Nebuchadnezzar's Dream

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream – Received and Not Understood, Dan 2:1-3 Daniel 2:1–3

- 1 Now in the second year of the reign of Nebuchadnezzar, Nebuchadnezzar had dreams; and his spirit was troubled and his sleep left him.
- 2 Then the king gave orders to call in the magicians, the conjurers, the sorcerers and the Chaldeans to tell the king his dreams. So they came in and stood before the king.
- **3** The king said to them, "I had a dream and my spirit is anxious to understand the dream."

Nebuchadnezzar's Dream – <u>Interpretation</u> is Revealed by God to Daniel, Dan 2:16-19 Daniel 2:16–19

- 16 So Daniel went in and requested of the king that he would give him time, in order that he might declare the interpretation to the king.
- 17 Then Daniel went to his house and informed his friends, Hananiah, Mishael and Azariah, about the matter,
- 18 so that they might request compassion from the God of heaven concerning this mystery, so that Daniel and his (3) friends would not be destroyed with the rest of the wise men of Babylon.
- 19 Then the **mystery** was **revealed** to Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven;

all these 10 Kingdoms, 2:34-35, 2:44d

"In the days of those kings (10 toe kings) the God of heaven will set up a kingdom (God's Kingdom) which will <u>never be destroyed</u>,

the **Messiah** who will come, and setup **God's Kingdom**, that will endure **forever**, 2:44 All this is what will take place in the future 2:45 He (God) has made known to King Nebuchadnezzar what will take place in the latter days, 2:28 He (God) who reveals mysteries has made known to you (King) what will take place, in the future, 2:29 the great God has made known to the king what will take place in the future, 2:45

First we see, **"The head** of that **statue** was made of fine **gold**, **2:32 Interpretation:** the **Babylonian Empire** or **Nebuchadnezzar** is **"the head of gold"**, **2:38**

Second we see, "its (statue's) breast and its arms of silver, 2:32 Interpretation: "After you (King) there will arise another kingdom inferior (lessor) to you", 2:39

Third we see, "its (statue's) belly and its thighs of bronze, 2:32 Interpretation: "another third kingdom of bronze, which will rule over all the earth", 2:39

Fourth we see, "its (statue's) legs of iron", 2:33

Interpretation: "Then there will be a fourth kingdom as strong as iron; inasmuch as iron <u>crushes</u> and <u>shatters</u> all things,

so, like **iron** that <u>breaks</u> (things) in pieces, **it** will **<u>crush</u> and <u>break</u> all these (All 4) in pieces.**

Fifth we see, "its (statue's) feet partly of iron and partly of clay", 2:33

Interpretation: "In that you saw the feet and toes, partly of potter's clay and partly of iron,

it (10 toe kingdom), will be a divided kingdom;

but **it** (10 **toe kingdom),** will have in **it** the toughness of **iron**,

inasmuch as you saw the iron mixed with common clay. 2:41

"As the toes of the feet were partly of iron and partly of pottery (clay),

so some of **the kingdom** (10 **toe kingdom**), will be <u>strong</u>

- and part of **it** (10 **toe kingdom),** will be <u>brittle</u>. 2:42
- "And in that you saw the iron mixed with common clay,

they (10 toe kingdom) will combine with one another in the seed of men;

but they (10 toe kingdom) will not adhere to one another,

even as **iron** does not combine with **pottery.** 2:43

Sixth we see, the stone that struck the statue became a great mountain (Kingdom) and filled the whole earth. 2:34-35, 2:44d

As Revealed:

A. "Then the iron, the clay, the bronze, the silver and the gold were crushed..., 2:35

- B. (Then, in order) "a stone struck the statue on its feet of iron and clay and crushed them (feet). 2:34
- C. But **the stone** that struck **the statue** became **a great mountain** (Kingdom) a. and **filled the whole earth. 2:35**

As Interpreted:

44 "In the days of those kings (10 toe kings)

the God of heaven will set up a kingdom (God's Kingdom) which will never be destroyed, and that kingdom (God's Kingdom) will not be left for another people;

it (the stone, God's Kingdom) will <u>crush</u> and <u>put an end to</u> but it (God's Kingdom) will itself endure forever. 2:44

As Interpreted Summation:

