BOOK OF REVELATION — REVELATION 20: 1-6 THE THINGS SEEN AND ARE AND WHAT SHALL TAKE PLACE

In Revelation 19, Christ comes and kills all the armies of the Beast gathered by Demons.

Jerusalem at 2nd Coming and the Lord will be King over all the Earth, Zechariah 14

Also, **Christ** will gather all the **Nations** against **Jerusalem** and **it** will be captured, **Zech 14:2**Then **Christ** will fight against those **Nations**, **Zech 14:3**, 14:12-13

Then Christ comes and stands on the Mt. of Olives and it will be spit in two causing a large Valley, Zech 14:4

Then the people of Jerusalem will flee East by that Valley, to Azel (Azal), Zech 14:5

In that Day, there will be No Light, but at evening time, there will be Light, Zech 14:6-7

It will come about, that Living Waters will flow from Jerusalem, both East and West, Zech 14:8

In that Day, the Lord will be King over all the Earth, Zech 14:9

In that Day, Israel's Land will be changed into a plain, But Jerusalem will rise up, Zech 14:10, Micah 4:1

In that Day, people will live in Jerusalem with No Curse and in security, Zech 14:11

Then, all of Nations not killed, will go up to Jerusalem and worship the Lord, Zech 14:16

Then, everyone will celebrate the Feast of Booths, or be punished by the Lord, Zech 14:16-19, Lev 23:42-43

Israel's unequaled Time of Distress, and their Resurrection, Daniel 12

At that time Michael, who guards Israel, will arise. It will be an unequaled time of distress for Israel, Dan 12:1 But everyone of Israel in the Book of Life, will be rescued, Dan 12:1

At that time many dead will be Resurrected, either to everlasting life or everlasting contempt, Dan 12:2-3 How long will it be until the End of these wonders?, Dan 12:6

The **time of distress** for **Israel** will be **3** ½ **years** (1260 days), until **Israel's** shattering is completed, Dan 12:7 From the time that the **regular sacrifice** is **abolished**, and the **abomination of desolation** is set up, there will be **1,290 days** (1260 days + 30 days), Dan 12:11, Rev 13:1-10

Blessed is he who waits and attains to the 1,335 days! (1260 days + 30 days + 45 days), Dan 12:12
The (30 days + 45 days), is the **Time** between **the End** of the (1260 day) **Tribulation** of **Israel**, Rev 18, and the setting up for the Millennial Kingdom, Dan 7:27

The (30 days + 45 days), is probably when the **Sheep** and **Goat Judgment** occurs, Matt 25:31-46
The **Sheep** go into the **Kingdom** and the **Goats** go to **eternal punishment**, Matt 25:46
The (30 days + 45 days), a transitional period between the **End** of the **Tribulation**, Rev 19:11-21, and the **Beginning** of the **Millennial Kingdom**, Rev 20:4.

Revelation 20 covers many major events that occur over a 1000 year period.

- I. The Millennium Kingdom, the Resurrections, the Judgments, and the 2nd Death, Rev 20:1–15
 - A. Satan is bound by an Angel and thrown into the Abyss for a 1000 years, 20:1–3
 - B. 1st Resurrection, Saints, reign with Christ for a 1000 years, 20:4–6
 - 1. Millennial Kingdom, Many OT Passages refer to the Millennium, and the Nation of Israel
 - 2. Israel is Resurrected, comes to Life out of graves, Ezek 37:1-14, Dan 12:2, Isa 26:19, Rev 20:4
 - 3. Israel is gathered, Judged, and brought into the bond of Covenant, Ezek 20:33-44,
 - 4. **Israel** is **Restored**, Deut 3:30-31, 4:25-31, 30:1-10, Ezek 11:13-21, 16:60-62, 20:33:34, 28:25-26, 34:11-31, 36:16-3, Jer 30:1-24, 31:23-40, 32:36-44, 33:7-26, Zech 13:1-9, 14:1-21, and others.
 - 5. When Jesus comes, He will take away Israel's sins and All Israel will be saved, Rom 11:25-32
 - 6. Christ builds Temple (Ezekiel's), in Jerusalem, on Mt. Zion, Zech 6:12-13, Ezek 40:1-43:27
 - 7. The Promised Land will be divided for Israel in the Millennial Kingdom, Ezek 47:13-48:23
 - 8. The **New Covenant** will be **fulfilled** for **Israel**, Jer 31:31-34, Ezek 36:24-28, and Many more Passages See my personal website, http://allscriptureinspired.com/covenants-bible-study/
 - 9. The Abrahamic Covenant will be fulfilled for Israel, my website, Gen 12, 13, 15, 17, 18, 22

