BOOK OF REVELATION – REVELATION 19:1-16 THE THINGS SEEN AND ARE AND WHAT SHALL TAKE PLACE By Kevin E. Hughes

Revelation 4–18 deals primarily with the events of the 7 year Tribulation with some interludes. Revelation 17 concerns the Judgment and Falling of the Harlot, the Woman, the City of Babylon the Great,

who rides on the Beast, the Antichrist, and sits on many waters or the Nations of the Earth. The Beast, the Antichrist, and his 10 Kings, will wage war against the Lamb but will be overcome. The Beast, the Antichrist, and his 10 Kings, will destroy the Harlot, the Woman, the City of Babylon. Revelation 18 concerns the Falling of the Harlot, the Woman, the City of Babylon the Great, who has corrupted the Nations of the Earth with her immorality and shedding the blood of the saints and prophets. Then in one day she Babylon will be burned up by the Antichrist and his agents, who God uses to Judge the Harlot. The Kings and the merchants, the great men of the Earth, stand and watch her being thrown down and burned and they both weep and morn over her destruction and her wealth being eliminated.

This Judgment was by God was for the saints, the apostles, and the prophets.

Revelation 19 concerns the Great Multitude and the saints in Heaven praising God, the proclaimed reign of the Lord, the marriage of the Lamb, the marriage supper of the Lamb, and

the Second coming of Christ with His armies of saints in Wrath, to smite and Rule the Nations. Then there is the assembling of the Birds for the Great Supper of God, the assembling of the Beast and the Kings of the Earth to make war with Christ and His army, the throwing of the Beast and the False Prophet into the Lake of Fire, the Killing of the Beast's army, and the eating of their flesh by the Birds.

Jesus taking back all Rule and all Authority of the Earth

The Kingdom of the World becoming the Kingdom of the Lord and His beginning to reign and His Wrath at His coming and His Judging the Dead and His rewarding His bondservants the saints and the prophets and His destroying of the Earth, was first announced with the 7th Trumpet Angel, in Rev 11:15-18 and is fulfilled here in Rev 19:11-21. Also, His Kingdom and authority have come, Rev 12:10

The God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed

Daniel 2:44

44 "In the days of those kings the God of heaven will set up a kingdom which will never be destroyed, and that kingdom will not be left for another people;

it (that kingdom) will crush and put an end to all these kingdoms, but it (that kingdom) will itself endure forever.

When He (Christ) has abolished all rule and all authority and power

then comes **the end**, when **He (Christ)** hands over **the kingdom** to **the God** and **Father** 1 Corinthians 15:22–28

22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ all will be made alive.

- 23 But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, after that those who are Christ's at His coming,
- 24 then comes the end, when He (Christ) hands over the kingdom to the God and Father,
 - when He (Christ) has abolished all rule and all authority and power. Dan 7:14,
- 25 For He (Christ) must reign until He has put all His enemies under His feet.
- 26 The last enemy that will be abolished is death.
- 27 For He (Christ) has put all things in subjection under His feet.

But when He (Christ) says, "All things are put in subjection,"

it is evident that He (the Father) is excepted who put all things in subjection to Him (Christ).

28 When all things are subjected to Him (Christ),

then the Son Himself also will be subjected to the One (the Father)

who subjected all things to Him (Christ), so that God may be all in all.

A Great Multitude in Heaven, praising and glorifying God for His Judgments Working Outline > Read Revelation 19:1-6 (Portion of Paragraph ¶ from NAS Bible) Revelation 19:1-6

After these things, John heard a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, Rev 19:1-2a Rev 19:1 begins with "After these things", meaning after the events of Rev 18:1-24.

"After these things", is referred to 9 times in Revelation,

which speaks to the Chronology of Events in Revelation, in Rev 1:19, 4:1, 7:9, 9:12, 15:5, 18:1, 19:1, 20:3, especially in Rev 1:19 and then from Rev 4:1 to Rev 19:1.

I (John) heard something like a loud voice of a great multitude in heaven, like in Rev 7:9, 11:15, 19:6 (a loud voice) saying, "Hallelujah!, like in Rev 19:3, 19:4, 19:6

The word **alleluia** is the Greek form of the Hebrew word **hallelujah**, which means "**praise the Lord**." The **Praising of the Lord** in **Heaven** is sung for the following **reasons**.