45 "Inasmuch as you saw that a stone (Messiah) was cut out of the mountain (kingdom) without hands and that it (Messiah) <u>crushed</u> the iron, the bronze, the clay, the silver and the gold, (All 5) 2:34-35 the great God has made known to the king what will take place in the future; , 2:28, 2:29,

so the dream is true and its interpretation is trustworthy." 2:44

it (God's Kingdom) will <u>crush</u> and <u>put an end to</u> all these (10 toe) kingdoms, Dan 2:34-35, 44-45

Q1: How do we know that **the first 4 parts of the statue** represent a later **Historic Empire** or **Kingdom** ? First of all, we know who the **World Empire** was in the time of **Daniel** and each succeeding **Empire**

that conquered each preceding **Empire** according to secular and Biblical resources. **First** we know, the head of **Gold** represented the **Babylonian Empire**, Dan 1:1, 2:38, 2 Chron 36:20, **Second** we know, the **breast** and **its arms** of **silver**, represents the **Medo-Persian Empire**, Dan 5:28, 5:31 **Third** we know, the **belly** and **its thighs** of **bronze**, represents the **Grecian Empire**, Dan 8:20-21 **Forth** we know, **its legs** of **iron**, represents the **Roman Empire**, Dan 11:2, as an empire after Greece.

<mark>Q2:</mark> How do we know that the **Feet/Toes** of **the statue** represent Future 10 Kings or 10 Empires ? We know from Dan 2:44,

that **God** will, as seen as a **stone**, will **crush** and **put an end to all these** (10 **toe kingdoms**), Also that **God** will setup a **Kingdom** that "which will never be destroyed"

and "it (God's Kingdom) will itself endure forever".

Therefore,

God has not yet setup a forever Kingdom and therefore the 10 Kings don't exist yet to be crushed

Daniel's Dream and Visions, Daniel 7:1-28

The Dream and Visions Summary Revealed by Daniel, Daniel 7:1–8 Daniel 7:1–8

- 1 In the first year of Belshazzar king of Babylon (553 BC) Daniel saw a dream and visions in his mind as he lay on his bed; then he wrote the dream down and related the following summary of it. 2 Daniel said, "I was looking in my vision by night, and behold, the four winds of heaven (Dan 8:8, 11:4, Rev 7:1, Ezek 37:9, Zech 2:6) were stirring up the great sea (Mediterranean). Num 34:6-7, Josh 23:4 3 "And four great beasts were coming up from the sea, different from one another. 7:17, Rev 13:2 4 "The first (beast) was like a lion and had the wings of an eagle. (Babylonian, Dan 2:38) Rev 13:2 I kept looking until its wings were plucked, and **it** was lifted up from the ground and made to stand on two feet like a man; a human mind also was given to it. 5 "And behold, another beast, a second one, resembling a bear. (Medo-Persian, Dan 2:39) Rev 13:2 And it was raised up on one side, and three ribs were in its mouth between its teeth; and thus they said to it, 'Arise, devour much meat!' 6 "After this I kept looking, and behold, another one, like a leopard, (Grecian, Dan 2:39) Rev 13:2 which had on its back four wings of a bird; Dan 8:8 the beast also had four heads (4 Kings, Dan 8:8), and dominion was given to it. 7 "After this I kept looking in the night visions, and behold, a fourth beast, (Roman, Dan 2:40) 7:19-20, 7:23, Rev 13:1, Rev 17:8, Rev 17:12 dreadful and terrifying and extremely strong; and **it** had large **iron** teeth. It devoured and <u>crushed</u> and <u>trampled down</u> the remainder with its feet; and it was different from all the beasts that were before it,
- and <mark>it had ten horns</mark>. (10 Toes, Dan 2:41) Rev 12:3, Rev 12:18, Rev 13:1, Rev 17:12 8 "While I was contemplating **the** (10) horns,
- behold, **another horn**, a **little one**, came up among **them**, (10 Toes, Dan 2:41) Dan 7:20-21, Rev 13:5-6, and **three of the first** (10) **horns** were pulled out by the roots before **it** (the little horn); and behold, **this** (little) **horn** possessed **eyes** like the **eyes** of a **man**

and a **mouth** <u>uttering great boasts</u>. 7:11, 7:20, Rev 13:5-6,

The scene switches from speaking of **the little horn**

to **the Ancient of Days** sitting on **His throne**, in **Court**, where **Books** were opened, which implies **Judging**. This may be when the **Little Horn** will be **Judged** and **his** <u>dominion</u> taken away and destroyed, Dan 7:26 This closely parallels, the **Great White Throne Judgement** of **unbelievers**, in Rev 20:11-15

The Little Horn, Speaking, Slain, Destroyed, and Burned

Daniel 7:11-12

11 "Then I kept looking because of the sound of <u>the boastful words</u> _____which **the horn** (little horn) was <u>speaking</u>; 7:8, 7:20, Rev 13:5-6

kept looking until **the beast** (little horn) was **slain**, 11:45, 2 Thes 2:8

and its (little horn's) body was destroyed

and <u>given to</u> the **burning fire.** Rev 19:20, 20:10

12 "As for the rest of the (4) beasts (Empires),

their dominion was taken away, 7:26,

but an extension of life was granted to **them** (4 **beasts**) for an appointed period of time.