- 10. The Davidic Covenant will be fulfilled for Israel, my website, 2 Sam 7:8-17, 1 Chron 17:1-16, Psalm 89
- 11. The Deuteronomic Covenant will be fulfilled for Israel, my website, Deut 29 & Deut 30
- 12. Thrones for Judgment were set up, for All Saints, both Jew and Gentile, 20:4
- 13. Then the souls of Martyred Tribulation Saints are Resurrected, 20:4
 - a. This is the 1st Resurrection, which is for Saints, 20:5
 - b. All Non-Tribulation Saints were Raptured/Resurrected previously, 1 Thes 4:13-18, I Cor 15:51-54
- 14. All Saints, both Jew and Gentile, reign on thrones with Christ, for 1000 years, 20:4
 - a. They will be Priests of God and of Christ, and Reign with Christ, 20:6
- 15. Christ Reigning on Throne in Jerusalem, on Mt. Zion, in Temple (Ezekiel's), Zech 6:12-13, 8:3, Isa 9:6-7, Jer 33:14-17, Luke 1:31–33, Isa 2:1–4, Micah 4:1–3, Ezek 34:22–24, 43:1-7,
 - a. The 12 Apostles and David will be reigning on thrones with Christ, Matt 19:28, Jer 30:9, Ezk 37:24
- C. After 1000 years, Satan will be released from Abyss to deceive and gather Nations, 20:7-8
- D. Satan and Gog and Magog Nations and their armies surround Saints and Jerusalem, 20:9
 - 1. then Fire from Heaven consumed their armies, 20:9
- E. Satan is thrown into Lake of Fire to be tormented forever, 20:10
- F. Great White Throne for Christ set up and Earth and Heaven have fled away, 20:11
 - 1. Unbelievers from Death and Hades are Resurrected and Judged for their Deeds, 20:12-13
 - 2. This is the 2nd Death, Judged Unbelievers are thrown into Lake of Fire, 20:14-15

an angel comes from heaven, and seizes and binds the dragon for a thousand years Working Outline > Read Revelation 20:1-3 (Paragraph ¶ from NAS Bible)

Revelation 20:1-3

- 1 Then I (John) saw an angel coming down from heaven, 10:1,
 - A. holding the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand. 1:18, 9:1-2, Jude 6,
 - B. 2 And he (angel) laid hold of (seized) the dragon, Rev 12:9,
 - 1. the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, Gen 3:1, Rev 12:7-9
 - 2. and bound him (Jude 6) for a thousand years; 20:3, 20:4, 20:5, 20:6, 20:7
 - 3. 3 and he (angel) threw him into the abyss, Lk 8:31, Rom 10:7, 9:1-2, 9:11, 11:7, 17:8, Jude 6,
 - 4. and shut it (abyss) and sealed it over him, Isa 24:22, 2 Pet 2:4,
 - C. so that (Reason) he (Satan) would not deceive the nations any longer,
 - 1. until the thousand years were completed; 20:7
 - D. after these things he (Satan) must be released for a short time. 20:7

an angel coming from heaven, holding the key of the abyss and a great chain, Rev 20:1 Then John saw an angel coming down from heaven, like the angel in Rev 10:1.

This angel was holding 2 things, the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand. 1:18, 9:1-2, Jude 6, "the key of the abyss" is Not a metal Key, but a Wetaphor > a figure of speech in which a word or phrase literally denoting one kind of object or idea is used in place of another to suggest a likeness, Websters "Key"> the means for gaining access to something by their owner, as in the Key to success or Key to your heart.

This is like the 5th Trumpet Angel in Rev 9:1-2

"the key of the bottomless pit was given to him" and "He opened the bottomless pit"

Jesus has the "the keys of death and of Hades", Rev 1:18. Keys give access to a place or thing by their owner, here a Metaphor and Death is a Condition and Hades is a place, the Grave, the abode of the Dead.

"the abyss", (Grk. Abussos), is the bottomless pit, Rev 9:1-2, the dwelling place where certain Demon Angels and here Satan are kept or in "prison", Rev 20:7, "in bonds" temporarily or eternally, Jude 9. "the abyss", is where "the angel (Demon) of the abyss; "Abaddon" or "Apollyon" comes from, Rev 9:11. "the abyss", is where "the Beast (Antichrist) comes out of, to kill the 2 witnesses, Rev 11:7, Rev 17:8 "the abyss", is where Satan is kept or in "prison", Rev 20:7, "in bonds" temporarily, for a 1000 years, until he is released by God to deceive the Nations, Rev 20:7-8.