- 1) Because He (God) has judged the great harlot, Rev 19:2
- 2) Because He (God) has avenged the blood of His bond-servants, Rev 19:2
- 3) Because the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns, Rev 19:6
- 4) Because the marriage of the Lamb (Jesus) has come, Rev 19:7

saying, **"Salvation, glory,** and **power** belong to **our God"**, like the **praising** in Rev 7:9, 10, 12, 4:9, 11, 12:10 These things belong to **God**, **"because His judgments** are **true** and **righteous"**, as in Rev 6:10, 15:3, 16:6-7

for He has judged the great harlot, Rev 19:2b

for (Reason) He (God) has judged the great harlot (Babylon), judgment as in Rev 17:1, 18:20, 16:19, who (Babylon) was corrupting the earth with her immorality, as in Rev 17:2, 17:4, 18:3, 18:9,

and He has avenged the blood of His bond-servants on her." 6:10, 16:6, 18:20, 18:24, Deut 32:43 God has avenged His bond-servants, as promised in the 5th Seal, for those under the altar, in Rev 6:10

as in the **3rd Bowl Judgment**, Rev 16:6, as in the **Judgment** of **Babylon**, Rev 18:20, 18:24, and in Deut 32:43, "For He will avenge the blood of His servants, and will render vengeance on His adversaries."

Romans 12:19

"Never take **your own revenge, beloved**, but leave room for the **wrath** of **God**, for it is written, "**vengeance** is mine, **I will repay**," says **the Lord**." Also, in Deut 32:35, Heb 10:30, 1 Thes 4:6

a second time they said, "Hallelujah! Rev 19:3

Then a second time they, the great multitude in Heaven, said, "Hallelujah! or "praise the Lord". Her (Babylon's) smoke, of her burning, rises up forever and ever", as in Rev 18:9, 18:18,

The Beast's worshippers smoke of their torment goes up forever and ever, in Rev 14:11 "Hallelujah! is interpreted as "praise the Lord" 50 times in the OT.

Rev 19:2-3 continues the last segment of Rev 18:20–24 by emphasizing Babylon's judgment.

The 24 elders and the 4 living creatures fell down and worshiped God, Rev 19:4

Then the twenty-four elders and the four living creatures fell down and worshiped God. The **24 Elders**, Rev 4:4, 4:10, 5:8, 7:11, 11:16,

Elders in the Bible are always Men and Not Angels the only other choice.

Therefore, if **Men, they** are **Men** who are, at this point in time, in **Heaven**. See *Lesson* 09 for more. The **24 Elders** Rev **4**:6-8, **5**:6, **5**:8, **5**:14, **6**:1, **6**:3, **6**:5, **6**:6, **6**:7, **7**:11, **1**4:3, **1**5:7, **19**:4

The **4 living creatures**, Rev 4:6, 4:8, 5:6, 5:8, 5:14, 6:1, 6:3, 6:5, 6:6, 6:7, 7:11, 14:3, 15:7, 19:4 The **4 living creatures**, each one of **them** having **six wings**, Rev 4:8, Isa 6:2,

Only Angels are said to have wings in the Bible, so the four living creatures must be Angelic Spiritual Beings. Seraphim Angels are said to have 6 Wings, in Isa 6:2, Rev 4:8, therefore, these 4 living creatures must be Seraphim Angels. See Lesson 09 for more.

They both, **fell down** and **worshiped God who sits** on **the throne**, as in Rev 4:10, 5:14, 7:11, 11:16 They both were saying, "Amen (to affirm) and **Hallelujah**!" or "**praise the Lord**", as in Rev 19:1, 19:3, 19:6

a voice came from the throne, saying, "Give praise to our God, all you bond-servants, Rev 19:5 Then a (divine) voice came from the throne, saying, "Give praise to our God, Ps 135:1, 148:1-2, 150:1-6,

praise > to glorify, honor, and commend God in worship

all you His bond-servants (believers), Rev 1:1, 2:20, 7:3, 11:18, 15:3, 19:2, 22:3, 22:6.

you (believers) who fear (reverence) Him, the small and the great." Rev 11:18, Ps 115:13, Ps 22:23, Therefore, the 24 Elders, the 4 living creatures, and God's bond-servants (believers), all Give praise to God.