The scene switches again from speaking of **the Ancient of Days** to **the little horn** in **the latter days**. **the little horn** or **the Beast** in Dan 7:11, is **the Beast** or **the Anti-Christ** in Rev 13:1-10, 19:20, 20:10 **the rest of the** (4) **beasts** (Empires), refers to the (3) **beasts, the Lion, the Bear, and the leopard**, 7:3-6 which are also the Statue Empires, **Gold** (Babylon), **silver** (Persian), **bronze** (Greek), Dan 2:32-33

Revelation 13:5–6

5 There was given to him (the Beast/little horn) a mouth <u>speaking arrogant words</u> and <u>blasphemies</u>, and authority to act for forty-two months was given to him.

6 And he (the Beast) opened his mouth in blasphemies against God,

to <u>blaspheme</u> His name and His tabernacle, that is, those who dwell in heaven.

Revelation 19:20

20 And the beast was seized, and with him the false prophet who performed the signs in his presence, by which he deceived those who had received the mark of the beast

and those who worshiped his image;

these two (beast & false prophet) were thrown alive into the lake of fire which burns with brimstone.

The Son of Man was Given Dominion, Glory and A Kingdom, by The Ancient of Days Daniel 7:13–14

Daniel asks for the exact meaning of the Visions of the Beasts

Daniel 7:15–22 Chart

15 "As for me, **Daniel**, my spirit was distressed within me, and the visions in my mind kept alarming me. **16** "I approached **one of those** (Angels) **who** were standing by 7:10

and began asking him (Angel) the exact meaning of all this.

So he (Angel) told me and made known to me the interpretation of these things:

and which devoured, <u>crushed</u> and <u>trampled down</u> the remainder (3 Kings) with **its** feet, 7:23 20 and <u>the meaning of</u> the ten horns that were on its (4th iron King's) head

- and the other horn (little horn) which came up, and before which three of them (3 Kings) fell,
 - namely, **that horn** (little horn) which had **eyes** and a **mouth** <u>uttering great boasts</u> 7:8, 7:11 and which (little horn) was larger in appearance than **its** (3 Kings) associates.

which had **eyes** and a **mouth** <u>uttering great boasts</u> **7:8**, **7:11**, **Rev 13:5-6**

and which (little 11th horn) was larger in appearance than **its** (3 Kings) associates.

18 'But the saints of the Highest One will <u>receive</u> the <u>kingdom</u> and <u>possess</u> the <u>kingdom</u> forever, for all ages to come.' 7:22, 7:27, Rev 2:26, Rev 20:4

21 "I kept looking, and that horn (little 11th horn) was waging war with the saints and overpowering them
22 until the Ancient of Days <u>came</u> and <u>judgment</u> was passed in favor of the saints of the Highest One, and the time arrived when the saints took possession of the <u>kingdom</u>. 7:10, 7:18, 7:27, Rev 2:26, Rev 20:4

It was explained that the 4 Great Beasts represent 4 Kings or 4 Kingdoms who will arise from the earth, 7:17