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"the abyss", is where God "committed them (Demons) to pits of darkness, reserved for judgment" 2 Pet 2:4
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The "great chain" is Not a metal Chain, but a Wetaphor > a figure of speech in which a word or phrase literally denoting one kind of object or idea is used in place of another to suggest a likeness, Websters "Chain" > something that confines, restrains, or secures, Websters as in "My baby's got me locked up in chains" "Whoa, these chains of love", from song Chains by the Beatles.

The angel laid hold of the dragon, and bound him for a thousand years, Rev 20:2 Then the angel laid hold of or seized (ESV) the dragon, Satan.

Here are 4 names for him, the dragon, the serpent of old, who is the devil and Satan, Gen 3:1, Rev 12:7-9
This is the great dragon thrown out of heaven with his angels (Demons), Rev 12:9, for the previous 3 ½ years.

The angel "laid hold of" or "seized" and "bound" the dragon with a "great chain"

The "great chain" in this case, is something that restrains, or keeps one under control, a Metaphor.

The "great chain" that restrains, is called "eternal bonds" when applied to Demon angels, in Jude 6 "And angels who did not keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode,

He has kept in eternal bonds under darkness for the judgment of the great day", Jude 6

Satan had freedom, in the Garden, in Job, in the OT, in the Gospels, and for the last 2000 years, but after Christ Comes again, he is "bound" in the "the abyss" temporarily for a 1000 years.

Satan's thousand years, is mentioned 6 times, in Rev 20:2, 20:3, 20:4, 20:5, 20:6, 20:7

a thousand years, as interpreted Non-Literally by Reformed (Covenant) Theology

How long does the millennium last?

See Lesson 04

There can be **no doubt** that it began with the completed work of Christ on earth.

Why, then, does Revelation use the expression a thousand years? In terms of biblical numbers,

ten represents fullness, and a thousand is ten times ten times ten, hence fullness times fullness times fullness.

It seems to equal a vast number of years without being a precise chronology of human history.

Nowhere else does Scripture limit the binding of **Satan** and the success of the church's mission

to a specific period of time before the end of the age. [Strawman Argument]

Moreover, there are other places in Scripture where the word **thousand** is used without being a literal number. In Psalm 50 this same number is employed in a different context, where it says that God owns "the cattle on a **thousand** hills" (v. 10) [Hyperbole]. It is an expression for fullness. It is the same in Psalm 68:17, [thousands?].

.....The message in Psalms 50 and 68 is one of fullness, and it is the same in Revelation 20.

One day, the fullness of the elect will be brought into the church, and then the end will come.

It is not a matter of literally **one thousand years**, but of God's **secret timing** as to the gathering of His people into union with Christ, however long that may take from our human perspective.

thousand years—As seven mystically implies universality, so a thousand implies perfection, whether in good or evil [Aquinas]. Thousand symbolizes that the world is perfectly leavened and pervaded by the divine; since thousand is ten, the number of the world, raised to the third power, three being the number of God.

The interpretation of the 1000 years in Revelation 20:1-15.

(3) that it is a **symbol** with a definite meaning--not of a period of time but a **symbol** of the complete and perfect rule of Christ over the lives of all fully surrendered Christians. *Norris' Commentary on the Book of Revelation*

These Non-Literal interpretations by Reformed (Covenant) Theology break most rules of interpretation.

They **interpret**, out of **context**, **add** and **subtract** meaning that is Not in scripture, and **spiritualize**, **symbolize**, and give **mystical** application to the plain straight forward meaning as literally presented in the text.

They open the door to be **cursed**, by **adding** and **subtracting** from the words of this book, Rev 22:18-19, 18 I testify to **everyone** who hears **the words of the prophecy of this book** (Revelation):

if anyone adds to them, God will add to him the plagues which are written in this book;

19 and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God will take away his part from the tree of life and from the holy city, which are written in this book. Rev 22:18-19, Deut 4:2, 12:32