the voice of a great multitude saying, "Hallelujah! For the Lord our God, reigns, Rev 19:6 Then John heard something like the voice of a great multitude, as in Rev 7:9, 11:15, 19:1 and like the sound of many waters, and like the sound of mighty peals of thunder, Rev 1:15, 4:5, 8:5, 14:2, 16:18

a great multitude saying, "Hallelujah ! or "praise the Lord", For (Reason) the Lord our God, the Almighty, reigns. Rev 12:10, 19:15, Lk 1:32-33, 1 Cor 15:25, Ps 146:10, ls 24:3,

"The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of His Christ;

and He will reign forever and ever", Rev 11:15, and He has "begun to reign", Rev 11:17

The Lord has always reigned (ruled) over All Creation, but the Triune US God said let man Rule Over All the Earth, Gen 1:26. This is called "Theocratic Rule" or a "Theocracy" as a form of government or Rule

in which **God** is recognized as the supreme **Ruling authority,** but **He** delegates His **divine authority** to another to **manage the affairs** of or **Rule** of **His government** or **Kingdom**.

But man falls and forfeits his Rule, and Satan became the Ruler of this world or Earth, Jn 12:31, 16:11. Satan has been Ruling since the Fall, but is still under the supreme Ruler Yahweh and still subject to

the Restrainer, the Holy Spirit, 2 Thes 2:1-10, but he Satan, like the Antichrist, will be slain by Christ and brought to an end at the appearance of Christ, 2 Thes 2:7-9, Rev 19:20, 20:10, 1 Cor 15:24.

"then comes **the end**, when **He** hands over **the kingdom** to **the God** and **Father**,

when **He** has abolished all rule and all authority and power", 1 Cor 15:24

The marriage of the Lamb has come, and His bride has made herself ready Working Outline > Read Revelation 19:7-10 (Portion of Paragraph ¶ from NAS Bible) Revelation 19:7-10

- 1. 7 "Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him, 11:13, Lk 2:14, Rom 4:20

The marriage of the Lamb has come, and His bride has made herself ready, Rev 19:7-8 Then he (the angel) said "Let us rejoice and be glad and give the glory to Him (the Lamb),

Rejoice, Matt 5:12, Lk 10:20, 1 Pet 4:13, and **give the glory** to **Him**, Rev 11:13, Lk 2:14, Rom 4:20 **Rejoice** Because, **the marriage of the Lamb** has **come** Rev 19:9, Eph 5:22-32,

and His (Jesus') bride has made herself ready." 21:2, 21:9, 22:17, 2 Cor 11:2,

the marriage of the Lamb has come, Rev 19:7

The Marriage of Christ the Bridegroom, Jn 3:29, has now come for Him to formally marry His Bride.

His Bride has made herself ready by having been given by God "to clothe herself in fine linen" because "the fine linen is the righteous acts of the saints". Those in fine linen are clearly those in "the Book of Life", Rev 3:4-5, or Believers or the Church as defined here.

the Church is all those baptized in the Spirit, Matt 3:11, or those made to drink of the Spirit, 1 Cor 12:13, or those "born of the Spirit", Jn 3:8, or those permanently indwelled by the Holy Spirit, John 14:16, after the Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ.

the Church is All those now under the New Covenant, "as servants of a new covenant,

not of the letter (the Law) but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life", 2 Cor 3:6

This includes All Jews and Greeks baptized of the Holy Spirit from Acts 2 until Christ's coming, often called the Church age, that ends with the Rapture of the Church.

the Church is made up of primarily of Gentiles with a remnant of Jews, Rom 11:5-10.

The mystery Marriage of Christ to the Church, under the New Covenant

There is the marriage of the Lamb to His People the Church,

the marriage of the Lamb, to His bride the Church, has come, Eph 5:22-32,

This **mystery** is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church (His wife), Eph 5:32.

The Mystery: the Gentiles are fellow heirs with Israel and members of the body of Christ Ephesians 3:3-6

3 that by revelation there was made known to me the mystery, as I wrote before in brief.