The meaning of the 4th Beast, the 10 Horns, and another King Daniel 7:23–28

23 "Thus he (Angel) said: 'The fourth beast will be a fourth kingdom on the earth, (4th iron Beast King) which will be different from all the other kingdoms (3 Beast Kings) and (4th kingdom) will <u>devour the whole earth</u> and <u>tread it down</u> and <u>crush</u> it (the earth). 7:19 24 'As for the ten horns, out of this (4th) kingdom ten kings will arise; Dan 7:7, Rev 13:1, 17:12 and another (horn, 11th King) will arise after them (10 Kings), 7:8 and he (that 11th King) will be different from the previous ones (10 Kings) and (that 11th King) will subdue three kings (3 of 10 Kings). 25 'He (that 11th King) will speak out against the Most High and (that 11th King) wear down the saints of the Highest One, Rev 11:7, Rev 13:7 and he (that 11th King) will intend to make alterations in times and in law; Dan 11:36 and they (the saints) will be given into his (that 11th King) hand Dan 12:7, Rev 11:7, Rev 13:7 for a time, times, and half a time (3 ½ years). Dan 12:7, Rev 12:14, Rev 13:5, 26 'But the court will sit for judgment, Dan 7:14 and his (that 11th King) dominion will be taken away, annihilated and destroyed forever. The meaning of the Fourth Beast (Latter Days, Roman Iron/Clay Feet/Toes Empire) (Forth Beast, refers back to the Roman iron legs, Dan 2:33 and forward to the Roman iron/clay Feet/Toes.) the iron/clay Feet/Toes Kingdom > will have ten Kings, with a 11th King that subdues 3 of the 10 Kings, That 11th King > will speak against the Most High, Rev 13:5-6 (the saints) will be given into his hand for (3 ½ years) or (42 months), Rev 13:5-6

That 11th King > is the beast, having 10 horns with diadems and 7 heads, in Rev 13:1

Revelation 13:5-6

- **5** There was given to **him** (**the Beast/little horn**) a mouth <u>speaking arrogant words</u> and <u>blasphemies</u>, and <u>authority</u> to act for forty-two months (3 ½ years) was given to **him**.
- 6 And he (the Beast) opened his mouth in <u>blasphemies</u> against God, to <u>blaspheme</u> His name and His tabernacle, that is, those who dwell in heaven.

Revelation 13:1

1 And the dragon stood on the sand of the seashore. Then I saw a beast coming up out of the sea, having ten horns and seven heads, and on his (10) horns were ten diadems, and on his (7) heads were blasphemous names.

The meaning of the Ten Horns (Latter Days, Roman Iron/Clay Feet/Toes Empire)

"in the days of those (10 Toe) Kings" Dan 2:44-45

when "God of Heaven will setup a Kingdom, ... never destroyed, Dan 2:44-45 what will take place in the latter days, Dan 2:28, 2:29, 2:45

'As for the ten horns, out of this (4th) kingdom ten kings will arise; Dan 7:7, 7:24, Rev 13:1, 17:12

Revelation 17:12-13

12 "The ten horns which you saw are ten kings who have not yet received a kingdom, but they (ten kings) receive authority as kings with the beast (little horn) for one hour.
 13 "These (ten kings) have one purpose,

and **they** (**ten** kings) give their power and authority to **the beast** (little horn).

The meaning of Another King (11th King) (Latter Days, the Little Horn, the Beast, Empire) Little Horn, Dan 7:24-25

24 'As for the ten horns, out of this (4th) kingdom ten kings will arise; Dan 7:7, Rev 13:1, 17:12 and another (horn, 11th King) will arise after them (10 Kings), 7:8 and he (that 11th King) will be different from the previous ones (10 Kings) and (that 11th King) will subdue three kings (3 of 10 Kings).
25 'He (that 11th King) will speak out against the Most High and (that 11th King) wear down the saints of the Highest One, Rev 11:7, Rev 13:7 and he (that 11th King) will intend to make alterations in times and in law; Dan 11:36 and they (the saints) will be given into his (that 11th King) hand Dan 12:7, Rev 13:7, for a time, times, and half a time (3 ½ years). Dan 12:7, Rev 12:14, Rev 13:5,

26 'But the court will sit for judgment, Dan 7:14 and his (that 11th King) dominion will be taken away, annihilated and destroyed forever. Dan 7:10-12

Another (horn, 11th King) in Dan 7:24, is one in the same forth Beast in Dan 7:23. The forth Beast in Dan 7:23, is one in the same Beast in Rev 13:1, Rev 13:5–6 (on this page above) The Beast in Rev 13:1, Rev 13:5–6, is one in the Antichrist in Revelation.

1 John 2:18 (1 John 2:22, 4:3, 2 John 7)

- 18 Children, it is the last hour; and just as you heard that antichrist is coming, (singular, Future) even now many antichrists have appeared (plural, Past); from this we know that it is the last hour.
- the Antichrist is the "coming" final world ruler (Beast) "according to the activity of Satan" 2 Thes 2:9 "who opposes and exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship,
 - so that **he** takes **his** seat in the **temple of God**, displaying **himself** as being **God**", 2 Thes 2:4 **the Antichrist** will seek to replace and oppose the true **Christ**.