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"thousand", (Greek, chilioi, 5507), 9 times, 2 Pet 3:8, Rev 12:6, 14:20, 20:2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7
"thousand", (Greek, chilias, 5505), 22 times, Lk 14:31, Acts 4:4, 1 Cor 8:10, Rev 5:11, 7:4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 11:13, 14:1, 14:3
    "Chiliasm" is derived from (Greek, chilias, 5505), a "thousand".
 Chiliasm is a teaching that Christ will reign for a literal 1000 years on earth after his 2nd coming.
Numbers without using "s", is Using a Number as an adjective
When you say you have a thousand dollars, you have exactly a thousand dollars.
When you say you have a "thousand (adjective) dollars" you're using "thousand" as an adjective
   You're describing, using an adjective, as to How Many dollars you have exactly.
1. chilioi (χίλιοι, 5507), "a thousand," occurs in 2 Pet. 3:8; Rev. 11:3; 12:6; 14:20; 20:2–7.
2. chilias (χίλιοι, 5505), "one thousand," is always used in the plural, chiliades, (See verses above)
    but translated in the singular everywhere, except in the phrase "thousands of thousands," Rev. 5:11.
          Vine's Complete Expository Dictionary of Old and New Testament Words (Vol. 2, pp. 630–631).
Rev 5:11, is better seen in KJV as,
       11 ... and the number of them was
           ten thousand (murias, 3461) times ten thousand (murias, 3461) (100,000,000),
             and thousand(s) (chilias, 5505), of thousand(s) (chilias, 5505) (1,000,000).
  (chilias, 5505), means "one thousand" exactly, (chilioi, 5507), means "one thousand" exactly,
        and (murias, 3461), means "ten thousand" exactly.
Numbers using "s", is Using a Number as a Noun
When you say you have thousands of dollars, you don't have exactly a thousand dollars.
When you say you have "thousands (noun) of dollars" you're using "thousands", as a noun.
  You're describing, using a noun, as to How Many dollars you have approximately.
      You're saying approximately How Many dollars you have plural,
         This means you could have, either 2 thousand or 10 thousand or 100 thousand dollars.
Conclusion
The word "thousand", in Greek, when used as an adjective, describes an exact number.
Sometimes "thousand" singular in Greek, is interpreted as "thousands" in our English Bibles,
    as in Lk 12:1, Acts 21:20, Jude 14, where "thousands" = "ten thousand", in Greek,
      and in Rev 5:11, where "thousands" = one "thousand", in Greek.
Therefore, "ten thousand" or "thousand" singular in Greek, is used as an adjective,
       and describes an exact number.
The word "thousands", when used as a noun, describes an approximate number,
    But "thousands" is Not used as a noun, in the NT, But always used as an adjective, in the NT.
Therefore, a thousand years, in Rev 20, means exactly a thousand years, no more and no less,
   and the Millennial Kingdom will last exactly a thousand years.
The angel threw the dragon, into the abyss, Rev 20:3a
Then the angel threw the dragon (Satan) into the abyss, Lk 8:31, Rom 10:7, 9:1-2, 9:11, 11:7, 17:8, Jude 6,
     and shut it (abyss) and sealed it over him, Isa 24:22, 2 Pet 2:4,
The angel had the key to the abyss, and then he "laid hold of" or "seized" the dragon,
   and then he "bound" the dragon with a "great chain", and then he shut the abyss,
        and then he sealed the abyss over the dragon. See discussion on "abyss", see Rev 20:1, hereon.
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a thousand years, as interpreted Literally

The angel threw the dragon, so that he would not deceive the nations any longer, Rev 20:3b Then the angel threw the dragon (Satan) into the abyss, so that (Reason) the dragon would not deceive the nations any longer, until the thousand (chilioi, 5507) years were completed, when he does deceive them. after these things he must be released for a short time. 20:7 the dragon (Satan) is "who deceives the whole world" when thrown down from Heaven, in Rev 12:9 the serpent has been deceiving the world since the Garden of Eden, 2 Cor 11:3

When the thousand years are completed, Satan will be released from his prison (the abyss), and will come out to deceive the nations which are in the four corners of the earth, Rev 20:7–8 to deceive > to cause someone to believe something that is not true, to gain some personal advantage.

Those on Thrones, beheaded, without mark of Beast, came to Life
Working Outline > Read Revelation 20:4 (Portion of Paragraph ¶ from NAS Bible)
Revelation 20:4

- 4 (4a, sentence) Then I (John) saw thrones, and they sat on them, Dan 7:9, Rev 3:21, 5:10, 20:6, 22:5,

In the **Greek**, Rev 20:4 is **2 sentences**, labeled here as (4a, sentence) and (4b, sentence). It seems that (4a, sentence) could have been split into a few more **Verses**, as is often done elsewhere.

John saw thrones, with persons, and judgment was given to them, Rev 20:4a Then John saw thrones, and they sat on them, Dan 7:9, Rev 3:21, 5:10, 20:4b, 20:6, 22:5

The Pronoun "they" can't be interpreted by the previous Context as is usually done.

