



Rev 22:1-5 continues the Description of New Jerusalem, out of Heaven, given in Rev 21:1-27.





a river of the water of life, coming from the throne of God, Rev 22:1

Then the same angel, 21:9-10, showed John, a river of the water of life, clear as crystal,

coming or going out from the throne of God and of the Lamb, Rev 1:4, 3:21, 4:2-11, 5:6, 21:3, 22:3

The source of the water of life, is the throne of God and of the Lamb, Rev 22:1

The guide to the water of life, is "the Lamb" "will guide them to springs of the water of life", Rev 7:17
The giver of the water of life, is "Jesus"

"I will give to the one who thirsts from the spring of the water of life", Rev 21:6

The thirsty for the water of life, let the one who is thirsty come;

let the one who wishes take the water of life", Rev 22:17

"thirsty", normally has to do with, an inner desire or craving for a drink of something.

"thirsty", can mean, having an inner desire or craving for something, as in "being thirsty for knowledge".

Therefore, if a person is thirsty, having an inner desire or craving for God, they can and will have

access to the water of life from God's throne, which is from Jesus,

who gives to the thirsty from the water of life", Rev 21:6.

These people are believers, "whoever believes, will in Him, have eternal life, Jn 3:15-16.

The water of life gives a person eternal life and maintains a person's eternal life.

The ESV reads better than the NAS here, with its punctuation, in Rev 22:1-2

1 Then the angel showed me the river of the water of life, bright as crystal,

flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb 2 through the middle of the street of the city; also, on either side of the river (of the water of life),


the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, Rev 2:7, 22:14, 22:19, Gen 2:9, 3:22-24, yielding its fruit each month. Ezek 47:12,


The **leaves** of the tree (of life) were for the healing of the nations (peoples).

the river of the water of life, was flowing from the throne of God and of the Lamb through the middle of the street of the city. This would mean that the river split the street into two halves.

This like a landscaped median on a highway with a river in that median, with trees on either side of the river.

on either side of the river (of the water of life), was the tree of life
the tree of life with its twelve kinds of fruit, Rev 2:7, 22:14, 22:19, Gen 2:9, 3:22-24,
yielding its fruit each month. Ezek 47:12,






the tree of life in on either side of the river of the water of life

the tree of life was on either side of the river of the water of life.

This can't mean half a tree on each side of the river, so this must mean the tree(s) of life on either side.

It was not one individual tree, but a particular tree as to its kind, as we speak of 'the apple' or 'the oak'.

Example: The apple tree (as a kind) was on either side of the river in that city.



#### the tree of life in the Garden of Eden

the Lord caused to grow every tree, including the tree of life also in the midst of the garden of Eden, Gen 2:9 the tree of life was good for food, Gen 2:9

If man was to take from the tree of life and eat, he would live forever, Gen 3:22

#### the tree of life in the Paradise of God

To him who overcomes, I will grant to eat of the tree of life, which is in the Paradise of God, Rev 2:7

Blessed are those who wash their robes, so that they may have the right to the tree of life, Rev 22:14

In the garden of Eden, the tree of life was good for food and when eaten, man would live forever, Gen 3:22 In the New Jerusalem or Paradise of God believers will be granted by God to eat of the tree of life, Rev 2:7

After the Fall of man, God drove the man out; and at the east of the garden of Eden

God stationed the cherubim and the flaming sword ..... to guard the way to the tree of life, Gen 3:24
In the New Jerusalem or Paradise of God believers will have the right to the tree of life again, Rev 22:14

#### the tree of life had 12 kinds of fruit,

the tree of life had 12 kinds of fruit, not just one kind of fruit but 12 kinds.

This speaks of Heaven having a variety of types of things to eat.

the tree of life yielded or produced its fruit each month, on a regular basis.

#### the tree of life leaves

the leaves of the tree of life were for the healing of the nations or the peoples.

The word "healing" (therapeian) can be understood as "health-giving." Even though there is no sickness in the eternal state, the leaves seem to contribute to the well-being or be therapeutic to the peoples.

This is similar to the tree leaves in the Millennial Kingdom, in Ezek 47:12.

There will no longer be any curse in the **New Jerusalem** or the **New Earth**, Rev 22:3a There will no longer be any curse; Zech 14:11

No more **curse**, of **Man**, **Woman**, **Beasts**, **the Ground**, **Creation**, or **Israel**, **Gen** 3:14-19, Rom 8:20-23 "For as in **Adam** all **die**, so also in **Christ** all will be made **alive**", 1 Cor 15:22, Rom 5:17

#### People groups in the New Jerusalem, besides the Father and Jesus

Elect/chosen angels, including all those around the throne in heaven, Rev 4:1-11, 5:1-14

Elect/chosen Church-Age people saved, under the New Covenant, inside and outside the City.

Elect/chosen Nation of Israel people saved, under the New Covenant, inside and outside the City.

All those who by God's grace have believed by faith in Jesus, shall not perish, but have eternal life.

Then Jesus says, "Behold, I (Jesus) am coming quickly (or soon), Rev 2:16, 3:11, 22:7, 22:20
Jesus here is speaking of His Second Coming and that it will be quickly or soon. This was written by John in
the first century, and since then Jesus has not come again, then quickly or soon can't mean after a short time,
    because 2000 years is not a short time.
Also, Jesus has not yet rewarded or rendered to every man, according to what he has done,
   over the last 2000 years. Therefore, quickly or soon must mean His Second Coming is imminent.

Then Jesus says, My reward (wage) is with Me, Isa 40:10, Isa 62:11,
reward (Grk, misthos, 3408), as in wage given as payment for worthy acts (as in a reward)
    or as in wage given as payment for retribution (as in punishment or vengeance) for wrongdoing.
Therefore, Jesus is coming to both reward or pay men for their worthy acts,
                  and Jesus is coming to punish or pay men for their wrongdoing.
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Believers will be rewarded, based on their deeds, at the Bema Seat Judgment, 2 Cor 5:10-11. Unbelievers will be punished, based on their deeds, at the White Throne Judgment, Rev 20:12.

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Contrast between Believers and Unbelievers, Rev 22:14-15

"... they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb", Rev 7:14

They are Blessed, so that (Reason) they may have the right to the tree of life, Gen 2:9, Rev 3:22, 22:2

They are Blessed, so that (Reason) they may enter by the gates into the city (new Jerusalem).

Second, are those (Unbelievers) who are "outside" or "apart from" those Blessed,

They are the dogs (persons, Phil 3:2), and the sorcerers (poisoner, magician)
and the immoral (fornicator) persons and the murderers (unlawful killing)
and the idolaters (idol worshipers), and everyone who loves and practices lying (untruth telling).
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I, Jesus, have sent My angel to testify to you (John) these things for the churches