4 By referring to this, when **you** read **you** can understand **my** insight into the **mystery** of **Christ**, **5** which (mystery) in other generations was not made known to the sons of men,

as it (mystery) has now been revealed to His holy apostles and prophets in the Spirit; 6 to be specific, that the Gentiles are fellow heirs and fellow members of the body, and fellow partakers of the promise in Christ Jesus through the gospel,

Mysteries > Hidden Things or Kept Secret Things of God

Mysteries in the Bible are those things <u>revealed</u> by God, that were <u>previously hidden</u> by God. Rom 16:25-26

The Metaphor of: the Marriage of Christ and Believer's Marriages

Ephesians 5:22–32

22 Wives, be subject to your own husbands, as to the Lord.

23 For the husband is the head of the wife, as Christ also is the head (Husband) of the church, He Himself being the Savior of the body (the Church, His wife).

24 But as the church (His wife) is subject to Christ,

so also the wives ought to be to their husbands in everything.

25 Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ also loved the church and gave Himself up for her,

26 so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word,

27 that He might present to Himself the church (His wife) in all her glory,

having no spot or wrinkle or any such thing; but that she (His wife) would be holy and blameless. 28 So husbands ought also to love their own wives as their own bodies.

He who loves his own wife loves himself;

29 for no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it,

just as Christ also does the church (His wife),

30 because we (His wife) are members of His body (the Church).

31 For this reason a man shall leave his father and mother and shall be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh.

32 This mystery is great; but I am speaking with reference to Christ and the church (His wife).

Conclusion From Lesson 08 See Chart there

Those **Born of God, Overcomers, His Bride** will be Given by **God Clean White Fine Linen Robes**, Rev 3:4-5, 19:8 Because the **fine linen** is the **righteous acts** of **the saints**, Rev 19:8

Because **they** are **Worthy** and have **Overcome** the World by **Faith** and **Belief** in Jesus, Rev 3:4-5, 1 John 5:4–5 Because **they** were **Washed**, **Sanctified**, and **Justified** with the **Blood** of **Lamb**, Rev 7:15, 1 Cor 6:11 Because of the **Blood** of **Lamb** their **Sins** are **Forgiven** and **they** are **Reconciled** to **God**, Col 1:21-22

The Marriage of Christ to the Church, is different from the Marriage to Israel

The Marriage, Divorce, and Re-Marriage of the Nation of Israel, under the Old Covenant

There is the **marriage** of **God** to **His People**, the Nation of Israel, as described in Hosea. First, the Lord a faithful husband, marries by Covenant an adulteress harlot wife, Israel, Hos 2:2, 4, 5

Israel, an adulteress harlot wife, goes after other lovers, Hos 2:2, 4, 5

the Lord says; therefore Israel is Not My wife and I am Not her husband, Hos 2:2

the Lord divorces His wife, He gives her a Writ of divorce, Hos 2:2, Jer 3:8, Isa 50:1, Deut 24:1-2


the Lord sends her away, as in dispersing, (10 Tribes, Jer 3:8, Isa 50:1, 2 tribes, 2 Kings 24:1-2, Deut 28:64-65)


the Lord is separated from His wife Israel, and has No compassion for her children, Hos 2:4-5 the Lord divorces His wife, for many days, she will be without a King or sacrifice, Hos 3:4

After many days, in the last days, Israel His wife will return and seek the Lord and David her King, Hos 3:4 in the last days, Israel His wife, will come trembling to the Lord, and return and seek her husband, Hos 3:4-5 the Lord a faithful husband, will re-marry His adulteress harlot wife Israel, Hos 3:5

"I will betroth you to Me forever, in righteousness, justice, lovingkindness, and compassion, Hos 2:19 "I will sow her for Myself in the land and have compassion on her, Hos 2:23

"I will say to those who were not My people, 'You are My people!' they will say, 'You are my God !", Hos 2:23 This is explained in great detail on my personal website, <u>http://allscriptureinspired.com/hosea/</u>





the marriage supper of the Lamb, Rev 19:9

9 Then he (angel) said to me (John),

"Write, 1:19 'Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb." And he (angel) said to me (John), "These are true words of God."

The Marriage of Christ the Bridegroom, Jn 3:29, has now come for Him to formally marry His Bride. His Bride has made herself ready by having been given by God "to clothe herself in fine linen", Rev 19:7. Then the angel continues by saying, "Blessed are those who are invited to the marriage supper of the Lamb"

There are many different views as to WHERE this **supper** is and WHO will attend **it**.