The "they" here must refer to all Saints who rule in the Millennial Kingdom both Jew and Gentile.

Dan 7:27 'Then the <u>sovereignty</u>, the <u>dominion</u> and the <u>greatness</u> of **all the kingdoms** under the whole <u>heaven</u> will be given to the people of the saints of the Highest One; 7:10, 7:18, 7:22, Rev 2:26, Rev 20:4

Dan 7:18 'But the saints of the Highest One will receive the kingdom

and possess the kingdom forever, for all ages to come.' 7:22, 7:27, Rev 2:26, Rev 20:4

Dan 7:22 until the Ancient of Days came and judgment was passed in favor of the saints of the Highest One, and the time arrived when the saints took possession of the kingdom. 7:10, 7:18, 7:27, Rev 2:26, Rev 20:4 The Book of Daniel here, concern's the saints of Daniel's People, the Nation of Israel. See Lesson 11

Believers/saints reigning on thrones with Christ is mentioned, in Rev 3:21, 5:10, 20:4b, 20:6, 22:5

The "they" must refer to all those Saints, both Jew and Gentile, who will rule in the Millennial Kingdom.

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The Restoration and Resurrection of the Nation of Israel, in Ezek 36:1-38, Ezek 37:1-14
Israel's Restoration, Ezek 36:8-15
Israel's great sin and scattering, by the wrath of God, Ezek 36:16-20
the Lord's concern for His Holy Name, profaned by Israel, among the Nations, Ezek 36:16-20
the Lord vindicating His Name, but Not for Israel's sake, but His sake, Ezek 36:16-23, 36:28
the Lord gathering Israel back into the Land and cleansing them, Ezek 36:24-25
the Lord giving Israel a New Heart and New Spirit (New Covenant), Ezek 36:26
the Lord giving Israel the Holy Spirit within them, to observe His ordinances, Ezek 36:27, John 3:5-8
the Lord giving Israel the Land of their forefathers, Ezek 36:28
Israel will be the Lord's people and the Lord will be their God, Ezek 36:28
the Lord multiplies grain and fruit and produce for Israel, Ezek 36:29-30
the Lord does this, but Not for Israel's sake, Ezek 36:32, 36:22.
the Lord cleansing Israel's sin and its cities restored, Ezek 36:33
the Land of Israel becomes like the Garden of Eden and rebuilt, Ezek 36:34
the Valley of Dry Bones, Israel coming to Life out of the graves, or Resurrected, Ezekiel 37:1-14
the Dry Bones coming alive, with breath and skin, and standing on their feet, Ezek 37:1-10
    these Bones are the whole house of Israel, Ezek 37:11
the Lord opens Israel's graves and causes them to come out of the graves, Ezek 37:12-13
the Lord puts the Holy Spirit in them, they come to life, and they are put in their own Land, Ezek 37:14
"and judgment was given (granted) to them, both Jew and Gentile, (Believers)". 1 Cor 6:2-3
These Believers will be sitting on thrones reigning with Christ and will be granted by God
    to Judge others in and during the thousand year Millennial Kingdom.
       1 Corinthians 6:2-3
       2 Or do you not know that the saints will judge the world?
            If the world is judged by you, are you not competent to constitute the smallest law courts?
       3 Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more (judge) matters of this life?
Then John saw the souls of those beheaded who had Not worshiped the Beast, Rev 20:4a
Then John saw the souls of those who had been beheaded (killed) 6:9, 7:14, 11:7, 13:7, 14:13, 16:6, 17:6, 18:24,
They were beheaded because (Reason) of their testimony of Jesus Rev 1:2, 1:9, 6:9, 12:11, 12:17, 19:10,
    and because (Reason) of the word of God, they were martyred saints. Rev 6:9, 12:11, 12:17
and those (Believers) who had not worshiped the beast or his image, Rev 14:13
    and (those) had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; 7:3, 9:4, 13:16, 14:1, 13, 22:4
The souls of those beheaded (killed) martyrs
The soul is the immaterial part of a person, the heart, mind, conscience, as in Matt 10:28, 2 Cor 5:8, Rev 6:9.
These martyrs > are the Tribulation saints slain or killed during the 7 year Tribulation.
   They are first souls, 20:4a, absent from the body, 2 Cor 5:8, but have now "come to life", 20:4b,
        or been resurrected, because of their testimony during the 7 year Tribulation, in Rev 20:4.
These martyrs > are the killed Tribulation saints mentioned in Rev 6:9, 7:14, 11:7, 13:7, 14:13, 16:6, 17:6, 18:24.
These martyrs > are Not the Church Gathered/Resurrected before the 7 year Tribulation,
   because the Rapture there includes those alive believers being "caught up" to Christ,
       without being killed as martyrs, in 1 Thes 4:13-18 and in 1 Cor 15:50-54.
Reformed Theology's 4 Views believe that the Rapture saints and these martyred saints were both
   "caught up" and "rise" at this point in Time, but I see No one being "caught up" alive here.
There is No mention of the Rapture of BOTH, those "raised" Dead and those "caught up" Alive "in Christ"
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See Lesson 19 for more detail on the Rapture.

