Lord: Willed it, Planned it, Purposed it, and will Surely do it. Isa 46:8-11

Where do Prophets Get the Words to Say?

Jeremiah 1:9

9 Then the LORD stretched out His hand and touched my (Jeremiah's) mouth, and the LORD said to me, "Behold, I have put My words in your mouth.

Isaiah 51:16

16 <u>I have put My words in your (Isaiah's) mouth</u> and have covered you with the shadow of My hand, to establish the heavens, to found the earth, and to say to Zion, 'You are My people.

Acts 28:25

And when they did not agree with one another, they began leaving after Paul had spoken one parting word, "The Holy Spirit rightly spoke through Isaiah the prophet to your (Israel's) fathers,

Surely the Lord GOD does nothing Unless He reveals His secret counsel To His servants the prophets.

Interpretation of Prophecy Key: The Words of the Prophets, Are put in the Prophet's mouth by the Lord, who reveals His secret counsel to them, through the Holy Spirit, who rightly spoke through them. Jer 1:9, Isa 51:16, Acts 28:25

Who were the Prophets?

Enoch was a Prophet (3270 to 2905 BC)

Jude 14-15

14 It was also about these men (False Teachers) that Enoch,

in the seventh generation from Adam, prophesied, saying,

"Behold, the Lord came with many thousands of His holy ones,

15 to execute judgment upon all, and to convict all the ungodly

of all their ungodly deeds which they have done in an ungodly way,

and of all the harsh things which ungodly sinners have spoken against Him." [Second Coming?]

Abraham was a Prophet (1951 to 1796 BC)




"Now therefore, restore the man's (Abraham's) wife (Sarah), for he (Abraham) is a prophet,"

Prophecy In the Old Testament

Most Prophecy revealed in the Book of Revelation, was previously revealed in the Old Testament.

The First Coming of Christ, in Old Testament



The Cursing and Restoring of Israel

1 "So it shall be when all of these things have come upon you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and you call them to mind in all nations where the Lord your God has banished you,

The Restoring of Israel > When Israel returns to the Lord

- 2 and you return to the Lord your God and obey Him with all your heart and soul according to all that I command you today, you and your sons,
- 3 then the Lord your God will restore you from captivity, and have compassion on you, and will gather you again from all the peoples where the Lord your God has scattered you.
- 4 "If your outcasts are at the ends of the earth, from there the Lord your God will gather you, and from there He will bring you back.
- 5 "the Lord your God will bring you into the land which your fathers possessed, and you shall possess it; and He will prosper you and multiply you more than your fathers.
- 6 "Moreover the Lord your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your descendants, (New Cov.) to love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul, so that you may live.

- 10 if (*when, ESV) you obey the Lord your God to keep His commandments and His statutes which are written in this book of the law,

if (*when, ESV) you turn to the Lord your God with all your heart and soul.

[* "ki" in Hebrew (3588) definition: that, **for**, **when**, NASB Hebrew-Aramaic Dictionary "ki" is translated, because (409 times), **if** (169 times), **when** (241 times) in OT. See "when", Deut 30:1]

This is the Deuteronomic Covenant given by "the Lord Israel's God" to Moses and then to Nation of Israel.

Moses told Israel Before they even entered the Promised Land that they would be Cursed as well as Blessed.

Israel was **Cursed**, in the **Past**


We know what came upon Israel in the Past,

they were: "cursed", "banished", "scattered", outcasts", Deut 30:1, 3, 4.

Israel will be Blessed, in the Future

Therefore, we know what will come upon Israel in the Future,

they will be: Blessed, restored, receive compassion, be gathered, brought back into the Land, and given a heart to love the Lord, and will be rejoiced over by the Lord again, Deut 30:2-10

31 "Behold, days are coming," declares the Lord, "when I will make a new covenant



New Covenant is Not like the Mosaic Covenant given to Israel at Mt. Sinai, Jer 31:32

New Covenant will Forgive and Cleanse All of the Nation of Israel of Sin, Jer 31:34, 33:8, 36:3, 50:20, Rom 11:26-27, Heb 10:17

New Covenant will write the Law on Israel's Hearts, Jer 31:33, Heb 10:16


New Covenant will Not be completely Fulfilled for the Nation of Israel until the Second Coming of Christ.

New Covenant will cause "all Israel to be saved" and Sins forgiven, at Second Coming of Christ,

"the deliverer (Christ) will come from Zion, He will remove ungodliness from Jacob." Rom 11:26-27

New Covenant with Israel, Can't be Broken, Jer 33:19-22

New Covenant with Israel, is Everlasting, Jer 32:40, Ezek 36:26



The **Old Covenant** with **Israel** was Conditional, but the **New Covenant** with **Israel** is Un-Conditional and can't be broken and is **Everlasting**.

- 33 'Thus says the Lord God, "On the day that I cleanse you from all your iniquities, I will cause the cities to be inhabited, and the waste places will be rebuilt.
- 34 "The desolate land will be cultivated instead of being a desolation in the sight of everyone who passes by.
- 35 "They will say, 'This desolate land has become like the garden of Eden; and the waste, desolate and ruined cities are fortified and inhabited.'
- 36 "Then **the nations** that are left round about **you** will know that **I, the Lord**, have rebuilt the ruined places and planted that which was desolate; **I, the Lord**, have **spoken** and **will do it.**"
- 37 'Thus says the Lord God, "This also I will let the house of Israel ask Me to do for them:

I will increase their men like a flock.

- 38 "Like the flock for sacrifices, like the flock at Jerusalem during her appointed feasts, so will the waste cities be filled with flocks of men.

 Then they will know that I am the Lord."
- Q: What part does Israel have in making sure all of these things take place?
- A: None, they are all things the Lord will do, because these are Un-Conditional Promises from the Lord.