- I think the ones **Blessed** are **those invited** to **the supper**, which are **those** who **clothe themselves** in **fine linen**, and **those** who made **themselves ready**, in **Rev 19:7**.
- These **invited** are **the Bride**, **the wife of the Lamb**, **the Church**, or **truly prepared** (ready) **Believers**. I don't think those outside of **Church** are **the ones invited** as **supper guests**, in this context.
- Those **invited** are there because **they** are **"Blessed**" or shown favor by **God**, and **they** are the **ready** ones. Also, there will be millions of **Church members** there, all **saved** over the last **2000 years**.
- This doesn't mean that no one outside of **the Church** will attend, it means that only **the Church** is spoken of in this passage. Probably **the angels** and the **living creatures** and **Elders** will be there.

Jewish Wedding Customs

the marriage supper of the Lamb is best understood in light of the Jewish wedding customs in the time of Christ. These Jewish wedding customs had three major parts.

First, a marriage contract as in a covenant agreement was signed by the parents of the bride and groom, and the parents of the groom or the groom himself would pay a dowry to the bride or her parents.

This began what was called **the betrothal period**, what we would today call **the engagement**.

This period was the one **Joseph** and **Mary** were in when **she** was found to be with **child** (Matt 1:18, Luke 2:5). **The second step** in the process usually occurred **a year later**, when **the groom**, accompanied by **his male friends**, went to the house of **the bride** at **midnight**, creating a torchlight parade through the streets.

The bride would know in advance this was going to take place, and so she would be **ready** with her maidens, and they would all join the parade and end up at the groom's home.

This custom is the basis of **the parable of the ten virgins** in Matt 25:1–13.

The third phase was the marriage supper itself, which might go on for days,

as illustrated by the **wedding** at **Cana** in John 2:1–2.

Jewish Wedding Customs applied to the marriage supper of the Lamb Rev 19:7-10 concerns

the marriage supper of the Lamb (Jesus Christ) and His bride (the Church) in its third phase. The first phase was completed on earth beginning in Acts 2, when each individual called person, of the newly formed Church, Eph 2:11-13, placed their faith in Christ, under the New Covenant.

The dowry paid to the bridegroom's (Jesus') parent (the Father) was the blood of Christ

"which He purchased with His own blood", Rev 5:9, 14:3-4, Acts 20:28, Eph 2:13,

that dowry paid on the Bride's behalf, she was "bought for a price", 1 Cor 6:20.

The Church on earth today, then, is "betrothed" to Christ, like the parable of the virgins, Matt 25:1-13.

We should be **ready**, for the appearance of **the Bridegroom** at the **Rapture** for **the Church**. The **second phase** symbolizes the **Rapture** of **the Church**, when **Christ comes** to claim **His Bride**

and take her to the Father's house, before the 7 year Tribulation begins.

The **third phase** is **the marriage supper** of **the Lamb** when **the Church** is already in Heaven, with Christ, which takes place in heaven at the end of the **7 year Tribulation** on **earth**.

The marriage supper of the Lamb is a glorious celebration of all who are in Christ!

Key Point, Marriage Illustrations, Parables, Analogies, and Metaphors must be understood

in their proper context, especially according to the intended **people group**.

Marriage Illustrations, in the Old Testament relate to the Nation of Israel, like in Hosea.

Marriage Illustrations and Parables, and in the 4 Gospels, relate to the Nation of Israel,

like the Parables of the Wedding Feast, Matt 22, the 10 Virgins, Matt 25,

and when the "bridegroom" is referred to in Matt 9:15, Jn 3:29.

Marriage Illustrations in Paul's Epistles relate mostly to the Church, like Eph 5:22–32

Marriage Illustration in Rev 19:7-10, relates to the Marriage of the Bride, the Church.

Marriage Illustrations in Rev 21:2, 21:9-10, relate to the "Holy City" "Jerusalem" as a "Bride", 1000 years later.

John fell at his feet to worship him, Rev 19:10

Then I (John) fell at his feet to worship him (angel), as John did in Rev 22:8, Heb 1:14

But he (angel) said to (John), "Do not do that", as the angel did in Rev 22:8-9.

Then the angel said,

I am a fellow servant of yours (John) and your brethren, as the angel did in Rev 22:8-9,

where he explains who John's brethren are, "the prophets and those who heed the words of this book". This is referred to in Rev 1:3.

Revelation 1:3

3 Blessed is he who reads and those who hear the words of the prophecy, and **heed** the things which are written in **it**; for (Reason) the time is near.