in the Book of Revelation.

they (the dead) came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years, Rev 20:4b

Then they, the dead martyred Tribulation saints, came to life or were resurrected from the grave.

All believers, when they die, their spirits go to be with the Lord, but their bodies go to the grave, 2 Cor 5:8.

All believers, when they are resurrected, their New spiritual Bodies are united with their spirits,

spirits that are already with the Lord, 1 Cor 15:50-54. See Lesson 19 for more on the resurrected.

The dead martyred Tribulation saints came to life and begin to reign with Christ for a thousand years.

The Saints or Overcomers will Reign with Christ during the Millennial Kingdom, Rev 20:4b
The saints, will be given authority over the nations, Rev 2:26
The saints, will sit down with Christ on His throne, Rev 3:21
The saints, will be a kingdom and priests to God; and they will reign upon the earth, Rev 5:9–10
The saints, will be priests of God and of Christ and will reign with Him for a thousand years, Rev 20:6

Christ will Reign on His throne, in Jerusalem, during the Millennial Kingdom
Christ Reigning is mentioned in many passages, as in Isa 2:1-4, Isa 9:6-7, Isa 11:1-4, Isa 42:1, Ps 72:1-11,

Jer 23:5-8, Dan 7:13-14, Mic 4:1-8, Mic 5:2-5, Zech 14:9-11, Lk 1:31-33

Isaiah 2:1-4

1 The word which Isaiah the son of Amoz saw concerning Judah and Jerusalem.

2 Now it will come about that in the last days

The mountain (Zion) of the house of the Lord Will be established as the chief of the mountains, And will be raised above the hills; And all the nations will stream to it (Zion).

3 And many peoples will come and say,

"Come, let us go up to **the mountain** (**Zion**) of **the Lord**, To **the house** of **the God** of **Jacob**; That **He** may **teach** us concerning **His** ways And that we may walk in **His** paths."

For **the law** will go forth from **Zion** And **the word of the Lord** from **Jerusalem**.

4 And **He** (the Lord) will judge between the nations, And will render decisions for many peoples; And they will hammer their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks.

Nation will not lift up sword against nation, And never again will they learn war.

Those on Thrones, beheaded, without mark of Beast, came to Life
Working Outline > Read Revelation 20:5-6 (Portion of Paragraph ¶ from NAS Bible)
Revelation 20:5-6

- I. 5 (5a, sentence) The rest of the dead (Unbelievers) did not come to life 20:12-13
 A. until the thousand years were completed. 20:7,
 B. (5b, sentence) This is the first resurrection. Lk 14:14, Phil 3:11,
- II. 6 (sentence) Blessed and holy is the one who has a part in the first resurrection; Rev 14:13

A. over these the second death has no power, Rev 2:11, 20:14,

B. but they will be priests of God and (priests) of Christ Rev 1:6,

C. and (they) will reign with Him for a thousand years. Rev 3:21, 5:10, 20:6, 22:5,

In the **Greek**, Rev 20:5 is **2 sentences** labeled here as (5a, sentence) and (5b, sentence). But Rev 20:6 is just **one sentence**.

The rest of the dead did not come to life until the thousand years were completed, Rev 20:5a
Then the rest of the dead, meaning all those Not included as martyred believers in Rev 20:4,
 did not come to life. These other dead persons must then be seen as Unbelievers.

Death is a Condition and Hades is a place, the Grave, the abode of the Dead, where Unbelievers temporarily go after Death, until they are raised, Judged, and condemned, Rev 20:12-15.

These dead Unbelievers will Not be raised until the thousand years were completed.

This is the first resurrection, Rev 20:5b

This (5b, sentence) at first glance seems to **refer back** to what was just said, concerning "the rest of **the dead**", the **Unbelieving Dead**, but instead it **refers** to **believers**, in Rev 20:4, 20:6. With this in mind, "This is **the first resurrection**", refers to the **martyred believers**, in Rev 20:4, and to the **Blessed** and **Holy Ones** that are **priests** of **God** and **reign** with **Christ**, in Rev 20:6.

The Resurrection of the righteous or the Resurrection of Life, occurrences

Christ was "the First fruits", the First Resurrected, 1 Cor 15:23

Then the resurrection of many bodies of dead saints, Matt 27:52-53, John 5:29

Then the caught up/resurrected of the Church, 1 Thes 4:13-18, John 5:29

Then the resurrection of the two witnesses, Rev 11:3, 11, (assumes they were not resurrected before.)

Then the resurrection of the martyred dead Tribulation saints, Rev 20:4-5, John 5:29

Then the resurrection of OT saints, as in (Isa 26:19-21, Ezek 37:12-14, Dan 12:2-3), not mentioned in Rev 20.

Reformed Theology View

Therefore, we confidently affirm that the "first resurrection" here is a spiritual (Non-Physical) resurrection, having reference to the conversion of sinners through the preaching of the gospel.

over these (believer's) the second death (Lake of Fire, 20:14) has no power, Rev 2:11, 20:14,

but they (believer's) will be priests of God and (priests) of Christ, as in Rev 1:6,

and (they) will reign with Him for a thousand years. Rev 3:21, 5:10, 20:6, 22:5,

The Saints or Overcomers will Reign with Christ during the Millennial Kingdom. See previously, Rev 20:4b

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The Millennial Kingdom, WHO will be there?
The Rapture caught up/resurrected all who had come to Christ, from Pentecost, Acts 2 to Rev 4.
    This resurrection resurrects all the Dead Tribulation saints who come to Christ, from Rev 6 to Rev 18.
All saints, once resurrected, are Glorified > in a final state of high honor and esteem, Rom 8:29-30
What remains is all the Alive (Not Killed) Tribulation saints who come to Christ, from Rev 6 to Rev 18.
These Alive Tribulation saints join all the previously resurrected saints, and all enter the Millennial Kingdom.
The Millennial Kingdom begins with resurrected believers and alive believers only,
    and without resurrected Unbelievers and without alive Unbelievers, John 3:5, Matt 5:20, 7:21, 18:3.
The separating of alive believers and alive Unbelievers happens at the Sheep and Goat Judgment,
   Matt 25:31-16, where all the alive nations are gathered before Christ on His throne, 25:31.
       The Sheep will inherit the kingdom (Millennial), 25:34, and eternal life, 25:46.
       The Goats will depart to the eternal fire, 25:41 and eternal punishment, 25:46.
The Millennial Kingdom begins with only alive and resurrected believer's and with No Unbelievers.
    Alive Unbelievers will have already departed to the eternal fire, Matt 25:41
    Dead Unbelievers will Not be raised (resurrected) until the thousand years is completed, Rev 20:5.
During the Millennial Kingdom, alive believers will have children, some of those children will be believers
    and some of those children will be Unbelievers, like it is now in this present age.
When the 1000 years is completed, Satan will deceive the Nations, there will be Unbelievers
    as the sand of the sea, Rev 20:7-9.
During the Church Age > the past 2000 years, the fulness of the Gentiles (believers) has come in, Rom 11:25.
    Once that fullness comes in, the mostly Gentile Church will be Raptured/resurrected, 1 Thes 4:13-18.
During the Millennial Kingdom Age > the future 1000 years, All Israel will be saved, Rom 11:26-32,
  and All the OT saints will be resurrected, Dan 12:2, Ezek 37:1-14, Isa 26:19.
    Christ will be King in Jerusalem, on Mt. Zion, in His Temple, on the throne of David,
        and all the nations will stream to Mt. Zion, and there will be peace for a 1000 years. Isa 2:1-4
During the Millennial Kingdom Age > Israel is Restored, Deut 3:30-31, 4:25-31, 30:1-10, Ezek 11:13-21, 16:60-62,
20:33:34, 28:25-26, 34:11-31, 36:16-38, 37:1-14, 37:15-28, Hos 2:14-23, 3:1-5, Isa 65:17-25, 66:10-24, Jer 30:1-24, 31:23-
40, 32:36-44, 33:7-26, Joel 3:1-2, 2:18-21, 3:18-21, Amos 9:11-15, Micah 7:11-20, Zeph 3:11-20, Zech 13:1-9, 14:1-21,
Mal 4:1-3, and others.
After the 1000 years is completed, Satan is released, peace ends, and he wars against Jerusalem, Rev 20:7-9.
Then the Present Earth and Heaven have fled away, Rev 20:11, been destroyed, 2 Pet 3:7, 10, 12.
Then the Great White Throne of Christ Judges all resurrected and alive Unbelievers,
       and they are all thrown into the Lake of Fire, Rev 20:11-15, 21:8. Therefore, No more Unbelievers.
During the Eternal Kingdom Age > the future eternity, the New Heaven and New Earth are created.
The New Jerusalem comes down from Heaven, from the "Father's House", where Jesus has prepared
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a dwelling place for the disciples and All Believers, John 14:2