Also, "(those) who hold the testimony of Jesus, as in Believers Rev 1:9, 6:9, 12:17, 20:4, 1 John 5:10,

instead worship God, like Jesus said to Satan, in Matt 4:10

1 John 5:10

10 The one who believes in the Son of God has the testimony in himself;

the one who does not believe God has made Him a liar,

because (Reason) he has **not believed** in **the testimony**

that God has given concerning His Son.

I am a fellow servant of yours (John) and your brethren,

Hebrews 1:14

14 Are they (angels) not all ministering spirits, sent out to render service (servants) for the sake of **those** who will inherit **salvation** (**Believers**)?

"For the testimony of Jesus", is the spirit of prophecy."

Is the **spirit** of **prophecy**, which is **those things revealed** to **John** in the book of Revelation.

Jesus' testimony in "spirit", "the activating or essential principle influencing a person", Websters

Whereas Jesus is acting in a "spirit" of revealing what He has said, as in His testimony.

and He (Jesus) who sat on it (horse) is called Faithful and True, as said in Rev 3:14 and "True", in Rev 16:7. The one on the horse must be Jesus, as identified by His many Names, as in "the word of God", Rev 19:13.

and in **righteousness He (Jesus) judges**, as **prophesied 3000 years** ago, in Ps 96:13, Ps 9:8, Isa 11:4a Psalm 96:13

13 Before the Lord, for He is coming, For He is coming to judge the earth.

He will judge the world in righteousness And (judge) the peoples in His faithfulness.

And "because His judgments are true and righteousness" Rev 19:2 And because all judgment has been given to the Son (Jesus) John 5:22, Jn 5:27, Jn 5:30, 22 "For not even the Father judges anyone, but He has given all judgment to the Son, John 5:22 in righteousness He (Jesus) wages war. Jesus wages war righteously, or rightly, justly, or correctly, according to God's standard for righteousness. "He will judge the world in righteousness", Ps 9:8, Acts 17:31 Jesus wages war with those who do not repent, Rev 2:16 This is, "the war of the great day of God, the Almighty", in Rev 16:14 This is, the war waged against the Lamb, in Rev 17:14, Rev 19:19 the Second coming of Jesus Christ to Earth Chart This is the Second coming of Jesus Christ to Earth from Heaven as prophesied and promised many, many times in the Old and New Testament. This identifies Jesus with Judgment in the blood shed by Unbelievers, in Isa 63:1-6, Rev 14:20, Rev 19:21 Jesus' name is called The Word of God, as in Jn 1:1-5, Jn 1:14, Heb 4:12, 1 Jn 1:1 This identifies Jesus as God, with the Father in the beginning, who brought all things into being, Jn 1:1-3

This Jesus is the one from the beginning, with the Father, who was manifested, seen, and heard, 1 Jn 1:1-3

the armies which are in heaven, in fine linen, were following Him on white horses, Rev 19:14 Also, the armies which are in heaven, were following Jesus

"the armies which are in heaven" can refer to either Angels or saints/holy ones or both Angels and saints. Angels are referred to as coming with Christ, in Matt 24:31, Matt 25:31, 2 Thes 1:7

Saints/holy ones are referred to as coming with Christ, in 1 Thes 3:13, 2 Thes 1:10, Jude 14-15

We know that **believers** will be with **Him** always, in **1** Thes **4**:17, once **raptured**.

We know that believers are clothed in fine linen, white and clean, Rev 3:4, 7:9, 19:8,

We know that fine linen, "is the righteous acts of the saints", in Rev 19:8, Rev 7:14

With these things in mind, I think the Saints and the Angels are with Him when He comes.

"....and those (believers) who are with Him are the called and chosen and faithful", Rev 17:14

But neither does **war** with **Christ's enemies**, **Christ** does all the **killing** by **Himself**, Rev 19:21, Isa 63:3 The **Angels** have already carried out much **destruction/killing** in the **Seal**, **Trumpet**, and **Bowl Judgments**. The **Saints** have been told that **vengeance** is to be carried out by **God** and Not by **them**.

"Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath of God,

for it is written, "vengeance is mine, I will repay," says the Lord." Rom 12:19

the armies, Saints and Angels, were following Him on white horses.

Then Christ went forth first, and the Saints and Angels, were following His lead.

From Jesus' mouth comes a sharp sword, that He may strike down the nations, Rev 19:15

Jesus is on His white horse and from His mouth comes a sharp sword, 1:16, 2:12, 2:16, 19:21, Isa 49:2, Heb 4:12, This the "sharp two-edged sword" is spoken of by John in Rev 1:16 and Rev 2:12

This is the "the sword of My (Jesus') mouth" that Jesus "will make war" with, in Rev 2:16.

This is the "the sword which came from the mouth" of Jesus that kills the earth's armies, in Rev 19:21.

The meaning of **the sword** is revealed in, Isa 11:4, Heb 4:12, 2 Thes 2:8

Isaiah 11:4

4 But with righteousness He will judge the poor, And decide with fairness for the afflicted of the earth; And He will strike the earth with the rod of His mouth, And with the breath of His lips, He will slay the wicked.

Hebrews 4:12

12 For the word of God (what God says) is living and active and sharper than any two-edged sword, and (the word is) piercing as far as the division of soul and spirit, of both joints and marrow, and (the word is) able to judge the thoughts and intentions of the heart.

2 Thessalonians 2:8

8 Then that lawless one will be revealed whom the Lord will slay with the breath of His mouth and bring to an end by the appearance of His coming;

The sword in Jesus' mouth is Not a metal sword, but is a figure of speech, as in Personification.

Personification is a literary device that gives human characteristics to nonhuman things or inanimate objects.

The sword in Jesus' mouth is "the word of God" (what God says), Heb 4:12 that He will use to "slay with the breath of His mouth", the lawless one, the Antichrist, 2 Thes 2:8, and what He will use to "slay the wicked" "with the breath of His lips", Isa 11:4 and what He will use to "strike down the nations", here in Rev 19:15 Jesus' word(s) "the breath of His mouth", will "slay the wicked" and "strike down the nations".

The sword is so that (Reason) with it (sword) He may strike down the nations, Isa 11:4, 2 Thes 2:8 The sword (Jesus' word) is so that (Reason) with it (His word) He may strike down the nations.

Jesus will rule the nations with a rod of iron, Rev 19:15b

He (Jesus) will rule them (the nations) with a rod of iron (a scepter or staff), Rev 2:27, 12:5, Isa 11:4, Ps 2:8-9, Revelation 2:27

27 and He shall rule them with a rod of iron, as the vessels of the potter are broken to pieces,

as I (Jesus) also have received authority from My Father;

Revelation 12:5

5 And she gave birth to a son (Jesus), a male child,

who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron (scepter);

and her child (Jesus) was caught up to God and to His throne.

Isaiah 11:4

4 But with **righteousness He** will **judge** the poor,

And decide with fairness for the afflicted of the earth;

And **He** will **strike the earth** with **the rod** of **His mouth**,

scepter > something carried by rulers as a symbol of sovereignty, authority, power, and strength. Genesis 49:10 As said by Jacob, Blessing Judah

10 "The scepter shall not depart from Judah, Nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, Until Shiloh (Messiah) comes, And to him shall be the obedience of the peoples.

a rod of iron (a scepter or staff), (a metaphor) for Jesus' rule of all the nations by the word of His mouth.

Jesus treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty, Rev 19:15c

and He (Jesus) treads the wine press Rev 14:19-20, Isa 63:2-6, Joel 3:13

of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty. 14:10, 14:19-20, 16:19, Jer 25:15,

Revelation 14:19–20

- 19 So the angel swung his sickle to the earth and gathered the clusters from the vine of the earth, and threw them (clusters) into the great wine press of the wrath of God.
- 20 And the wine press was trodden outside the city, and blood came out from the wine press, up to the horses' bridles, for a distance of two hundred miles.

"King of Kings, and Lord of Lords" 17:14, 1 Tim 6:15, Deut 10:17, Dan 2:47 Revelation 17:14

14 "These (Kings) will wage war against the Lamb, and the Lamb will overcome them,

because He is Lord of Lords and King of Kings,

and those (believers) who are with Him are the called and chosen and faithful." Rev 19:14

1 Timothy 6:14–15

14 that you keep the commandment without stain or reproach

until the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ,

15 which <mark>He will bring about at **the proper time**—</mark>

He who is the blessed and only Sovereign, the King of Kings, and Lord of Lords,

Jesus in 2 places on His person that identifies Him as "King of Kings, and Lord of Lords"