The Millennial Kingdom, between Rev 20:6 and Rev 20:7

When Christ returns to the earth after His 2nd Coming, and establishes Himself as King in Jerusalem, on Mt. Zion, in His Temple, sitting on the throne of David, Luke 1:32–33, Isa 2:1-4.

At this time All of the Covenant Promises that were given and belong to Israel, Rom 9:4, will be fulfilled.

The Abrahamic Covenant (Gen 12, 13, 15, 17, 18, 22) promised:

the LORD will make Abraham a great nation (Israel), a great name, and a great blessing, Gen 12:2, Gen 18:18 the LORD will give Land of Canaan, to Abram and his (Physical) Descendants, Gen 12:7, 13:15, 13:17, 15:18, 17:8 the LORD will give Israel all the land of Canaan for an everlasting possession, Gen 17:8, 12:7, 15:8, Acts 7:5 the LORD will through Abraham, all the nations of the earth will be blessed, Gen 12:2, Gen 18:18

The **Deuteronomic Covenant** (Deut 29 & Deut 30) **promised**:

Israel would return and obey the Lord with all their heart and soul (New Cov.), Deut 30:2.

the LORD will restore Israel from captivity, and have compassion on Israel, Deut 30:3

the LORD will gather Israel from all the peoples where the LORD has scattered Israel, Deut 30:4

the LORD will bring Israel into the land which their fathers possessed, and Israel shall possess it; Deut 30:5

the LORD will prosper Israel and multiply them more than their fathers, Deut 30:5.

the LORD will circumcise Israel's heart (New Cov.) and the heart of Israel's descendants, Deut 30:6, Rom 2:29, to love the LORD their God with all their heart and with all their soul, so that they may live, Deut 30:6.

The Davidic Covenant (2 Sam 7:8–17, 1 Chron 17:1-16, Psalm 89) promised:

the LORD will appoint a place (Land) for My people Israel and will plant them, 2 Sam 7:10a, 1 Chr 17:9
that they (Israel) may live in their own place (Land) and not be disturbed again, 2 Sam 7:10b
the LORD will raise up (David's) descendant (seed) who will come forth from David, 2 Sam 7:12c, Ps 89:30
the LORD will establish (David's seed's) kingdom, 2 Sam 7:12c, 7:16, 1 Chr 17:11
the LORD will establish the throne of (David's) kingdom forever, 7:13b, 1 Chr 17:12, 22:10, Ps 89:4, 29, 36-37

The New Covenant (Jer 31:31-34, Ezek 36:24-28, Heb 8:6-13, 10:16-17) promised:

The Days are Coming, in the Future, when the Lord will make a New Covenant with Israel & Judah (12 tribes), Jer 31:31, Jer 32:40, Lk 22:20, Heb 9:15, 10:16, 12:24, 1 Cor 11:25, 2 Cor 3:6, Heb 8:8

the LORD will make a New Covenant not like the (Mosaic) covenant, Jer 31:32

This is the New Covenant which the LORD make with the house of Israel after those days, Jer 31:33, Heb 8:10

the LORD will put and write His law within Israel and on their Heart, Jer 31:33, 2 Cor 3:3, Jer 24:7

the LORD will be Israel's God, and Israel shall be His people, Jer 31:33, Jer 24:7, 30:22, 32:38

Israel will all know the LORD, from the least of them to the greatest of them, Jer 31:34 Heb 8:11

the LORD will forgive Israel's iniquity, and sin and remember it no more,


Jer 31:34 Heb 8:12, Jer 50:20

the LORD will Never Cast Off the offspring

Original Created Earth, with Nations, Kings, and People.

All Creation Cursed, Man, Creatures, and Ground, Gen 3, crying, mourning, pain, and labor.

All Die, in Adam all Die, 1 Cor 15:22, All People in Earthly Bodies, Lifespan typically less than 100 years,

Some People will come to Christ, Mostly Gentiles with some Israelites.

No People in Resurrected Spiritual Bodies,

All Covenant Promises are Not Fulfilled Yet

Millennial Kingdom Age > exactly 1000 years.
